

Back to the sea for hooked turtle

A green sea turtle was released back into the ocean at Hanauma Bay yesterday after being brought ashore Sunday with two fishing hooks in its flesh and trailing a tangle of line.

One hook in the animal's flipper was removed on the beach, and a second hook in its neck was surgically removed by veterinarian Robert Morris of Makai Animal Clinic in Kallua, who concluded that the animal

Wai'anae applauds girl's bravery

WAI'ANAE — Pearl Bautista said she clapped along with dozens of others Saturday night when police arrested her neighbor's 39-year-old brother in the rape and kidnapping of an 8-yearold girl in a vacant lot.

The crowd's reaction had nothing to do with the arrest of Yomeo Eieta at 8:31 p.m.

Bautista, coordinator of

Bautista, co Kau'iokalani h o u s i n g's Neighborhood S e c u r i t y Watch, said the community's reaction was for the little girl.

Bautista said Eleta

police brought the girl in a police SUV for a field lineup. The girl picked out Eieta as her attacker, according to a court document.

"We were clapping for her because it took a lot of courage and bravery to do what she did," Bautista said.

Eieta, a native of Chuuk (Federated States of Micronesia) who is unemployed, was charged yesterday with four counts of first-degree sex assault, one count of third-degree sex assault and kidnapping. His bail totals \$150,000. Eieta was scheduled to appear today at District Court.

Eieta has no criminal record in Hawai'i, said police Detective Phillip Lavarias, the lead investigator
