#### Disturbance of Wildlife

Commanding Officers shall take necessary steps to prevent unnecessary flying over known haunts of wildlife. When it is necessary to fly over such areas, an absolute altitude of at least 3000 feet shall be maintained, if maintaining such an altitude is not detrimental to the mission. Any type of hunting from any aircraft is prohibited.
