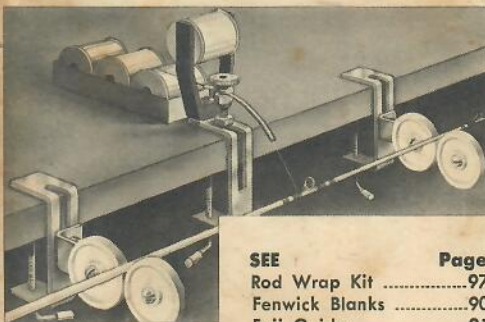
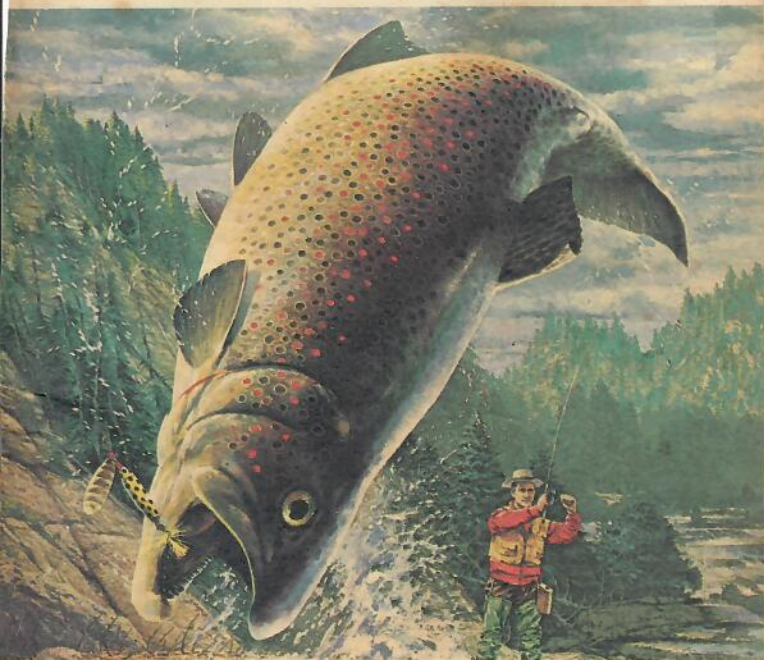

Zinc plated with yellow chromate dip to prevent rusting and provide years of trapping pleasure.
