The Dole pineapple stand, beyond Wahiawa on the road to Haleiwa, first built on that site in 1951, is being replaced by an ultramodern, two-story structure, visible in rear, to feature a museum, lookout, park and enhanced parking. It will be at least the third version of Dole's pineapple stand. The original stand was in Moanalua, near the site of Tripler Hospital, when pineapple was grown in that area by Dole's ancestor company, Hawaiian Pineapple Co., in the early 1900s.
