On Thursday June 11, 1992 a large Tiger Shark got hooked up at 1 AM on my Shark Line set at the end of Tiger Shark Alley. This ~~to~~ 20 foot, 2,000 pound shark bent a iron number 60 tuna hook and swam away. Seven days later on ~~June~~ Thursday June 18, 1992 at 1 AM a 11 foot ~~400~~ pound Male Tiger Shark ~~was~~ got hooked up ~~on~~ ~~the~~ my shark line set at the same place. It took me 4 and a half hours to kill this shark and tow him in too the beach. The rest of the story you know about.

After ~~we~~ spoke, I found the metal dart that was used to hold the plastic tag - enclosed. Also the piece of metal I found ~~in the~~ stuck in the throat of this shark. - enclosed.
