
## PIONEERTOWN How The West Was Once





## ABOUT PIONEERTOWN


PIONEERTOWN WAS BUILT IN 1946 WITH FUNDING FROM THE PIONEERTOWN LAND CO. WHICH INCLUDED HOLLYWOOD ACTORS DICK CURTIS, ROY ROGERS AND RUSSELL "LUCKY" HAYDEN, AMONG OTHERS.

PIONEERTOWN WAS DESIGNED AND BUILT TO SERVE AS A PERMANENT MOTION PICTURE SET AS WELL AS AN ACTUAL WORKING COMMUNITY COMPLETE WITH A GROCERY STORE, BARBERSHOP, BOWLING ALLEY, RESTAURANTS AND BARS AND A MOTEL WHERE STARS COULD STAY WHILE FILMING MOVIES AND TV SHOWS SUCH AS "JUDGE ROY BEAN," "THE CISCO KID," "ANNIE OAKLEY," AND "RANGE RIDER."

In the years following the Western movie boom of the 1940s and 1950s, the devoted Pioneertown community has stayed in place looking after the abundant wildlife and tending to the legacy of the special place called "Pioneertown."



PIONEERTOWN AND THE SURROUNDING AREA HAS BECOME A SPLENDID LOCATION FOR WEDDINGS. OUR BLUE SKIES MAKE THE PERFECT BACKDROP FOR YOUR WEDDING DAY. Mane Street in Pioneertown is one of the most unique streets in the world. Here the early western town that existed during the fabulous American era of 1849 to 1890 is reborn. Here, the frame buildings, the boardwalks spring to life to echo the clatter of Western boot-heres.

MANE STREET ITSELF CAN BE TRAVERSED ONLY BY FOOT OR HOOF. MOTOR VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED. ENJOY THE FRESH AIR WHILE YOU TAKE A QUIET STROLL DOWN THROUGH TOWN JUST LIKE GENE AUTRY DID. THERE IS PLENTY TO SEE. VISIT THE PIONEERTOWN FILM MUSEUM, WHERE YOU CAN DISCOVER THE WESTERN MOVIE AND TELEVISION HISTORY OF THIS OLD WEST MOVIE SET. CHECK OUT THE BEAUTIFUL CRAFT WORK OF CHAPARROSA OUTFITTERS SADDLE SHOP AND MAZAMAR POTTERY. SAY "HI" TO THE GOATS AT SOAP GOATS SHOP AND VISIT WITH ARTISTS DISPLAYING THEIR VARIOUS CREATIONS. THERE ARE ALSO SHOPS WITH VINTAGE CLOTHING, JEWELRY, KNICK KNACKS, AND COLLECTIBLES.



The horse is king in Pioneertown and Always has been. Both Roy Roger's Trigger and Gene Autry's Champion loved to roam around the Pioneertown area. There are miles and miles of Beautiful Equestrian trails, winding leisurely across vast expanses covered with Joshua Trees, Yuccas, Manzanita, Juniper and Pinon Pine trees, to the tops of magnificent Lava Mesas.

PIONEERTOWN CORRALS ARE THE PERFECT PLACE TO STABLE YOUR HORSE AND CAMP OUT FOR A DAY, WEEKEND OR WEEK OF EXQUISITE HORSEBACK RIDING AND HIKING.

Pioneertown is surrounded by The Wildlands Conservancy owned volcanic mesas, Sawtooth Mountains, and preserve lands leading to the San Bernardino National Forest. The 25,500 acre Pioneertown Mountains Preserve descends from the high piney 7,800-foot ridges into the Pioneertown Valley. The preserve is open daily from dawn to dusk for hiking.
