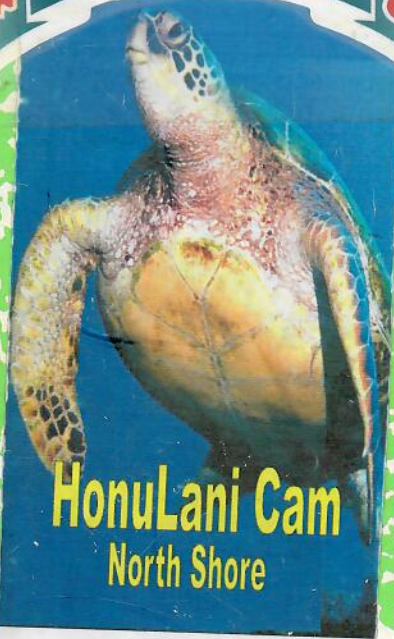

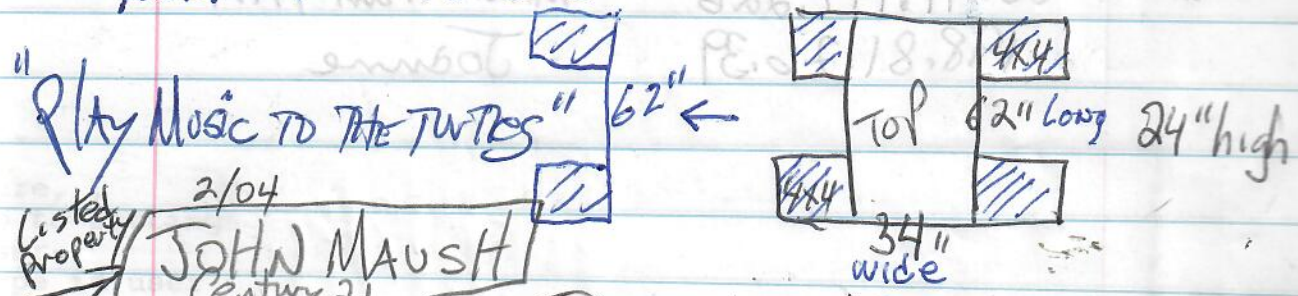

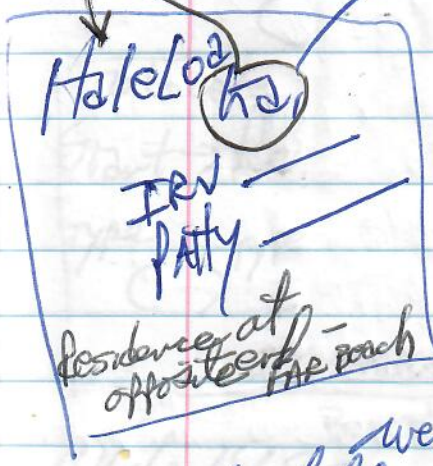

Thanks for such a detailed response. I teach at UHWO, in Pearl City (96-129 Ala Ike, Pearl City, HI 96797). In case you are not familiar with us, we offer several baccalaureate degrees to graduates of community colleges. We are upper division only, and (so far) have no science programs. I am a seaweed biologist myself (an Izzie Abbott product, as are nearly all the seaweed people in the islands). But when not collecting seaweeds, I snorkel just for fun and usually do those REEF fish counts to help me learn fishes... and to keep me from collecting seaweeds-I don't have time to work on!

The place where I saw L3 and L7 was off what I am calling, based on a city map, Kawailoa Beach Park. But there are no signs there, so I took a GPS this weekend. The turtles were directly offshore from 21degrees 37.10' N, 158 degrees 05.12' W

You might be interested to know that I am teaching an Environmental Ethics course this semester, and my students are choosing topics for research papers just this week. I used "Red Turtle Rising" last week, to emphasize the importance of combining science, management, and culture. Now it seems at least three of my 15 students want to do turtle papers! -- one will work on epidemiology of fibropapilloma disease, one on non-green sea turtle endangerment (hawksbill, leatherback...), and one will examine the international trade in turtle products. One other wanted to do something along this line, but I think I've diverted him to monk seals!

So, let me know if you might be coming our way, or are willing to. My students would be delighted to meet you (MW 12:30 class) -- either formally with a class talk, or informally just for a visit. I think I've actually met you, probably at an event at the Waikiki Aquarium, but no reason you should remember me. I'd be glad to get to know you better, and will certainly keep you posted on any special turtle sightings now that I have your e-mail address.
