I looked up the tags on our turtle and it was first captured on 4/21/92 at Kiholo Bay when it was 49.5 cm (straight carapace length). It was captured once again on 9/15/94 in the same area at SCL = 50.6 cm

It measured 74.5 SCL when I got back to campus and put it in the freezer. So it has been roughly 27 + years and it has grown from  $\sim$ 50 cm to 74.5 cm for a growth rate of roughly .9 cm/yr (very slow growth rate!) Have a nice day.
