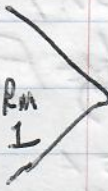

Field officer farewells rare friend

Of all the people who turned out to farewell Lady Nakalou at Wailoaloa Beach, Kolinio Musudroka was probably the most at ease.

The field officer with the World Wildlife Fund brought the turtle from Nakalou to his village in Navakasobu and was with her on the boat to Suva and on the van to Nadi.

Before that, the 105.9-centimetre green turtle spent two days and three nights in a pond he dug especially for her at the back of their house.

Their trip started last Sunday afternoon from Savusavu jetty and reached Narain Jetty in Suva on early Monday morning.

"I had to check her every

hour to see that she was all right when we left Savusavu. She slept in a tray on the truck deck," Mr Musudroka said.

"It was very hot and it

was lucky that we got through the night, which was amazing.

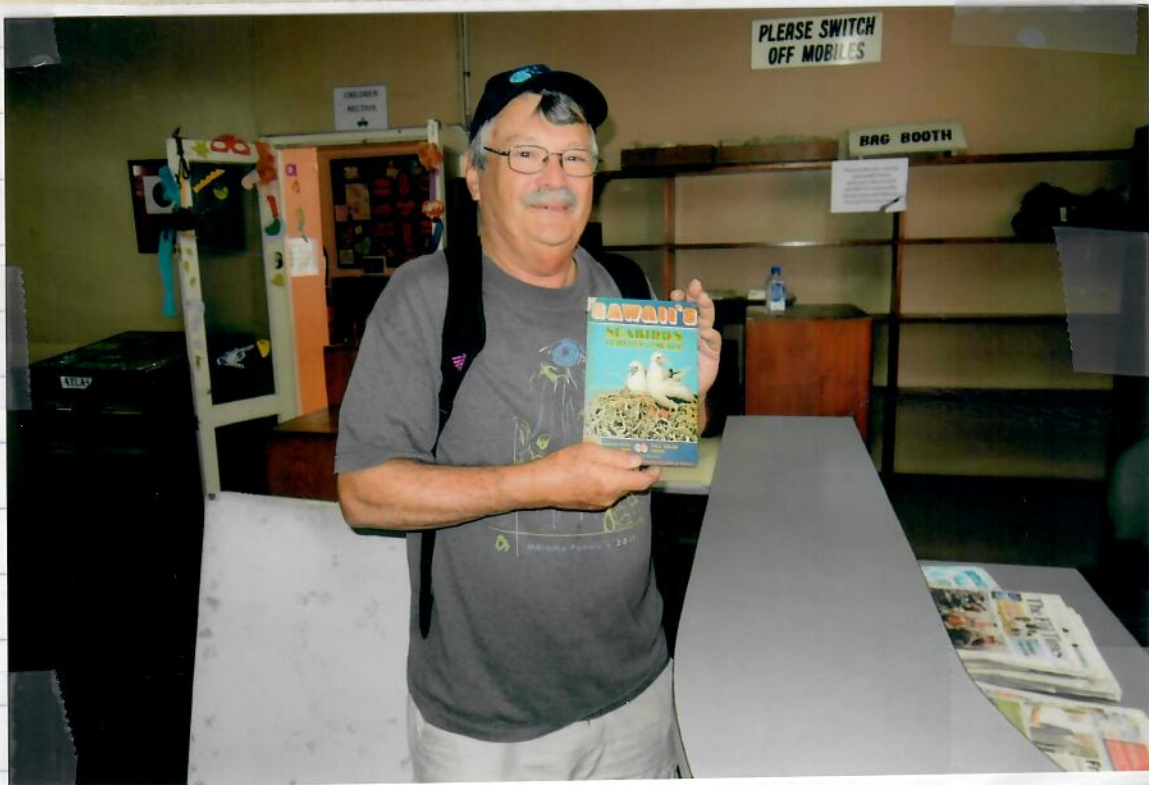
"Many people on the boat were from Savusavu and they were curious about what I was going to do with the turtle.

"I had to do lot of explaining to convince them that it was all part of a conservation effort."

When the ferry berthed at Narain Jetty, they were taken to Nadi immediately.

Mr Musudroka said he was grateful for the help of Nakalou and Navakasobu villagers.

"She managed to get through it to today and I'm so happy that she is free at last. Hopefully we might see her again someday."



A special lady returns home

A group of 25 marine conservationists turned up at Wailoaloa Beach, in Nadi, to send off a special friend.

She was Lady Nakalou, a green turtle all the way from Nakalou Village, in Maucata.

Lady Nakalou was tagged with a satellite tracker before she was freed to join her kind in the ocean while at the same time reporting home through the special apparatus attached on her back.

Her story is crucial in monitoring the migratory behaviour of these cultural icons.

On a tag on her back is written, Lady Nakalou, Nadi Fiji Island, Do Not Kill, Contact SPREP (Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme), 3315533.

It took six grown up men to carry Lady Nakalou from the vehicle to the beach after she was tagged.

She seemed reluctant to move but quickly vanished when her flippers touched the waves as applause erupted from her admirers.

Signs of relief were obvious on the faces of World Wildlife Fund staff and volunteers on the beach.

It was indeed a job well-done and marked the end of a two-day turtle tagging training workshop attended by stakeholders around the region at the Tanoa Hotel, in Nadi.

The workshop that was aimed at building national capacities to enable the satellite tagging of turtles and consequently learn more about their behaviour started on Tuesday.

It was facilitated by the Secretariat of the Pacific Regional Environment Programme, with support from the National Oceanic Atmospheric Administration and the Marine Conservation Action Fund.

Turtle conservation in Fiji received a major boost when the Government extended the moratorium, making it illegal to harvest and trade sea turtles for another 10 years from 2009.

Marine turtles grow slowly and take between 30 to 45 years to reach sexual maturity.

During their life and incredible migrations, they encounter many natural dangers. These have now been exacerbated by human pressures resulting in as few as one in 1000 eggs surviving to adulthood.

Five species of turtles can be found in Fiji — the hawksbill, green turtle, loggerhead, leatherback and Olive Ridley.

Pacific populations of leatherback and loggerheads are feared to be on the verge of extinction if slaughter levels continue.

Fund marine species coordinator Penina Solomona said: "With turtles traversing oceans, regional cooperation ensures that establishing the management and protection of turtle population must go beyond the national level to the cross-border level."

Scattered across 518,000 square kilometres of Pacific Ocean lie the 333 islands of Fiji. This beautiful, diverse country is world-renowned as the ultimate Pacific holiday destination, with warm sunshine, sandy beaches and hospitable, friendly people.

The British ruled Fiji from 1874, bringing indentured Indian labour to work the sugar cane plantations. In 1970, Fiji gained independence and was declared a republic.

The Country The Fiji islands lie 2100km north of Auckland, New Zealand and 2720km north-east of Sydney, Australia. Fiji's two largest islands, Viti Levu (10,429 sq km) and Vanua Levu (5556 sq km), make up most of the total land area. The country's bustling capital, Suva, is located on Viti Levu, and is the nation's main port and largest city.

Viti Levu, known for its scenic coastline, rainforests and swaying canefields, has many vibrant towns and regions for visitors to discover. Nadi, Denarau Island, Lautoka, Suncoast-Rakiraki, Coral Coast, Pacific Harbour and Suva and the Eastern Islands – these are all places you can easily explore as you make your way on the Queens Road in the south of the island, and the Kings Road in the north.

West of Nadi lies the beautiful Mamanuca group, with its idyllic island resorts and sandy beaches, and further north are the Yasawa Islands – magnificent, untouched jewels in the South Pacific. To the south, the islands of Beqa and Kadavu offer crystal clear waters, lovely beaches and superb diving.

In the north, rugged Vanua Levu Island (Big Land) is Fiji's second largest island. The main towns are Labasa and Savusavu. Labasa, known for its farming and fishing, is a busy township with dozens of shops and fresh fruit and vegetables. Savusavu, famous for its hot springs, sits beneath towering mist-covered mountains, alongside some of the most beautiful beaches in Fiji. Accommodation on Vanua Levu ranges from budget options right through to upmarket resorts.

To the east of Vanua Levu is Taveuni, known as the Garden Island. Famous for the Bouma Waterfall and Lake Tagimaucia, this lush tropical island is a haven for diving and fishing enthusiasts from around the world. You'll find many other islands to visit as well – some with luxury resorts; others completely uninhabited.

Getting There & Getting Around There are two international airports – one at Nadi, the other at Nausori in Suva. Both are on the island of Viti Levu. Many airlines fly in to Fiji, but the national carrier is Air Pacific (www.airpacific.com). Getting from one island to another is easy with an excellent domestic airline, Pacific Sun (www.pacificsun.com.fj), helicopters and boat services. There are plenty of transport options on the main islands, with an extensive bus service, taxis, scooters and rental cars.

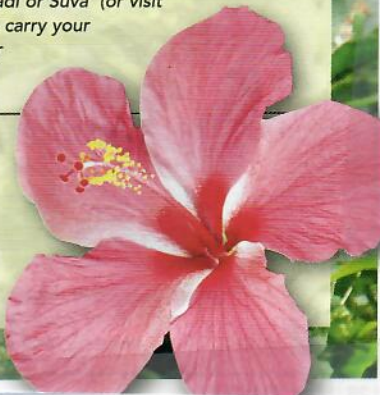
The Fiji Islands



The People The population of Fiji is 827,900 (2007 census) with indigenous Fijians making up about half the population and Fijian Indians the other half. This vibrant ethnic and cultural blend means Fiji has several main religions, including Christianity, Hindu and Islam. English is the official language, but Fijian and Hindustani are widely spoken. Fiji is famous for its pristine beaches and blue waters, but the country is also mountainous, with ancient craters and peaks rising to 1100m and more, and rivers stretching for many kilometres. This means there are plenty of activities for the adventurous, with exciting cultural village trips into the interior of the islands, as well as whitewater rafting and hiking. Villagers of Denimanu in Yadua Taba Island in Vanua Levu are not only saving the endemic iguanas of Fiji, but they have taken to turtle conservation as well.

The island was also the place where Marama-ni-Yadua, a turtle, was tagged to be used from the first satellite tagging for Fiji.

A group of turtle experts and researchers were on the island last week, tagging three loggerhead turtles or in Fiji known as Tuvonu.

Among the team was Dr George Balazs and Dr Jeffery Polovin from NOAA, Lui Bell, the Marine Species Officer for SPREP; Catherine Siota, Turtle Database Officer for SPREP; Aisake Batibasaga, Principal Fisheries Officer; Neema Nand, Marine turtle researcher for Fisheries Department; Merewalesi Laveti, Marine species officer with WWFSPPO; Unaisi Waqanivere, Conservation International; Jone Niukula, National Trust of Fiji and Graig Puxton, former Green Force Yadua expedition leader.

"These kind of co-operations between NGOs and Government departments are necessary for conservation work, and we are grateful to our regional and international partners," Mr Batibasaga said.

He reminded communities on the 10 years, Turtle Moratorium and its regulation in place.

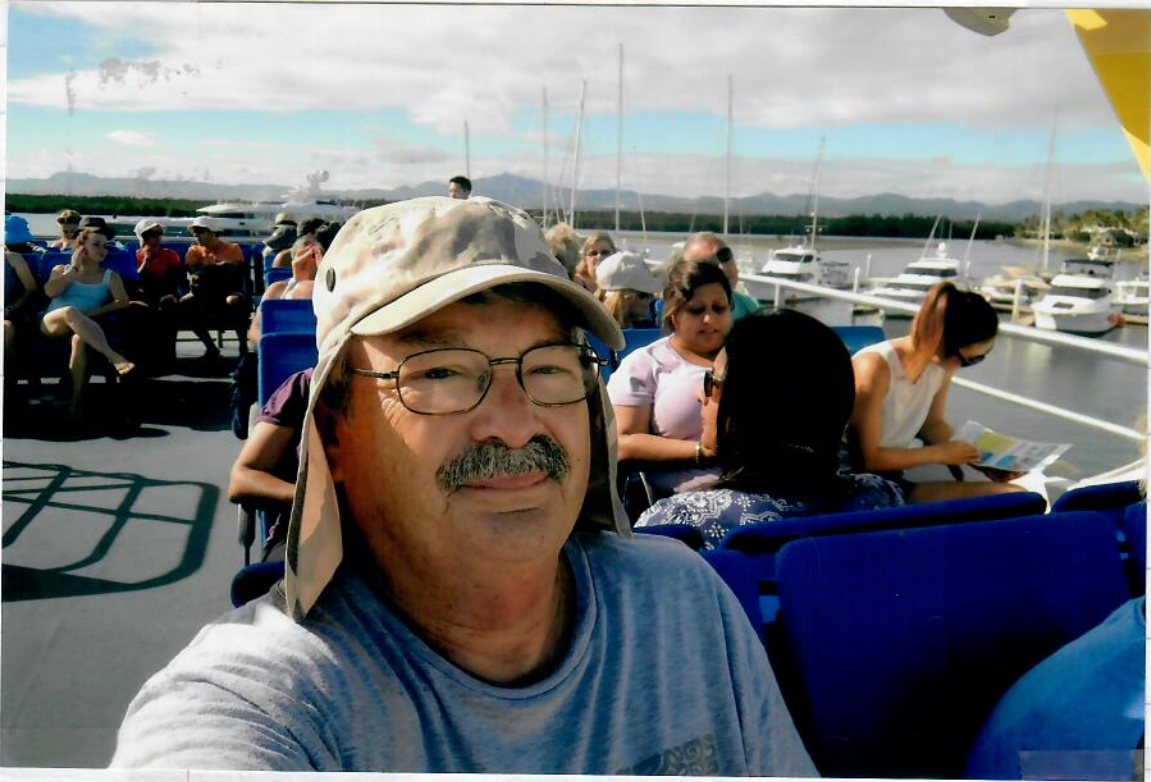

Thanks for the follow up email.

Anyway, iam sorry, Neema was sick and just gotten back to the office and Jone of National Trust is out in the field.

Just a brief update on the schedule:

1. Yes - the Loggerhead search started today. Fuel and batteries are with the Yadua communities. The communities have started building the Bi (traditional enclosed fence made from bamboo) out at the low tide mark.
2. We are proposing if we can all meet on Monday, may be over lunch here at either WWF conference room or National Trust may between 1pm -3pm this is to discuss the time, place to meet to leave Suva for Natouvanu boat to Nabouwalu and payments to be given so that we go and pay out boat fare from Suva to Natovi. Meaning that you will need to check in to a hotel here in Suva on Monday night. We will leave Suva early Tuesday morning (4 or 5am)



3. The boat from Natovi to Nabouwalu is safe (refer to pic of the boat attached) - (4 hours boat travel)

4. But boat from Bua to Yadua (4 hours max) - please all will need to bring along at least rain coats or jackets just in case it rains or rough seas (sea sprays). Life jacket and other equipments will be provided in the boat (Fibre)

5. We will be in a village setting, for respect would appreciate if you can bring with you a sulu or i lavalava

6. Yes, the resin will be secured by Neema.

7. Also bring some warm clothes (option), out in Yadua island it is a bit brizy now late in the evenings

Lui, does you, George and Jeff are thinking of coming back on the same route or joining us in Kia the following week for the Dau Ni Vonu meeting. I will be travelling up to Labasa with Jone where he will than fly out from Labasa to Nadi. To those who would want to take that route please book your return ticket from Labasa to Nadi. Or the other option is accompany Neema, who will travel by the ship again from Nabouwalu to Suva.

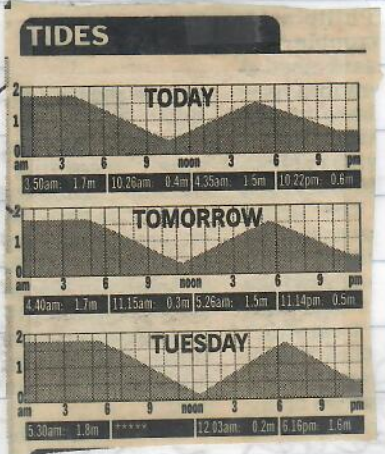

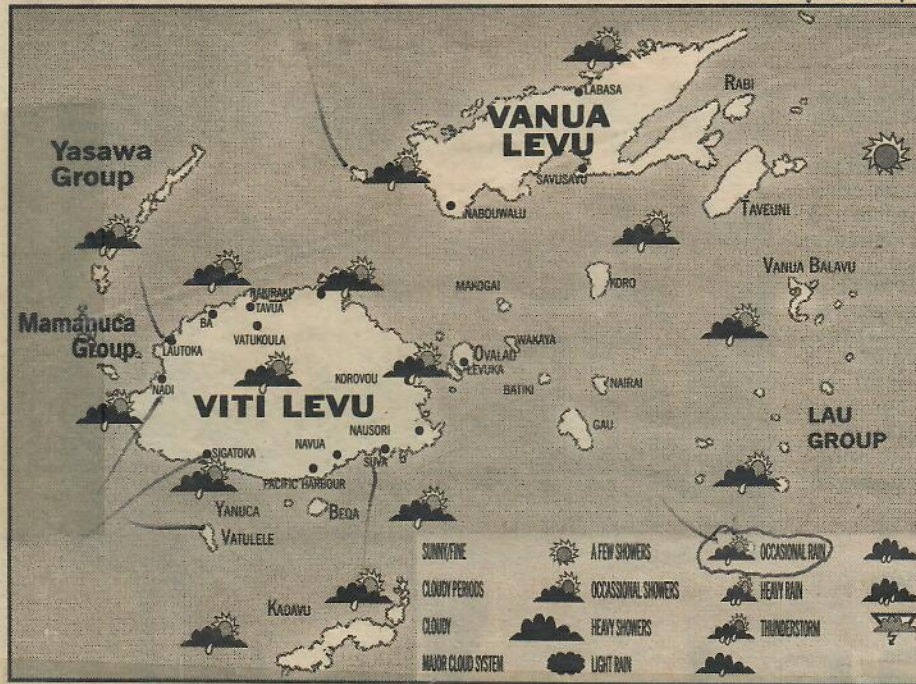

THE SITUATION

Situation: A developing trough of low pressure to the west of Fiji is expected to intensify as it moves across the group from later today. Meanwhile, an active convergence zone lies slow moving to the north of the group.

Forecast: Cloudy with showers and a chance of thunderstorm about northern Vanua Levu. A few showers over the interior and eastern parts of larger islands. Cloud cover increasing with rain and thunderstorms developing over the western parts from later today and spreading over the whole group. Isolated heavy falls expected.
