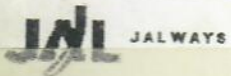

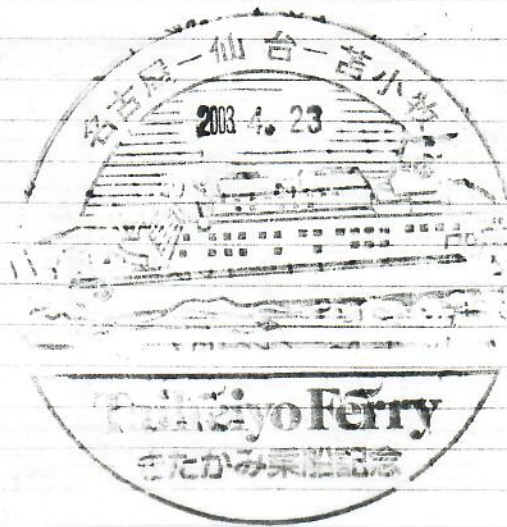

太平洋でウミガメ尾行

水族館 追跡装置付け放流

名古屋港水族館(港区
港町)は二十三日、アカ
ウミガメの太平洋回遊
経路を解明するため、追
跡装置を付けたウミガメ
をフェリーに積み込んだ。
米海洋大気局(N
OAA)との共同研究
で、二十四日早朝、千葉
県の房総半島沖で放流す
る。

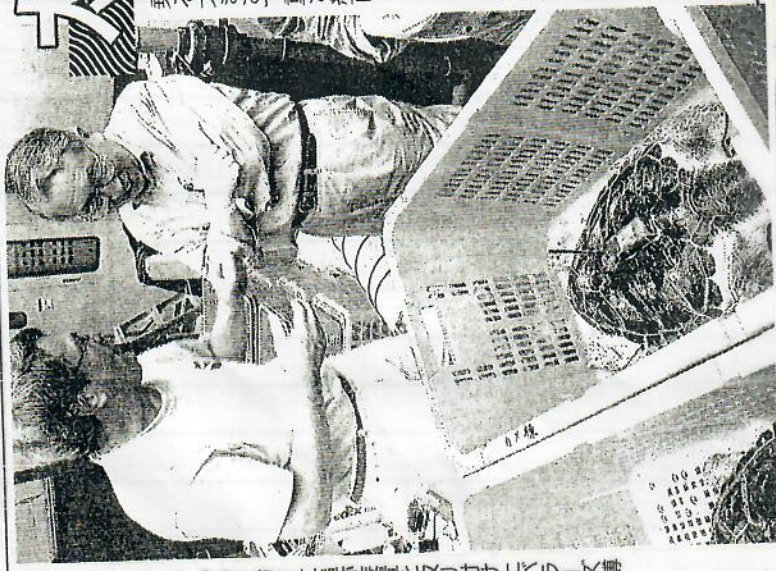
日本沿岸で生まれたア
カウミガメが、どのよう
に太平洋を移動していく
のか人工衛星を追跡する
調査。内田至館長とNO
AAのウミガメ専門員シ
ョーシ・バラーズ博士ら
は二十三日、約五時間か
けて同館で生まれた二
四歳のアカウミガメ七体
の背中に追跡装置を付け
た。

追跡装置は手のひらに
乗る大きさで重さ約百

回遊経路 解明に期待

二百匹。アカウミガメが
海面に浮上したときに電
波を発信し、衛星がキャ
ッチする。昨秋、同館が
シンガポールで放流した
アカウミガメ二体が意図
不通になっているのは、
追跡装置の不具合による
という推測もあるが、今
回の装置はより軽く、ア
ンテナに柔軟性があるた
め、破損しにくいとあら
れる。

放流のため、バラーズ
博士と一緒にフェリーに
乗り込んだ内田館長は
「前回のアカウミガメが
行方不明になったマラッ
カ海峡と違い、太平洋は
船の往来も少ないので実
験もうまくいくのでは。
黒潮に乗り、ウミガメが
どう米国西海岸までたど
りつるか楽しみ」と期待
を寄せていた。
