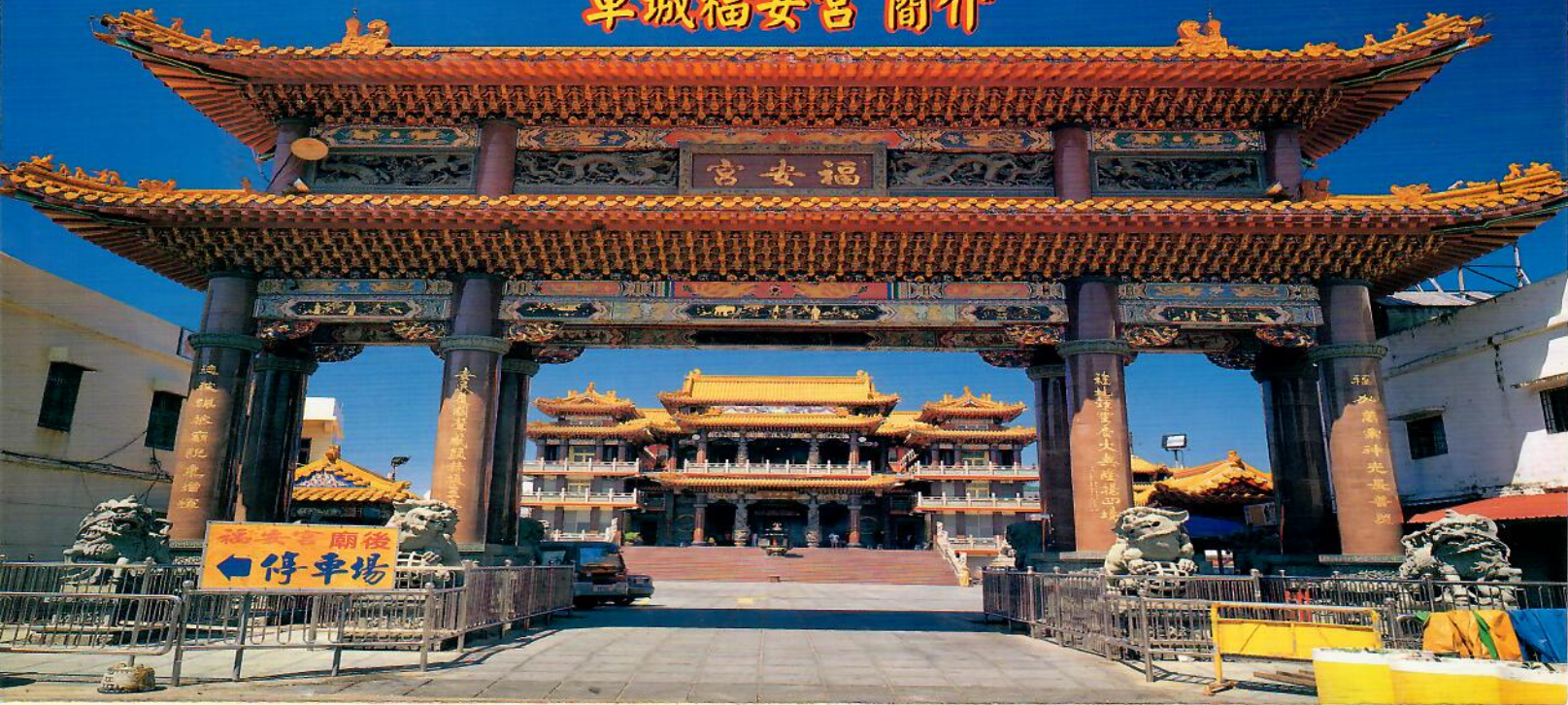

Che Cheng Fu An Temple is located on a sacred land, bound to the east by the Ssu Chung River, to the west by the Taiwan Strait, to the South by the Turtle Mountain where the National Museum of Marine Biology & Aquarium is in and to the north by the Dragon Mountain Ridge. It is situated in the impressive scenery. Dated back three or four hundred ago, the place was still wilderness. In addition to the life of hardship for those pioneers to have this region cultivated, there were also epidemic diseases unfortunately. To beseech for safety and wellness, settlers laid schemes to sculpture a "God of the Land" to bless and protect the people. As most of those settlers came from Chuan Jou and Jin Jiang, they sculptured the god based on what they memorized. They built a cottage and named it " the Holy Pavilion" until the Emperor Jia-ching's reign, Ching Dynasty when people solicited contributions for renovation and changed its name to Fu An Shrine. In 1953, Fu An Shrine was reconstructed and changed name to Fu An Temple. In 1980, though under financial difficulties, to accommodate the increasing followers and pilgrims, people decided to expand the Fu An Temple to a traditional six-story temple building.

During the expansion, the God of Land made its power felt by always saying yes to seekers of help, plus followers from all over the country to spare no effort in contribution, the six-story temple building was successfully completed in 1987, and was inaugurated on the ninth day of the eleventh month of the Lunar New Year of the same year, making the temple with splendid appearance to tower over. Its magnificentness and scale might be ranked number one in the country.

With the economic progress in Taiwan, and the development and construction of Kenting National Park and National Museum of Marine Biology & Aquarium, Fu An Temple has become a world renown tourist attraction and sacred place. Both foreign and local tourists drop in to pray for safety and wellness when passing by. The God of Land is efficacious. Whatever you ask for in prayer, it will be yours. It blesses and protects people, making Fu An Temple the most renown temple of the God of Land in the country.
