This time he has put a shield around pupella - and two pointed projections on bow. Later in the day, Doyle Gates told me that 2 Japanese <sup>spid</sup> boats have put into Midway because nets were fouled in their props. <sup>5/1/82</sup> Skip will take packet to Heide.
