During the early 1950s he told of a way catching turtles by net full (time off of Maile). He used to keep them on their backs in a quonset hut. As needed, take them to market in Honolulu.

Narvaez also told me that he personally saw turtles sleeping on "the bottom," as big as boulders at a place close to shore just inside the cut; pointing at the next projection of land to the west from where we were standing at Maile.
