Found a couple pockets of putrid flesh - still so after 8 months! Washed up and bleached the bones in the laundry room that evening. Had Curry ^{SEA LARVAE} bean dish at mess hall (for dinner).

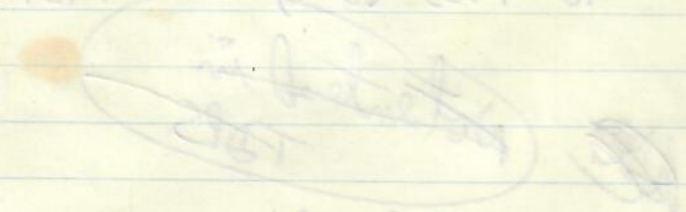

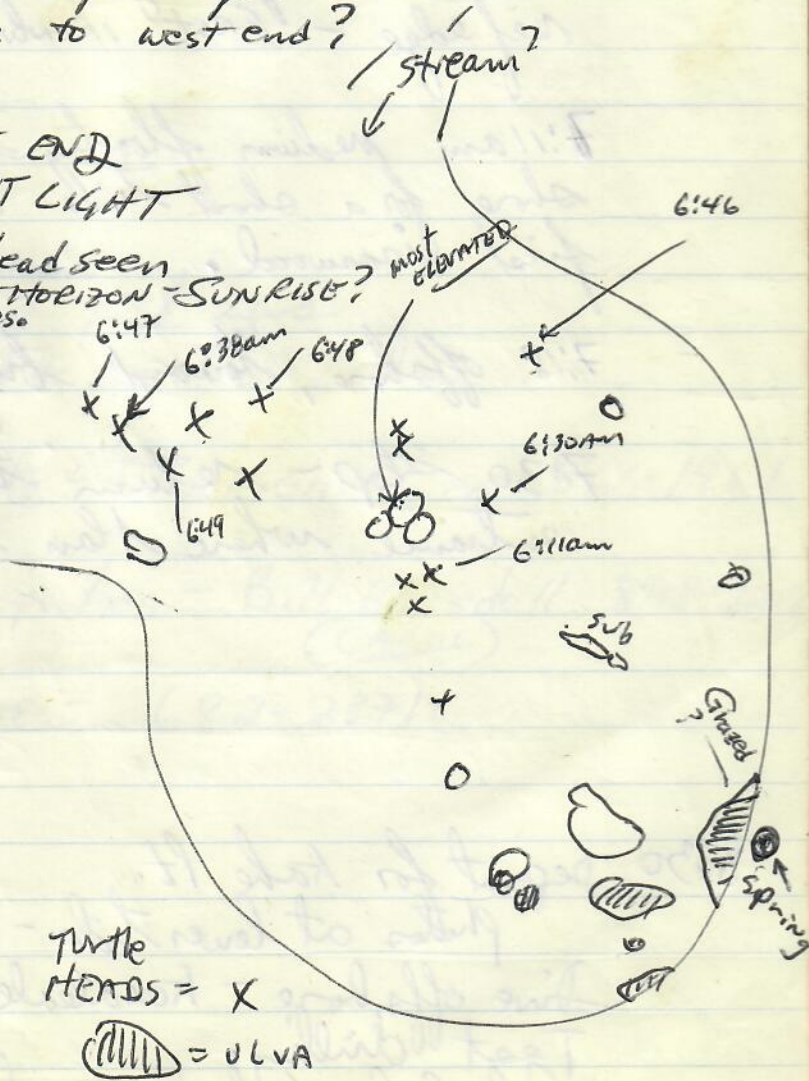
