Whale watch 4,000 hump

Volunteers counted 4,000 whales in Saturday in the annual surveys document the humpback population.

More than 600 volunteers counted 63 shoreline sightings of humpback whales in Kauai, the Big Island and Hawaii during the humpback whale watch hours Saturday.

The next count will be for March 29. The results will be released by the NOAA said.

Volunteers counted about 4,000 whales in Hawaii waters Saturday in the second of three annual surveys that attempt to document the humpback whale population.

The total count is likely inflated by multiple sightings of the same whales, according to the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, which coordinated the Hawaiian Islands Humpback Whale National Marine Sanctuary Ocean Count.

More than 600 volunteers at 63 shoreline sites on Oahu, Kauai, the Big Island and Kahoolawe participated over four hours Saturday, the NOAA said.

The next count is scheduled for March 29. The three counts will be analyzed and final results will be released in the fall, the NOAA said.

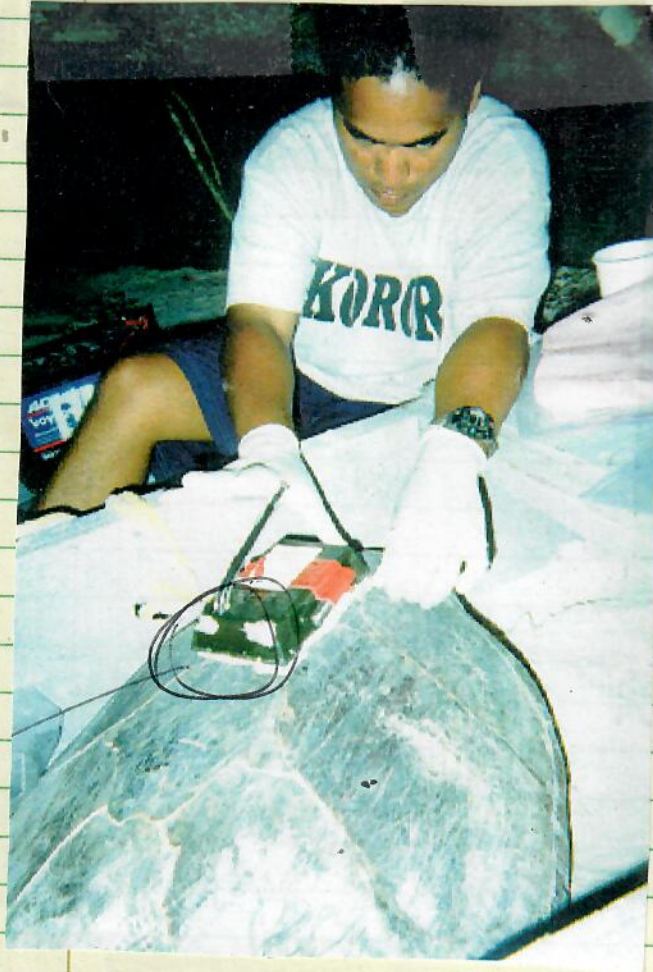

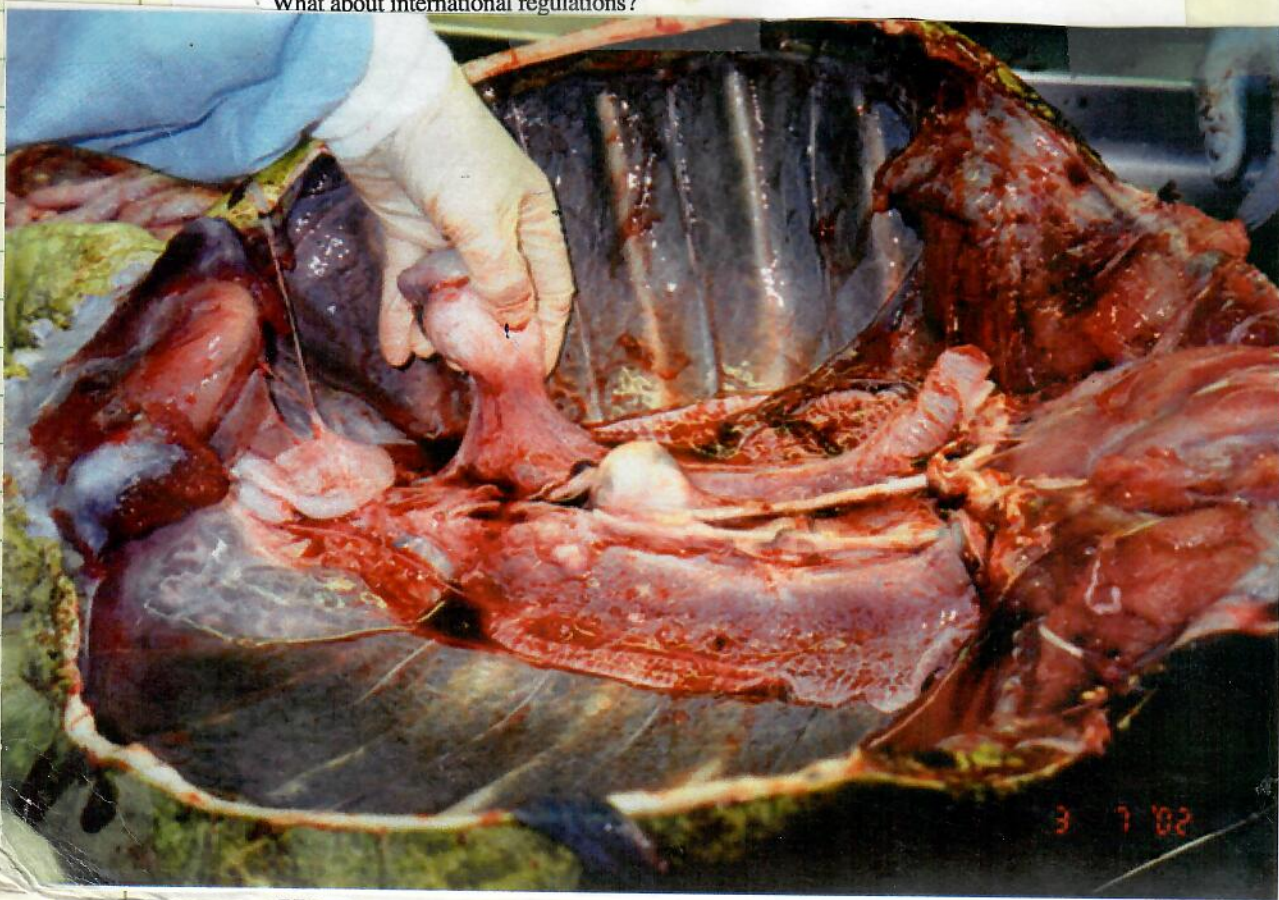
Our chief interest is in the population genetics of the turtle barnacle *Chelonibia tesudinaria* but other epibiotic barnacles could be targets as fortuitously encountered.

Chief objectives (in order of priority):

- 1) Determine whether barnacle population structure follows the population patterns of the host. This could potentially be addressed at 3 scales: Hawaii, Pacific Ocean and global.
- 2) Determine when the barnacles release larvae.
 - Is it when the host species aggregates?
 - Can they delay larval release?
 - Is there a chemical/thermal/temporal cue?
- 3) Culture the barnacles in the lab to describe reproduction, development, behavior and settlement.
 - Can settlement occur on various substrates?
 - Is there a chemical cue/turtle inducer?

What we need to find out:

- 1) Has population structure in turtles been defined and at what scales?
- 2) Can barnacles be obtained from turtles?
 - Is there ongoing research with turtles that might facilitate barnacle collection?
 - Are there researchers who might be willing to send specimens?
 - What legal and environmental considerations are there?
 - What about international regulations?

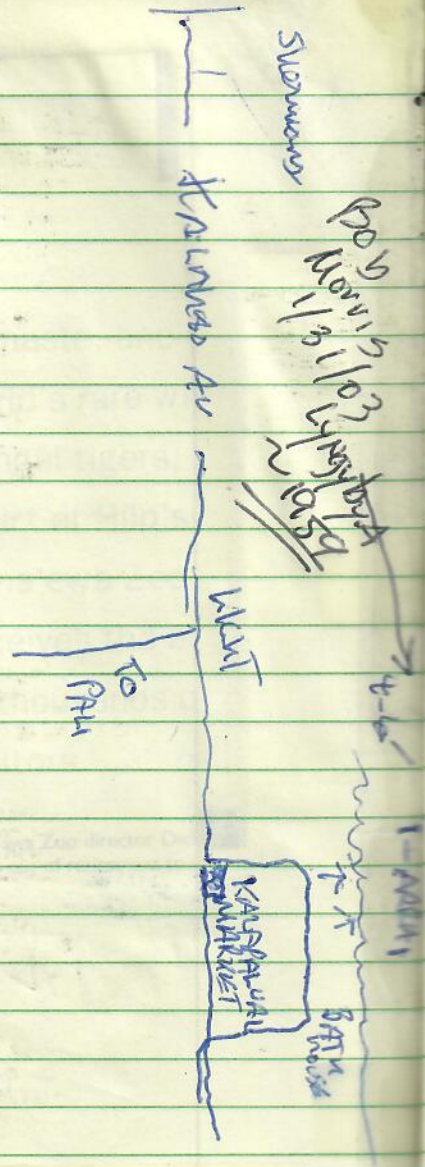

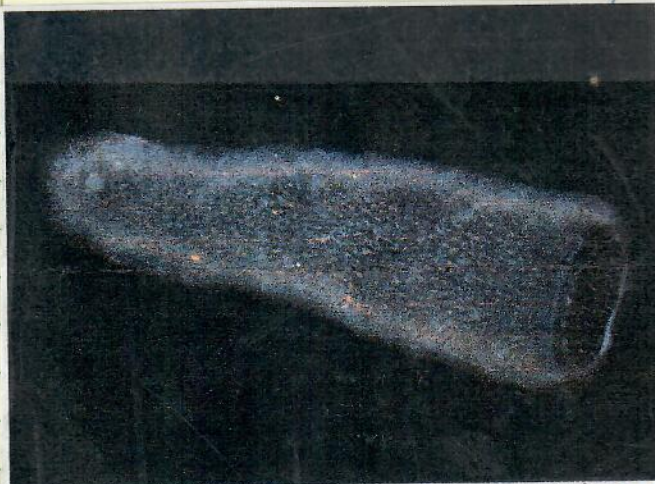

Report says manatees no longer endangered

ST. PETERSBURG, Fla. >>

Manatees should no longer be considered an endangered species because their numbers have increased over the past 30 years, according to a preliminary report by the Florida Marine Research Institute.

But the report, issued last week, also warned that greater threats from boats and loss of habitat could halve the manatee population in the next 45 years, which warrants their classification as a threatened species.

The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission, which asked for the report, will decide in January whether to list the gentle "sea cows" as threatened.

Estimates of Florida's manatee population vary, though it is estimated at around 3,000 animals.

To witness an event of this nature is very sad, and as humans our natural instinct is to save and

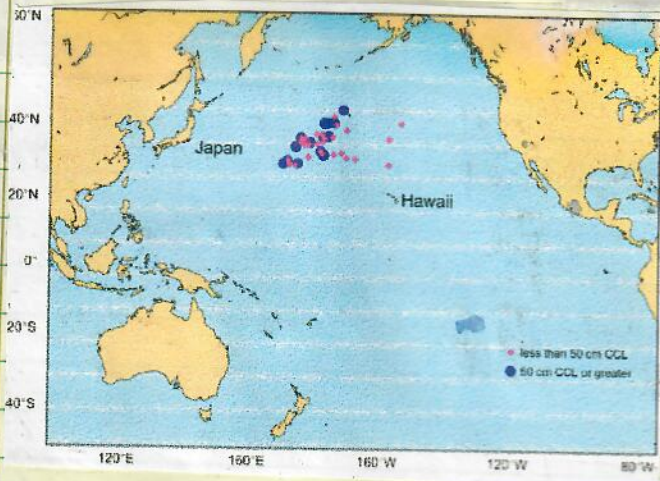
preserve and nurture, but we must realize that we should not interfere with the natural balance of nature.

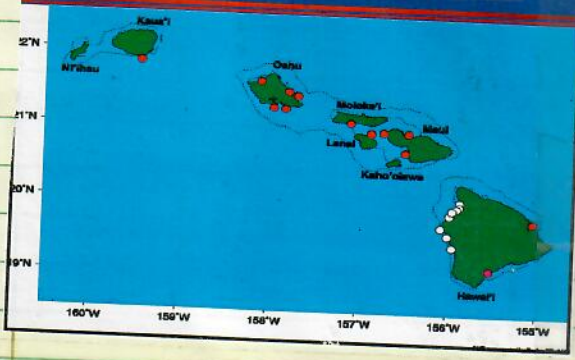

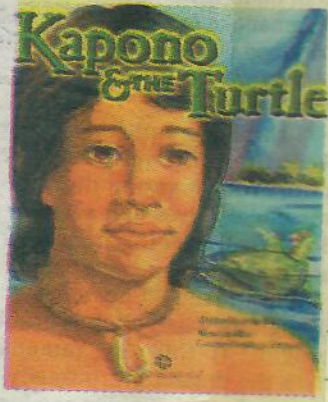

ELASTOMER**STORAGE AND SHELF LIFE**

- Keep the containers tightly closed when not in use. Do not expose to water, water vapor, or high humidity. In addition, sulfur-containing compounds such as dropper bulbs and stabilizers in plastic containers may deactivate the catalyst.
- Do not store the dropper in the catalyst bottle.
- The catalyst becomes somewhat less active with time. Simply use more catalyst to speed the curing.

CARE AND CLEANING OF INSERT

- Remove the insert daily and wash both it and the skin beneath it with warm water and mild soap. Allow to air dry thoroughly before repositioning the insert.
- Insert can be cleaned with rubbing alcohol.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

The working time is controlled by the proportion of catalyst and base. Standard mixes, giving the resulting working time, are listed on page 6.

1. Mix the base thoroughly to blend in the oil and pour desired amount into a container.
2. Using dropper, add appropriate amount of catalyst. To ensure a good mix, distribute drops of catalyst evenly over surface of base.

Do not draw the catalyst into the rubber bulb, since contact with the bulb will deactivate it. If contact occurs, discard the catalyst and rinse the dropper with rubbing alcohol. Rinse the dropper immediately after use. The glass dropper may become cloudy, but the cloudiness will not affect the catalyst.

3. Use a tongue depressor or stainless steel spoon to mix thoroughly.
4. Spread the material over the area to be covered. To help achieve a smooth surface, use a small amount of lotion on the finger tips while shaping the insert.
5. The insert can be held in place with an elastic garment or bandage. If the insert is to be worn under a splint, place the splint over the uncured elastomer so it conforms to the inside of the splint.
6. Allow to cure completely
7. Additional material can be joined to the insert—see instruction 9.
8. Change the insert when the contour of the scar changes or the insert feels loose.
9. Additional material can be joined to a cured insert by one of the following methods:
 - If the insert is fresh, simply mix another batch and apply it over the surface of the cured insert.
 - If the insert has been worn, scrape the surface with a sharp instrument to remove any oil and residue. Apply the new mixture over the scraped surface.
 - Elastomer Adhesive (Product No. A643-A1) can be used to join the two batches together. It provides a light tackiness to assist in keeping the pieces together, not a bond that will withstand shear forces.

VISION STATEMENT of the Strategic Plan for Marine Turtles of the South Pacific (drafted by participants of the Strategic Planning Meeting of the Regional Marine Turtle Conservation Project, June 1996, Apia, Western Samoa) -

I like the following also. At that meeting we were concerned about how the above statement, forged in English, might come out when translated into other languages. Several of the participants then proceeded to translate into their native tongue. And then, using that text, translate it back into English. The following is what resulted when this was done by the man from the Solomon Islands:

"It's not here yet, but we see a time when people in the Pacific and turtles are living together in harmony. The turtles will live to support the people in their needs; also turtles will have their place in the Pacific."

"You need to HAVE turtles in order for them to continue to be a part of Pacific Island cultures"

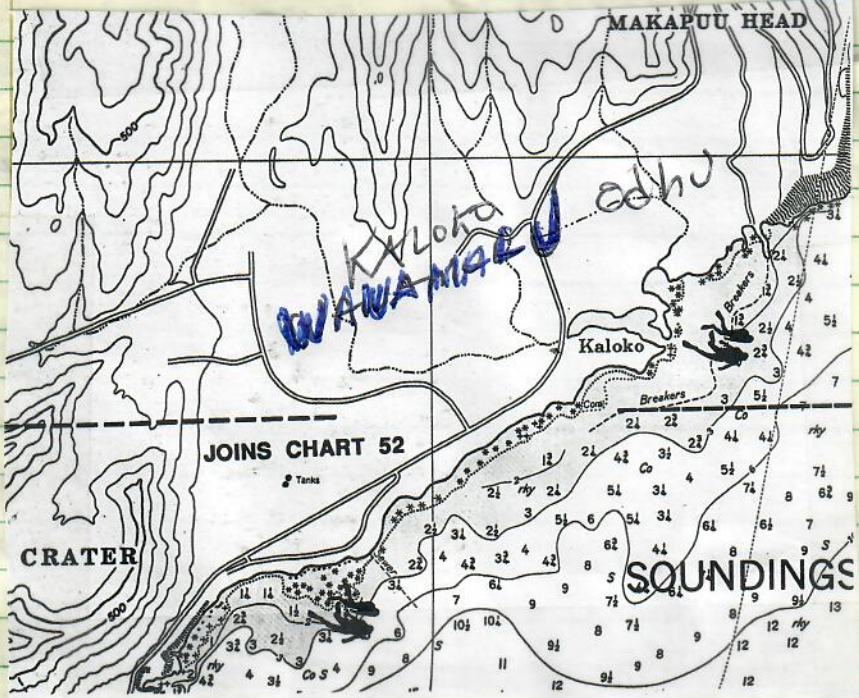

Recent Developments in the Spread and Study of Marine Turtle Fibropapillomatosis and the Fibropapilloma Associated Turtle Herpesvirus

Fibropapillomatosis (FP) of marine turtles is a neoplastic disease emerging worldwide. A Fibropapilloma Associated Turtle Herpesvirus (FPTHV) was identified by PCR studies which found herpesviral sequences present in tumors from FP-affected turtles and not in skin from unaffected turtles. Quantitative PCR (qPCR) has since demonstrated that FPTHV is present at very high copy numbers in FP tumor tissue. We have investigated two possible modes of viral transmission. We used qPCR to examine the tissues of five types of parasites (marine leeches, amphipods, blood flukes, bladder parasites, and barnacles) of FP-affected Hawaiian green turtles to determine whether any of them were valid candidate vector organisms for FPTHV. Of the parasites studied, only leeches were found to frequently carry high levels of viral DNA (10^6 to 10^7 copies per parasite organism). Further investigation showed that some of this viral DNA was associated with particles of the approximate size and density of herpesviruses. We have also found detectable levels of FPTHV sequences in seawater from Kaneohe Bay, where there is a particularly high incidence of FP, thus waterborne transmission should also be explored. Most recently, we have sequenced 22kb of the FPTHV genome. FPTHV genes UL23 through UL34 show homology to other sequenced herpesviruses, particularly Bovine Herpesvirus 1, Human Herpesvirus 3, and Merkel's Disease Virus. FPTHV genes UL23-34 lie in the same order and orientation as the homologous genes in HSV-1, confirming that FPTHV is an alphaherpesvirus.
