# Star cluster will mark start of Hawaiian year

It might not be January yet, but it is the new year this month, the Hawaiian new year, that is. Known as Makahiki, the Hawaiian new year begins when the first visible crescent of the waxing moon is seen after the star cluster Makali'i

(Pleiades) rises at

sunset. This celestial event takes place annually in November or December, this year on Nov. 18.

### CONSTELLATION SPOTLIGHT

Makali'i means the "little eyes," an appropriate moniker for this cluster of bright stars. Although there are more than 1,000 stars in this cluster, it is dominated by about six or seven bright ones visible to the unaided eye. The ability to see seven stars in this cluster was used as a test of good eyesight in old Hawaii. In modern astronomy this same group of stars is identified as M45, also called the Pleiades. According to Greek mythology, the Pleiades are seven sisters who were placed in the sky by Zeus, after they pleaded with him to help them escape the unwanted advances of the hunter Orion. The Japanese call these stars Subaru. The next time you see a Subaru car, look for this star cluster shining prominently in the logo.

The Pleiades can be seen in the night sky throughout November. Early in the month, they rise in the east just before 7 p.m. and are visible until dawn. By the end of the month, the Pleiades will already be above the horizon by sunset. Look for a bright cluster in the constellation Taurus, not far from Orion's belt.

### LEONID METEOR SHOWER

Meteor experts expect this year's Leonid shower to be a wonderful show. Meteor showers occur when Earth moves through debris from a nearby comet. This month, Earth will pass near the center of the debris stream from Comet Tempel-Tuttle, likely increasing the frequency of visible meteors. The peak night of this meteor shower is Nov. 16-17. Fortunately, it is also new moon on this night, which means that there will be no natural interfering light. The meteors will appear to radiate from the constellation Leo the lion, which rises in the east after midnight. For best viewing, head out in the hours before dawn on Nov. 17 and look east.

### PLANETARY HIGHLIGHT

On the evening of Nov. 23, look for a beautiful conjunction of the near-half moon and the bright planet Jupiter. Visible after sunset, the moon chases Jupiter across the southern sky until the duo set by midnight.

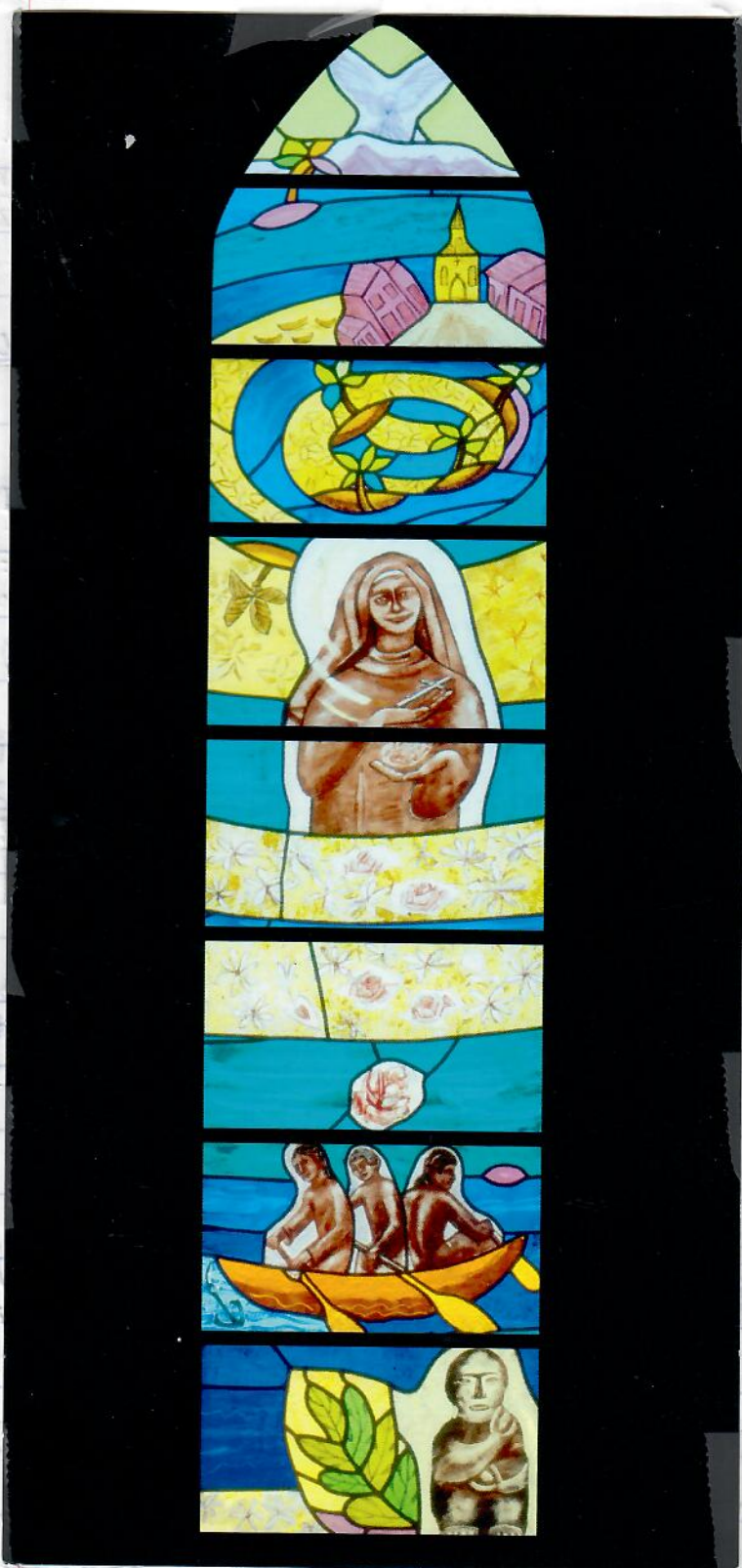

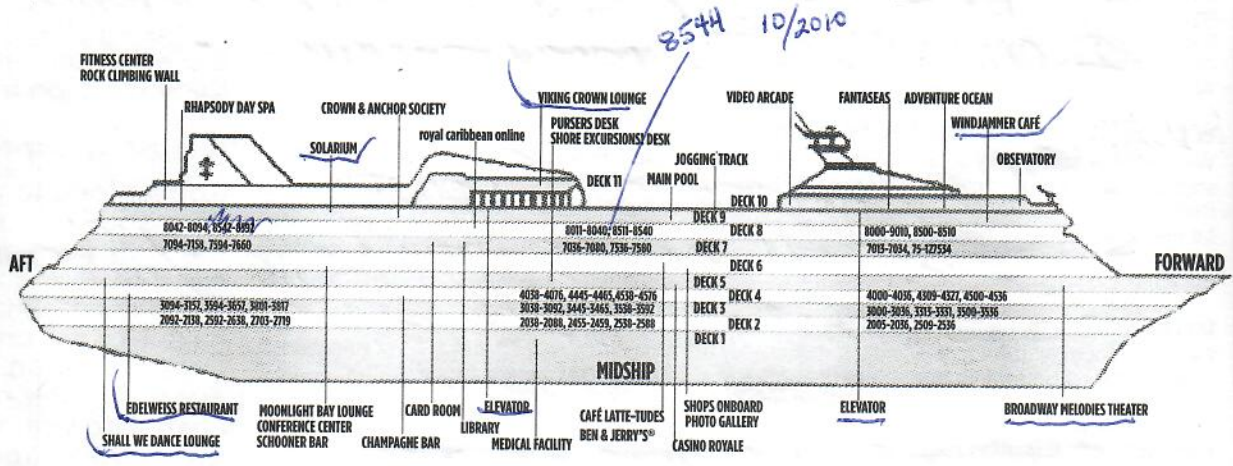

On December 7, 1941, the american base of Pearl Harbor, in the Hawaii island, was bombed by the japanese air-force, hence starting The Pacific war. On January 27, 1942, a real armada of 2 cruisers, 2 destroyers, 2 cargo boats, 2 troop carriers and one tanker left Charlston harbor in South Carolina to Bora Bora. On board the ships 4450 troopmen and 178 officers were packed, commanded by Admiral Turner who was in charge of the "Bob Cat" operation.

On February 17, 1942, the armada arrived in Bora Bora. Without knowing who was aboard the ships, the population went to welcome warmly the arrivals with their outriger canoes. 20 000 tons of materials were landed, on float stages and small boats.

Americans found out that everything had to be done. There was not enough drinking water, and no practicable roads for their vehicules and heavy engines. So, they started building roads all around the island and set up water supplies.

The military work was coming along. On June 9, 1942, the first gastank was usable. its size was 23 feet high, 52 feet across and was able to contain 150 000 liters of petrol. In July 1942, 20 others same gastank were operational with 10 others where 10 000 barrels of heavy oil could be used, the whole lot covered under the coconut trees, not far from the beach.

Also, Americans fixed on the hills 8 canons of 7 inches with anti-aircraft battery of 3 inches (D.C.A). 8 seaplanes were in charge of the air cover while buiding the landing-strip. The small islet of Motu Mute is chosen. Construction started on december 16, 1942 and the whole air base was operational by april 15, 1943.

The strip is 1,24 mile long and 145 yards large. In fact, it will receive transport air-crafts and some courier ones. In the meanwhile, the battle from settled down in the Philippines.

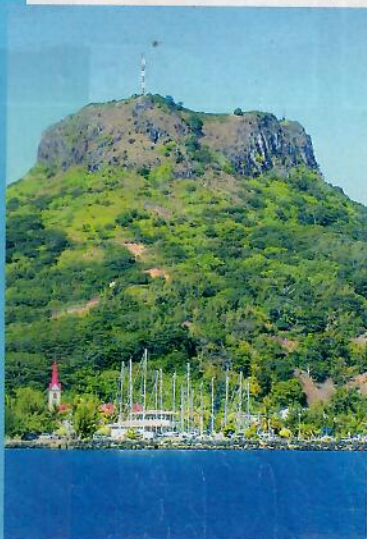

Hoani said in older days the chief "on took" off his protective belt when sitting on "back-rest" on Marae - stone <sup>UPRIGHT</sup> protected from being stabbed in back, and body guards protected their backs. Grandfather told Swaty that <sup>UPRIGHT</sup> stone, now upright, should be laying down. Grandfather also told him that when chief became old and couldn't lead any longer, that he took his suit into the interior and hid it. Person that found it became the new chief -- to not based on bloodline or family. To find it there are stones <sup>RAIATEA</sup> in Hamoa Valley (same name as a valley) (?) in Maui, there are petroglyphs pointing the way. So you follow them to find the suit. This alone doesn't make you the chief. There are 3 (or 4?) parts. Gods give approval. Strength (?), and finding suit. And - approval of people (?). # RAIATEA and TAHAA

Located nearly 200 km (125 miles) from Tahiti, Raiatea and Taha'a share the same lagoon. These two high islands have very similar geological formations with relatively high summits. The vast lagoon is full of motu, each one



more inviting than the other, with unbelievable white sand beaches. The coastline carved with deep bays offers many moorings along with incredible surf sites such as Faaroa and Miri Miri. Mt. Tefateaiti dominates Raiatea at the respectable altitude of 1,017 m (3,333 ft), the highest point in Taha'a is Mt Ohiri (590 m / 1,935 ft). Raiatea, whose name means « soft skylight » (170 km / 66 square miles) to the South is twice as large as Taha'a (89 km / 34 square miles). Nine passes around Raiatea and two around Taha'a allow communication with the surrounding ocean. A few breathtaking bays attract visitor's attention: Faaroa Bay on the Southeast of Raiatea, Haamene Bay, Hurepiti Bay, and Faaaha Bay in Taha'a.

De nombreuses tentatives pour conquérir Raiatea et Taha'a déboucheront finalement sur l'accession au pouvoir de Tamatoa IV, héritier des Pomare et de la lignée royale de Raiatea. Sa famille régnera sur l'île et sur Taha'a, revenu dans le giron, jusqu'au début de notre siècle. En 1847, la France reconnaissait l'indépendance des îles-sous-le-Vent. Mais 40 ans plus tard, l'annexion de l'archipel par le gouverneur Lacascade, provoquera une insurrection conduite par Teraupo. Pendant près de dix ans, la guerre fera rage au sein de ces îles. Finalement, les Français l'emporteront, non sans mal, et Raiatea et Taha'a rentreront dans le rang.

The island of Raiatea was considered by the ancient Polynesians as the cradle of their thousand-year old civilization. It was in this island in the Society archipelago that they first chose to settle over a thousand years ago. Its ancient name, Havai'i Nui, means «Big Springing Waters». James Cook anchored there in 1769 after Wallis' discovery of Tahiti. This was the beginning of a delicate colonization, marked by fratricide wars. At the end of the 18th century, The Chiefs of Bora Bora, Tefaaoroa and Mai, successfully conquered Raiatea and Taha'a. A power struggle followed to gain control of both islands. but it was Tamatoa III, the son of Tatu, who unified Raiatea and Taha'a some thirty years later. Converted to Christianity, he implemented a code of obedience to the missionaries, which spread to all Leeward Islands, except for Huahine. At the beginning of the last century, the Pomare family, then reigning over Tahiti, tried to establish their power over the other Society Islands. Many attempts to conquer Raiatea and Taha'a finally lead to the rise to power of Tamatoa IV, heir of the Pomare family and the Royal family of Raiatea. His descendance reigned over Raiatea and Taha'a until the beginning of our century. In 1847, France recognized the independence of the Leeward Islands, but 40 years later, the annexation of the archipelago by Governor Lacascade, caused an uprising led by Teraupo. For ten years war ravaged these islands. Finally the French won, with many difficulties, and Raiatea and Taha'a surrendered.

# TAHAA

Located inside the same lagoon as Raiatea, the high island of Taha'a is nevertheless very different from her bigger sister. Its 4,500 islanders are very proud of their island. Spread in eight villages along the shore, they live in harmony with the trade winds. The few guest houses and other hotels of the island offer their guests a 'preview of Paradise. The many motu circling the island are among the most gorgeous in Polynesia. The depth of Taha'a's lagoon (10 to 30 meters (30 to 90 feet) allow to sail full circle around the island in a sailboat or a power boat. Many shells are found there as well as beautiful fishes like rays, barracudas and dolphins, for the divers' delight.

Pearl farms have recently been built there, as the lagoon water is ideal for black pearl farming. Along with vanilla, this activity has, in a few years, become a major economic resource of this quiet island. The partially



84

paved road around the island will make you discover gorgeous view points along its 67 km (42 miles). The villages' surroundings are decorated with flower trees and well maintained. Elsewhere, large coconut groves still shelter the burrows of tupa (land crabs). The road crossing the island from Haamene to Patio, the main town, passes along a river and a beautiful forest of mape trees. From Vaitoetoe Pass, the view to the neighboring bays is breathtaking. It is a kingdom for mango trees, pineapple fields, and traditional taro farms. From the port of Uturoa, shuttles and activities speed canoe, ensure transportation to Taha'a which has no airport. Freighters bring supplies to both islands.
