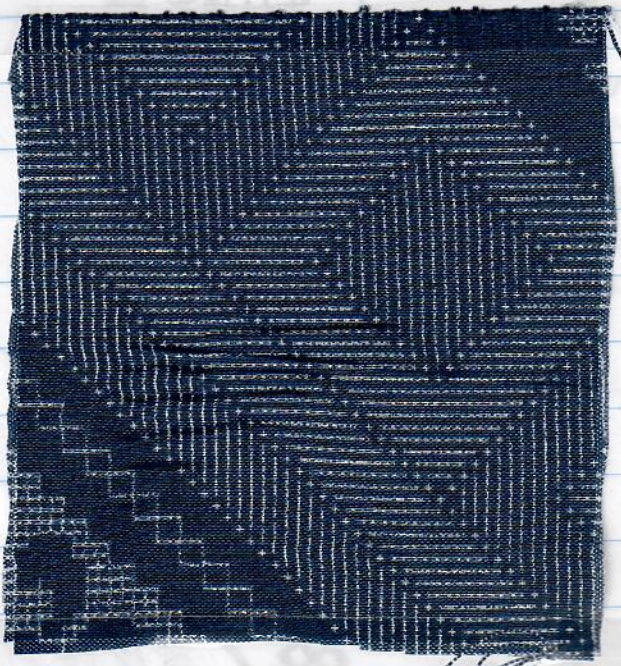

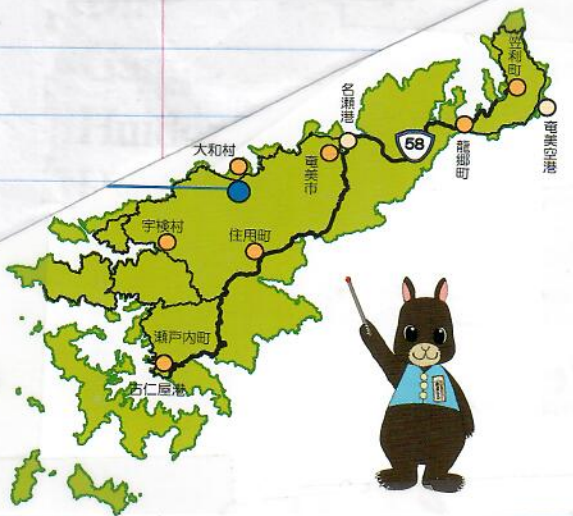

全国各地のウミガメ研究者が来島。開催に合わせて、地元小

中学校への出前授業や海岸調査などを実施。午後からは、素晴らしきハワイ諸島のウミガメたち・驚異的な回復を遂げた40年間」というテーマでバラーズ氏が講演した。

ミガメの頭数が67頭だったと説明。当時は観光が盛んになってきたという背景もあり、観光客に提供する食としてのウミガメ提供など、商業的な利用が減少につながったと指摘した。

最初の調査から約40年が過ぎた14年の調査では、846頭と大幅に増加し、調査開始から最も多くのウミガメを確認。バラーズ氏は「この成功はハワイの地元の人によるもの。『数が回復するまでは、食料利用などをしてほしくない』という願いを聞き、長い

間待つてくれたからこでできた」と語った。

講演中、観光客のすくそばでエサを食べるウミガメや、アラシと並んで休憩するウミガメなどの写真から、ウミガメが増加したこと起こった変化を紹介。今後の調査についてバラーズ氏は「日本や中国などの東アジアの文化的なウミガメについて調べていきたい」と話した。

講演後には質疑応答もあり、積極的に質問する参加者の姿も見られた。

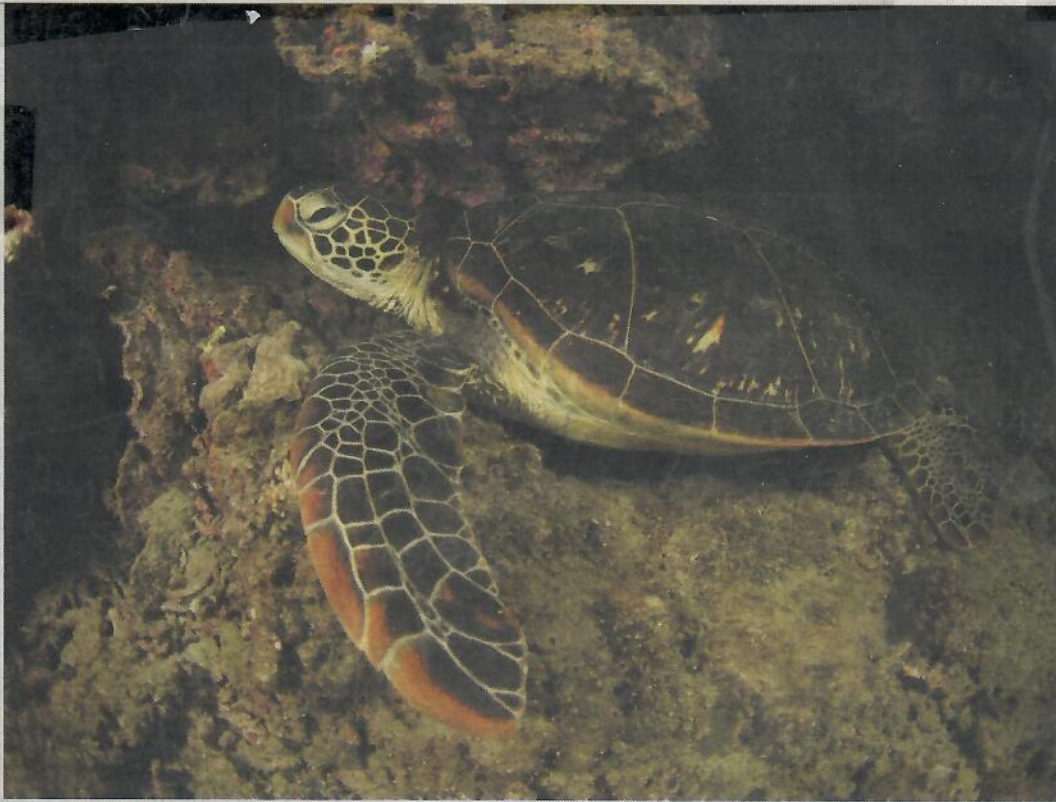

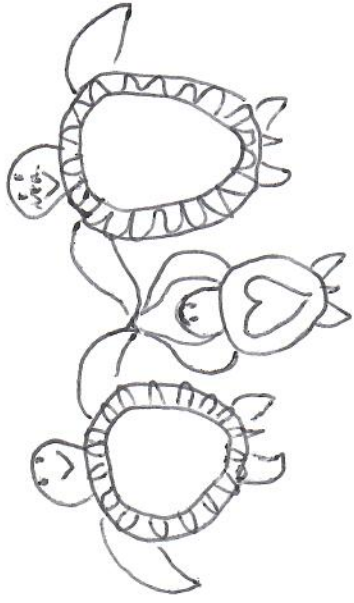

CHINA / USA MILESTONE

A proposal authored by G. Balazs, J. Seminoff (SWFSC), T. Work (USGS), and J. Wang (PIFSC) was prepared to convene an invitational China/ USA sea turtle workshop in Hawaii under the Living Marine Resources bilateral initiative. The proposal was subsequently endorsed and approved by NMFS Headquarters and the Chinese Academy of Fishery Sciences in Beijing. The workshop was held August 25-29, 2014. Nine scientists participated from the China region using non-USA travel funds. Areas represented included Hainan Island, Hong Kong, Taiwan, and Mainland China. Four of the participants, were university professors, three were government biologists, one was a graduate student, and one represented an NGO. Workshop activities consisted of a mix of classroom presentations, exchange of information and formulation of ideas for future actions and collaborative research, and actual hands-on fieldwork with sea turtles. Two of the several ways forward agreed upon for cooperation consisted of a follow-up workshop in Mainland China in late 2015, and reciprocal visiting scientists for 1-2 month periods.

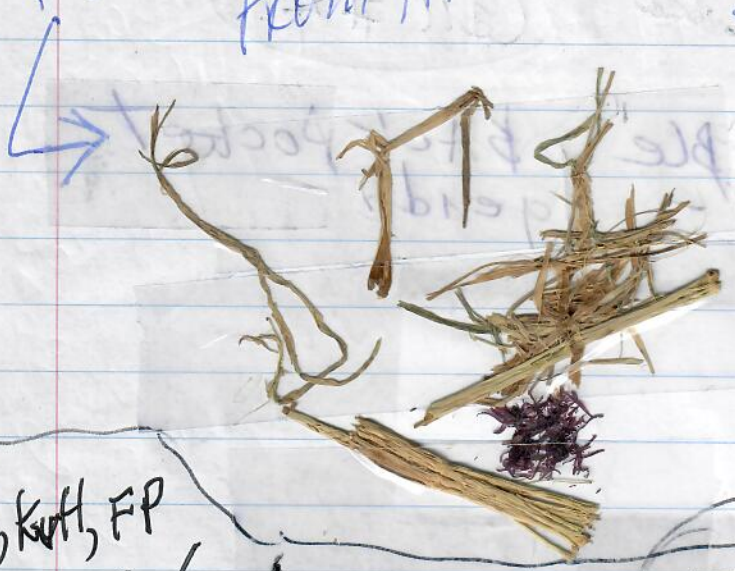

KAPOHO OBJECTIVES:

Our goals:

Sample 20 green turtles for blood, mouth algae, and scute scrapings from Kapoho for BEMAST, taking blood within 15 min of capture. Recaptures that NIST sampled in the past would not be refused, they are preferred.

Why?

Kapoho is targetted because it's a site with higher incidence of FP, so getting tumored turtles in this sample set is a definite goal. We have mouth algae from Kiholo, Kailua, Palmyra, and Saipan, but not Kapoho. We've been successful at getting 4-6 samples of mouth algae from each site so far (out of 20 turtles per site). The mouth algae samples will be measured for either metabolomics (Tracey's NMR method) or for the hydroxylated halogenated organic compounds I found in the turtles in our 2014 paper. Also, I was not collected the PAI gene tube of blood when we went to Kapoho in 2011, but Lisa Komoroske needs this type of blood for her gene expression study and wants to focus on gene expression in tumored and non-tumored turtles. She applied for an NRC post-doc at SWFSC, fingers crossed she gets it.

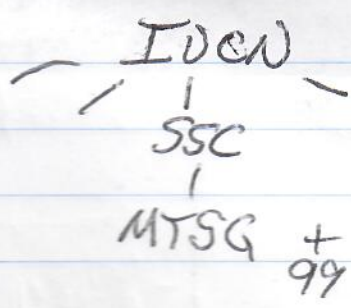
