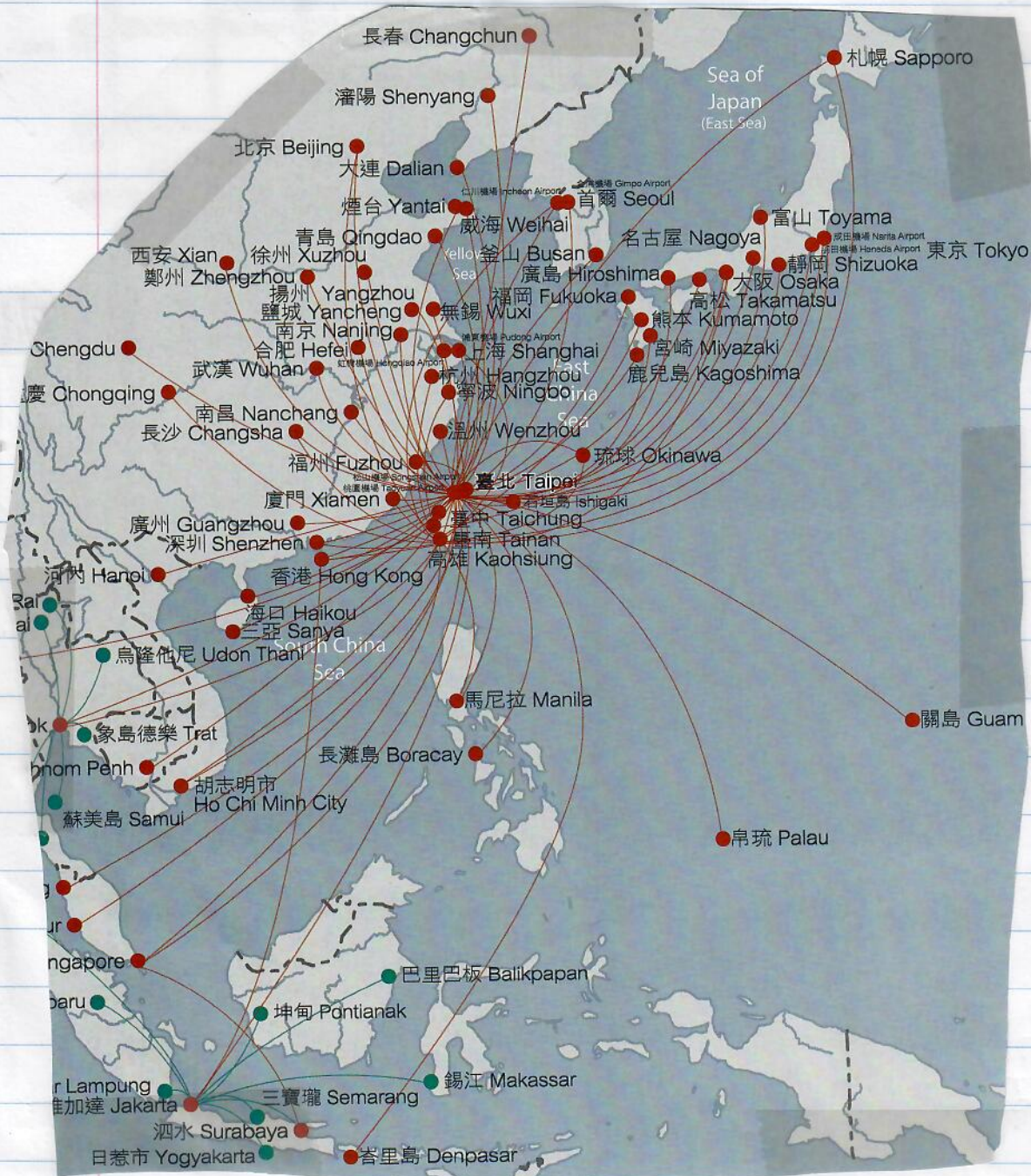

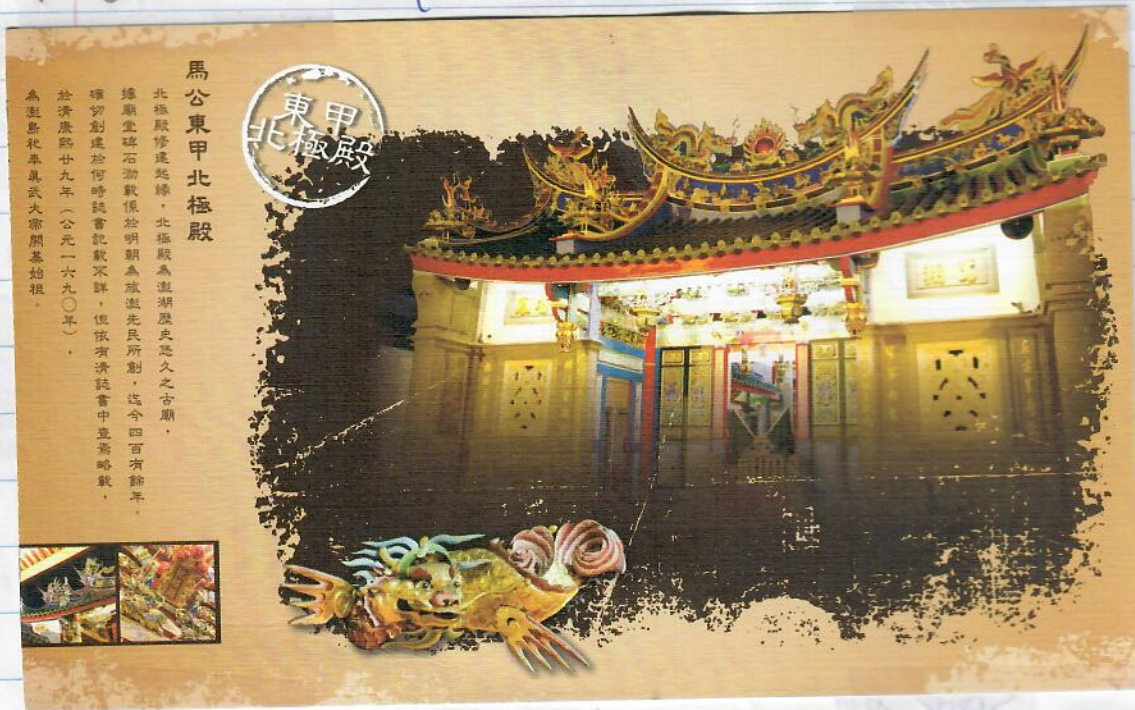

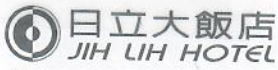

ABSTRACT: Seven species of ocean turtles exist globally as the descendants of ancient and resilient reptilian lineages that have adapted and survived for millions of years. Over the course of human history, an array of relationships has developed with turtles, and especially marine turtles amongst coastal and island peoples. Turtles are woven deeply into the cultural and traditional fabric of humanity, with uses ranging from food for families; sacrifices to the Gods; pets; utilitarian implements; ornamentation; medicine; funerary; foretelling the future; and spiritual strength and protection. Today all seven species of marine turtles are considered endangered by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN), with the exception of the population of green sea turtles (*Chelonia mydas*) in the Hawaiian Islands. Several other sea turtle populations besides Hawaii are also showing remarkable restoration from over-exploitation due to efficient fishing technologies and human encroachment into previously pristine turtle habitats. At the same time there are many sea turtle stocks at seriously low levels that continue to decline. This dichotomy in sea turtle conservation status is one of the great challenges of our time in balancing appropriate protective measures along with limited sustainable use, where such harvest and other forms of human utilization might be advantageous to both turtles and people. Conservation strengths and weaknesses of the life history of all sea turtles include: migrations over great distances to breed; keen navigational abilities; coming ashore to lay eggs in the sand; newly hatched young that travel far from shore to live on the high seas; and relatively slow rates of growth causing delayed adult sexual maturity. Successful conservation programs that endure are best built with local communities as their foundation. National legislation and international conventions, based on sound ecological principles, clearly also have importance. However, strategies for conservation are made robust and equitable when they integrate cultural and traditional components forged at the local level by the very people closest to the turtles and their environment. China and all of East Asia have vigorous and growing sea turtle conservation programs that deserve praise, support, and partnership to improve the status of regional stocks.

This presentation will rely heavily on photography and other imagery to illustrate the above biological facets of sea turtles, of human and turtle cultural links, and the speaker's life experiences and conservation viewpoints.

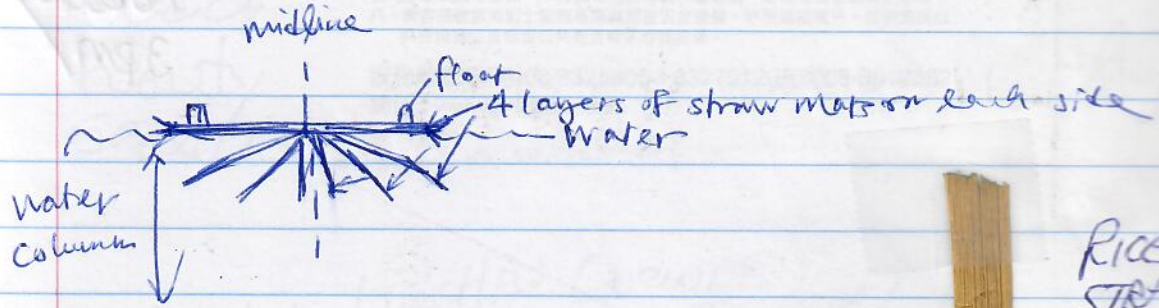

Due to the sudden and heavy rainfall, the Taiwan Railway Administration's Chiayi train station officials said that 11 trains and 2,000 passengers were delayed after the railway system was shut down temporarily because of low visibility.

The Chiayi City Fire Department said that many drivers asked for help after being trapped on flooded roads, but no one was injured.

Chiayi County Government said that two elderly who live alone were trapped in their residences, and needed rescue by local firefighters.

Meanwhile, the Lao-Nong River, which is located in Kaohsiung City, rose up suddenly and sharply due to heavy rain and destroyed a temporary bridge, so the local officials closed down the bridge's entry.

According to the CWB, a new front will bring unstable weather and heavy rain to the entire island for the rest of the week.

The CWB said that the front will hover over Taiwan until June 7, so all areas have to be alert to heavy rain for the rest of the week.

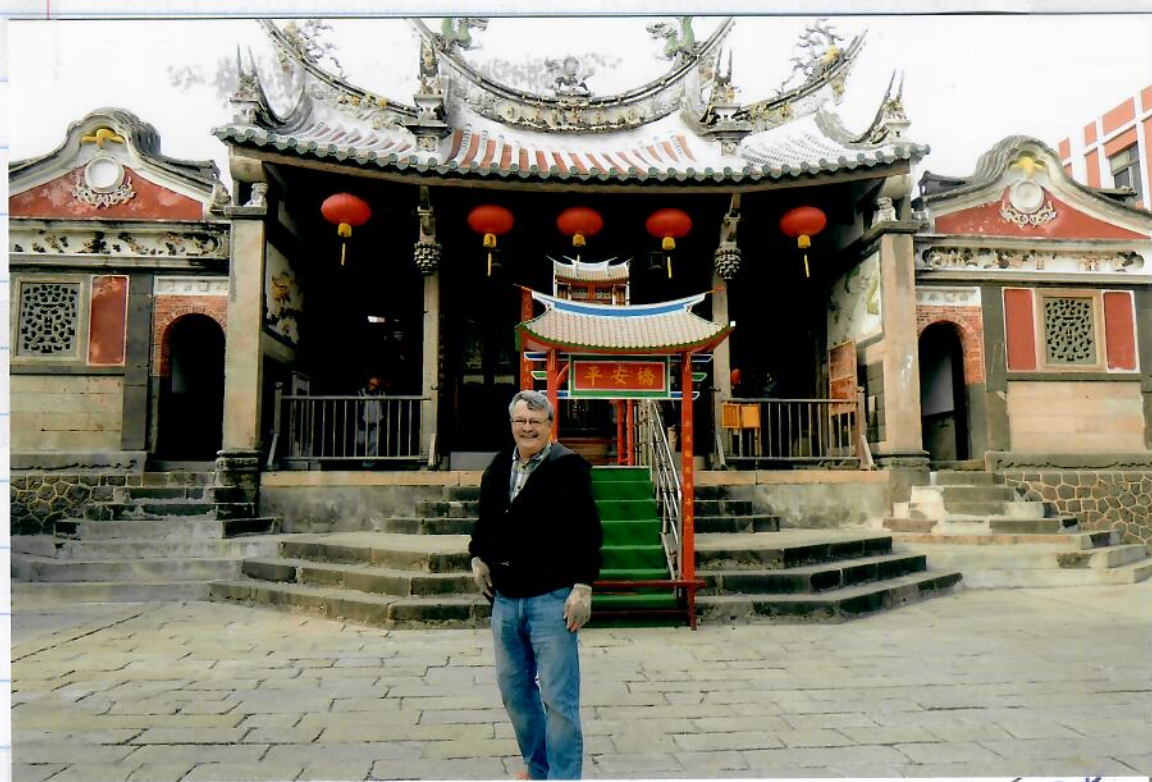

# Memory of crackdown flickers in tiny museum in Hong Kong

To find the world's only museum chronicling the brutal crackdown on the 1989 Tiananmen protests, look for the skinny office building wedged between a Tibetan-themed pub and a sports bar on a side street on the edge of a Hong Kong tourist district.

With nothing to indicate its location, aside from a listing on the lobby directory, there's no clue for passers-by that it houses the June 4th Museum, dedicated to preserving the memory of one of the darkest periods in China's recent past through photographs, artifacts, videos and written histories of the events.

Yet a steady stream of visitors, many from mainland China, has been trickling in since it was opened in April. The interest shows that even though authorities have deleted the events from China's official record, their memory flickers 25 years on in Hong Kong.

The protests remain a taboo topic in mainland China, and Beijing has never given a full accounting of what happened during the crackdown that killed hundreds, possibly thousands. But in Hong Kong, which retains Western-style civil liberties unseen on the mainland, the mem-

property deed and that visitors would swamp the building's two small elevators.

"We are confident about our legal position," Lee said.

Committee members could not be reached for comment. But committee member Yeung Cho-ming, secretary-general of a plastic manufacturing trade group, told the South China Morning Post newspaper in April that the museum is "definitely a political problem" and that they were afraid it would "bring us trouble."

The museum, just 75 square meters, is hidden away on the fifth floor of the nondescript Foo Hoo Center in Kowloon's Tsim Sha Tsui district.

Staffers say they see about 200 visitors a day on weekdays and 500 on weekends. About half are mainland Chinese.

The museum features a timeline of events, black-and-white news photos of scenes from those tumultuous days, including the famous shot of "tank man" — the lone protester who stood in front of a line of tanks.

Archival news footage of the student leaders is broadcast continuously on a computer tablet mounted on a wall. Another tablet shows a documentary in English. Nearly all the other exhibits are in Chinese.

video interviews with parents talking about their sons or daughters killed in the square.

The museum's collection of 100 artifacts, 16,000 photos, 33 rolls of microfilm and hundreds of books and magazines will be rotated regularly. Visitors can write messages of support on a narrow chalkboard running the length of the wall.

Souvenirs on sale include USB memory sticks — some unmarked, others with logos — loaded with photos and documents and videos on the crackdown, as well as T-shirts, mugs and miniature "Goddess of Democracy" statues.

Penny Leung, visiting from Malaysia — and who was a Hong Kong high school student in 1989 — said it was important to have the museum as a way to counter Beijing's influence, which has been growing since it regained control of the city from Britain in 1997.

"Everyone should come to see history, to view the truth because the Chinese government has been concealing the truth. They do not have the guts to face history," said Leung, 42.

Wei Ying-jun, a photographer from Shanghai who was visiting Hong Kong, said it was important to keep the memory of the protests alive.



ory of the Tiananmen protests are just one of many reminders of how the city's differences with China continue to widen 17 years after it ceased to be a British colony. Every year the city holds a candlelight vigil to commemorate the victims that's attended by tens of thousands, with numbers rising in recent years.

But otherwise, Hong Kong residents are more worried about the hordes of mainland visitors buying up everything from baby formula to luxury apartments and their bad manners, such as eating on the subway and letting their children urinate on the street.

"The world memory of it is fading and the younger generation doesn't know of it in China, where it's also banned," said Lee Cheuk Yan, chairman of the Labour Party and head of the pro-democracy group that operates the museum. "So we think it's very important for us to preserve this historical truth."

Lee said the museum aims to challenge the Communist Party to overturn its official verdict that the mostly student-led protests were a "counterrevolutionary riot."

His group, the Hong Kong Alliance In Support of Democratic Patriotic Movements in China, bought the space for nearly 10 million Hong Kong dollars (US\$1.3 million). But in a sign of the discomfort felt by some businesses about being associated with the Tiananmen protest, the building owners' committee is taking the group to court. The committee says the office's use as an exhibition hall violates the

A labyrinthine layout reflects "the maze which is the China of today," according to its website.

Visitors walking down an L-shaped section turn into a brightly lit passageway before emerging in front of a two-meter tall replica of the "Goddess of Democracy" statue that was famously erected by the protesters in Tiananmen Square. A copy of the statue is also displayed at Hong Kong's annual vigil.

"Entrance into turbulence, through the maze of chaos and exit onto democratic light," the website says.

A small screening room shows

"Nowadays in fact, mainland people in public situations, even so-called intellectuals at lectures, will skip over this part of history," said Wei, 35, who as a boy was only dimly aware of what happened during and after the protests. He said his interest grew at university, where he was able to find more information on the school's internal network.

He said he was disappointed that officials had tried to sweep the protests under the rug.

"These events happened," Wei said. "It is a fact. But you can't treat it as if it didn't happen."

# China creating runway on reef in the contested South China Sea

**BEIJING**>> A major reclamation project by the Chinese government on a tiny reef 500 miles from its mainland would enable China to land military aircraft there, expanding its reach into the contested South China Sea, analysts say.

The analysts' report came as a group affiliated with the People's Liberation Army hosted an international conference Friday and Saturday in Beijing intended to showcase President Xi Jinping's call for a new regional security architecture based on the concept of Asia for Asians, minimizing the role of the United States.

"Asian countries bear primary responsibility for the security of their region," China's vice foreign minister, Liu Zhenmin, said at the Xiangshan Forum held by the China Association for Military Science.

New satellite imagery reported Thursday by IHS Jane's Defence showed construction of an island about 9,850 feet long and 985 feet wide at Fiery Cross Reef in the Spratly Islands. The new island could support a runway and apron, the security group said.

Dredgers are also creating a harbor that would be large enough to dock warships, Jane's said in its report.

China has been expanding its footprint in the Spratly archipelago for much of this year by moving sand onto reefs and shoals and creating at least three new islands that could serve as surveillance bases and as resupply stations for vessels, according to Jane's.

But the report said the dredging operations at Fiery Cross are by far the largest, and are intended to coerce other claimant countries in the archipelago, which include Vietnam and the Philippines, to eventually relinquish their possessions.

China claims about 90 percent of the South China Sea, one of the world's busiest trading routes, based on a line drawn after World War II that covers water south of China, around Malaysia and north to the Philippines. Other countries do not recognize the U-shaped line.

The plans for an airstrip at Fiery Cross Reef were most likely intended for China to land military aircraft that could monitor an air defense identification zone, known as an ADIZ, that China appears likely to create in the future, said Bonnie S. Glaser, senior adviser for Asia at the Center for Strategic and International Studies in Washington.

# TV series' low necklines cut by Chinese censors

At the end of December, a popular television series chronicling China's most famous empress suddenly went on a four-day hiatus. When it returned on New Year's Day, the low-cut necklines and squeezed bosoms had vanished.

Instead, the screen was filled with close-up shots showing only the heads of the female characters in the period piece, which depicts the seventh-century Tang Dynasty, an era when a woman's beauty was defined partly by plumpness.

No one has claimed responsibility for the awkward cropping, but it is widely believed to be the work of the country's prudish censors.

The changes have drawn a wave of mockery from a public fed up with ham-handed censorship. Chinese have lit up social media with complaints and jokes, with some posting cropped photos of celebrities and drawings that add in the missing cleavages to show the absurdity of the cuts.

"It was not a public issue, but has become one after shameless officials wielded their powerful administrative powers," Ren Zhiqiang, a businessman who has been outspoken on social issues, wrote on his microblog. "What people are concerned about is not cleavage, but that a bunch of cultural hooligans are in charge of making approvals."

Calls to the State Administration of Press, Publication, Radio, Film and Television went unanswered Thursday and Friday. The administration does not always issue its decrees publicly, giving its orders instead directly to publishers and producers.

In recent years the regulat-

ing agency has issued a series of edicts, saying TV programming should be wholesome and avoid smutty material that would corrupt social morals. It has banned plots that involve one-night stands, wife-swapping, female protagonists falling in love with more than one man, and the use of sex in military espionage.

Bizarrely, authorities have also banned plots with time travel, a move they say is aimed at preserving historical integrity.

The risqué necklines in "The Empress of China" were the latest images to fall under the agency's cleaver.

The 80-episode series tells the story of Wu Zetian, who was a concubine to a Tang emperor but ascended to the apex of power and ruled officially under her self-proclaimed Zhou Dynasty. She is the only recorded woman to rule China in her own right and has been the subject of many TV and film productions.

The empress was played by Fan Bingbing, a rising star who appeared in the 2014 Hollywood blockbuster "X-Men: Days of Future Past."

The series has lavish costumes with the low necklines believed to have been commonplace in the age of Wu, and all 80 episodes already had been produced when the changes were imposed after 17 episodes were aired.

In one survey by the industry research group Zero Power Intelligence, nearly 40 percent say the cuts were too prudish, though another quarter of the 13,768 respondents said the show was now appropriate for all ages.

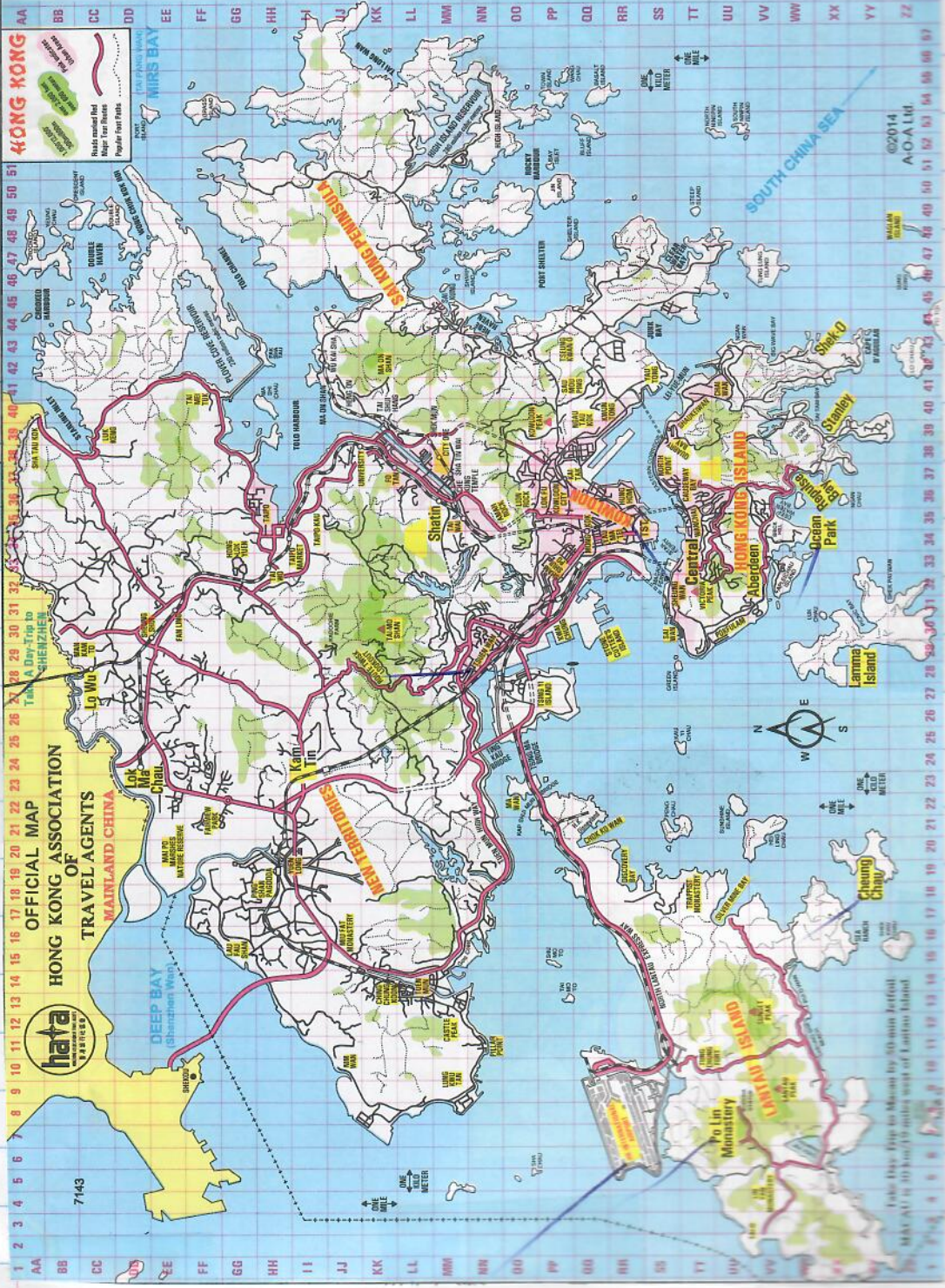

# I'm new Fiji PM, says coup leader

Fiji coup leader Voreqe Bainimarama declared himself the Pacific nation's new prime minister yesterday, four days after the country's first democratic election in eight years since he took power.

Although the final vote count has not been released, provisional results show Bainimarama's Fiji First Party heading towards a clear victory.

"My fellow Fijians, as you know Fiji First has won the general elections and I will lead the new government to serve the nation," he told thousands of cheering supporters gathered in a sports stadium.

"I am deeply honored and humbled that the Fijian people trust me to lead them into our new and true democracy."

The former military strongman also told the crowd he would attend the upcoming United Nations General Assembly to outline the nation's progress.

Bainimarama's victory came after the Fiji Electoral Office showed Fiji First with 59.1 percent of support after votes had been counted at 88 percent of the polling booths. This would give Fiji First 32 seats in the 50-seat parliament.

"I give you my absolute promise that we will govern for the well-being of all Fijians," Bainimarama said.

Bainimarama, 60, seized power in a bloodless coup in December 2006 saying he needed to end widespread corruption and root out entrenched discrimination against ethnic Indians, who make up about 40 percent of the 900,000 population.

## Hong Kong's 'Illegal' Vote for Democracy

More than 700,000 Hong Kong residents—about 10% of the population—voted online and at polling stations in the early stages of an unofficial 10-day referendum on electoral reform that began on June 20. City authorities said they would not acknowledge the results of the exercise, while Beijing dismissed the poll as a joke.

**THE BACKGROUND** An ex-British colony that reverted to Chinese control in 1997, Hong Kong operates semiautonomously, with its citizens enjoying more freedom than their counterparts on the Chinese mainland. But many are worried about Beijing's growing influence on the city's affairs.

**THE BALLOT** Organized by a protest group to rally support for pro-democracy reform and preserve the city's autonomy, the referendum asks locals to choose among three proposals for changing the way Hong Kong selects its leader, the chief executive. All three involve a vote for candidates proposed by the public. The Chinese and Hong Kong governments say the candidates should be vetted by a nomination committee.

**WHAT'S NEXT** The group behind the vote has threatened to organize protests if authorities don't meet its demands. But those in power show little sign of listening, and the state-run paper *Global Times* labeled the poll an "illegal farce."

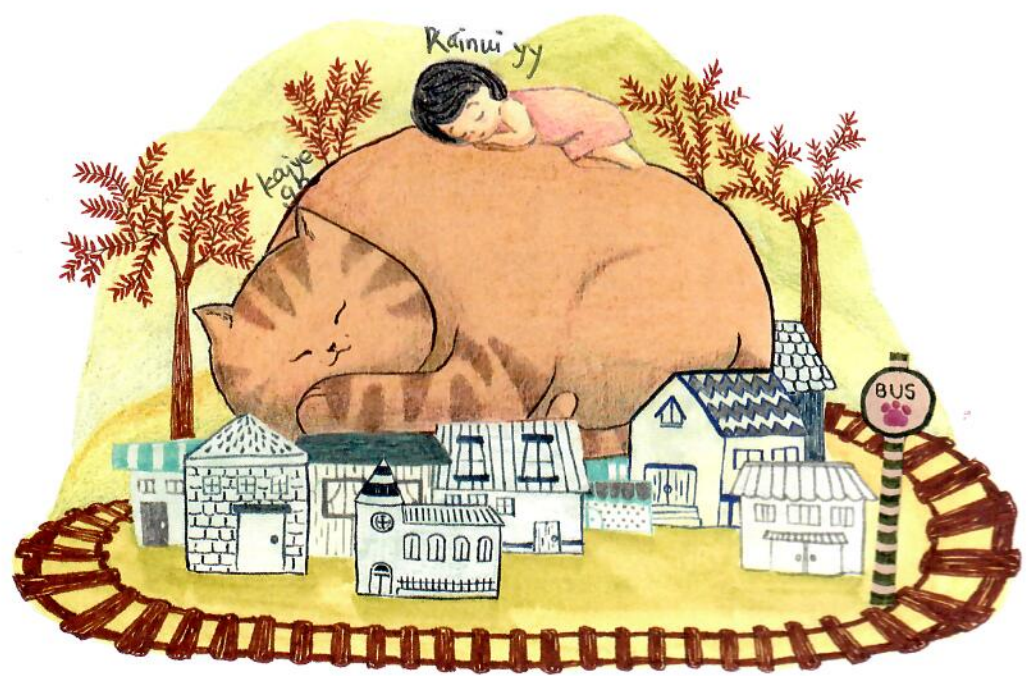

# October 1 banquet to start Occupy Central

Occupy Central is likely to start on October 1 with around 12,000 people expected to turn out.

In his Facebook page yesterday, co-founder and initiator of the civil disobedience movement Benny Tai Yiu-ting said "a banquet will be held in Central to fight for democracy in Hong Kong" on the day when "others are celebrating the nation's big day."

The article, entitled "A time for banquet," was posted on Facebook at around 10am.

Tai also said it would be a large banquet, featuring 1,000 tables – in effect 12,000 people.

Tai said he "welcomed those who support and are willing to achieve democracy to attend the banquet."

"You are also most welcome even if you only want to come and watch the banquet."

Tai wrote that throughout the 17 years following reunification, people have never genuinely experienced "Hong Kong people ruling Hong Kong" under the "one country, two systems" principle.

Instead, they were ruled by a Hongkonger appointed by the Chinese Communist Party.

Because of the series of faults within the administration, the voices for universal suffrage have been spread to different classes with many perplexed by the delay in achieving this, Tai added.

He said Occupy Central is not the last step in the fight for democracy but the first step of a democratic movement in a new era.

"The scale of the first Occupy Central will map

out its future direction," he said. "Occupy Central is the next watershed in the democracy development after the July 1 demonstration in 2003."

The Civil Human Rights Front has withdrawn its application for a rally on October 1 as this was rejected earlier by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.

Front convener Johnson Yeung Ching-yin said it would ask its supporters to join the one organized by the Occupy Central initiators.

Meanwhile, an anti-Occupy Central group comprising representatives of six business sectors – including tourism, retail and catering – has been set up. Protect Central Campaign's convener, Ho Kwan-yiu, said all of its members do not have a political background.

"We agree not to occupy Central and protect our living, but to use a peaceful and rational way to fight for universal suffrage."
