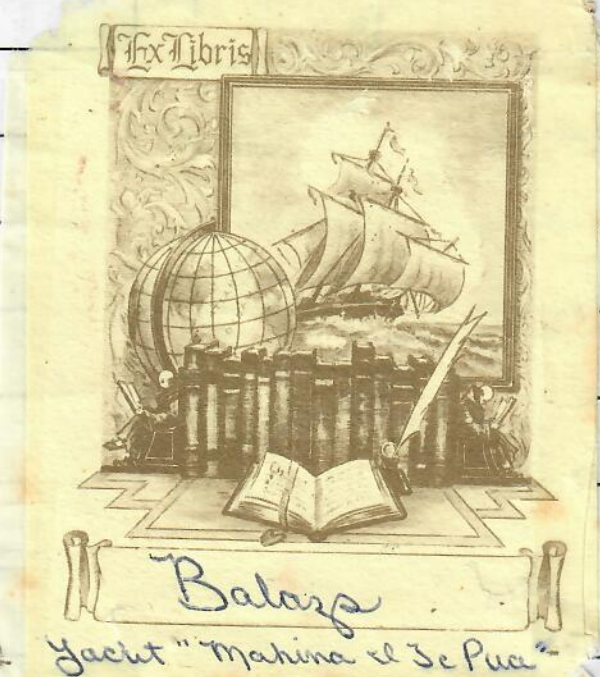

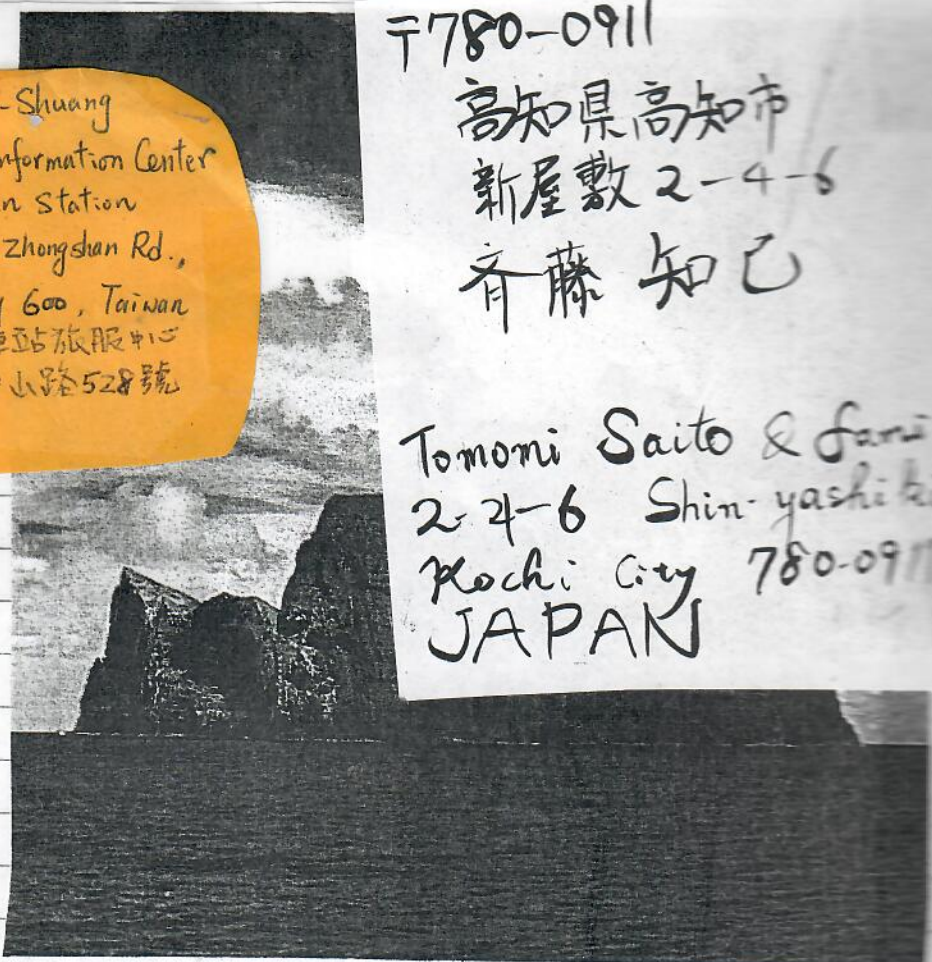

# Oceania

**Oceania** (UK pron.: /ˌəʊʃɪˈɑːniə/ or /ˌəʊsɪˈɑːniə/<sup>[1]</sup> US /ˌoʊʃiːæniːə/<sup>[2]</sup>) is a region centered on the islands of the tropical Pacific Ocean.<sup>[3]</sup> Opinions of what constitutes Oceania range from the coral atolls and volcanic islands of the South Pacific (ethnologically divided into the subregions of Melanesia, Micronesia, and Polynesia)<sup>[4]</sup> to the entire insular region between Asia and the Americas, including Australasia and the Malay Archipelago.<sup>[5]</sup> The term is sometimes used more specifically to denote a continent comprising Australia and proximate islands,<sup>[5][6][7][8][9]</sup> or biogeographically as a synonym for either the Australasian ecozone (Wallacea and Australasia) or the Pacific ecozone (Melanesia, Polynesia, and Micronesia apart either from New Zealand<sup>[10]</sup> or from mainland New Guinea).<sup>[11]</sup>

## Etymology

The term was coined as *Océanie* ca. 1812 by geographer Conrad Malte-Brun.<sup>[5]</sup> The word *Océanie* is a French language word derived from the Greek word ὠκεανός (*ōkeanós*), ocean.

## Physiography

*Main article: Geography of Oceania*

Oceania was originally conceived as the lands of the Pacific Ocean, stretching from the Straits of Malacca to the coast of the Americas. It comprised four regions: *Polynesia*, *Micronesia*, *Malaysia* (now called the Malay Archipelago), and *Melanesia* (now called Australasia).<sup>[12]</sup> Included are parts of three geological continents, Eurasia, Australia, and Zealandia, as well the non-continental volcanic islands of the Philippines, Wallacea, and the open Pacific. It extends to Sumatra in the west, the Bonin Islands in

the northwest, the Hawaiian Islands in the northeast, Rapa Nui and Sala y Gómez Island in the east, and Macquarie Island in the south, but excludes Taiwan, the Japanese Archipelago (including the Ryukyu Islands), and Aleutian Islands of the margins of Asia.<sup>[13][14]</sup>

The states that occupy Oceania that are not included in geopolitical Oceania are Indonesia, Malaysia (through Malaysian Borneo), Brunei, the Philippines, and East Timor. The islands of the geographic extremes are politically integral parts of Japan (Bonin), the United States (Hawaii), and Chile (Rapa Nui, formerly Easter Island). A smaller geographic definition also exists, which excludes the land on the Sunda Plate, but includes Indonesian New Guinea as part of the Australian continent.

### Biogeography

Biogeographically, Oceania is used as a synonym for either the Australasian ecozone (Wallacea and Australasia) or the Pacific ecozone (Melanesia, Polynesia, and Micronesia apart either from New Zealand<sup>[10]</sup> or from mainland New Guinea<sup>[11]</sup>).

### Ecogeography

Oceania is one of eight terrestrial ecozones, which constitute the major ecological regions of the planet. The Oceania ecozone includes all of Micronesia, Fiji, and all of Polynesia except New Zealand. New Zealand, New Guinea, Melanesia apart from Fiji, and Australia constitute the separate Australasia ecozone. The Malay Archipelago is part of the Indomalaya ecozone. Related to these concepts are Near Oceania, that part of western Island Melanesia which has been inhabited for tens of millennia, and Remote Oceania, which is more recently settled.<sup>[15]</sup>

### Geopolitics

<sup>bio</sup> In the geopolitical conception used by the United Nations, International Olympic Committee, and many atlases, Oceania includes Australia and the nations of the Pacific from Papua New Guinea east, but not the Malay Archipelago or Indonesian New Guinea.<sup>[16][17][18]</sup>

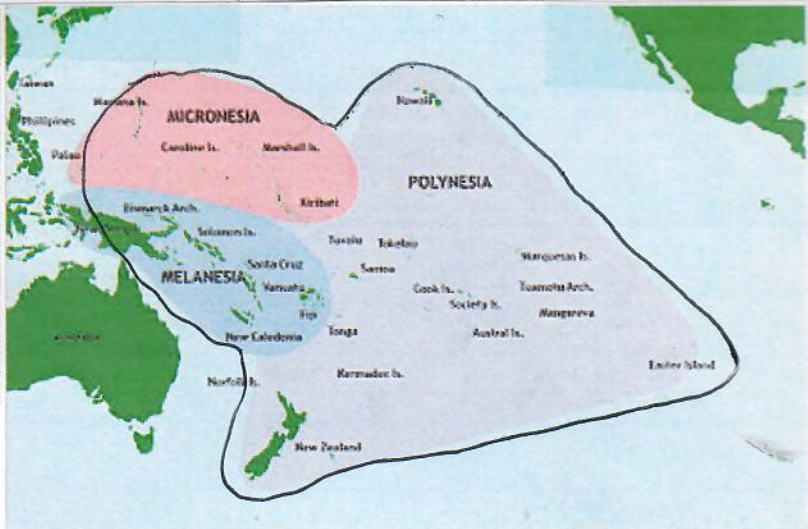

Ethno-cultural definition of Oceania

- New Zealand forms the south-western corner of the Polynesian Triangle. Its indigenous Māori constitute one of the major cultures of Polynesia. It is also, however, considered part of Australasia.<sup>[16]</sup>
- The widest definition of Oceania includes the entire region between continental Asia and the Americas, thereby including islands in the Pacific Rim such as the Japanese Archipelago, Taiwan, and the Aleutian islands.<sup>[19]</sup>



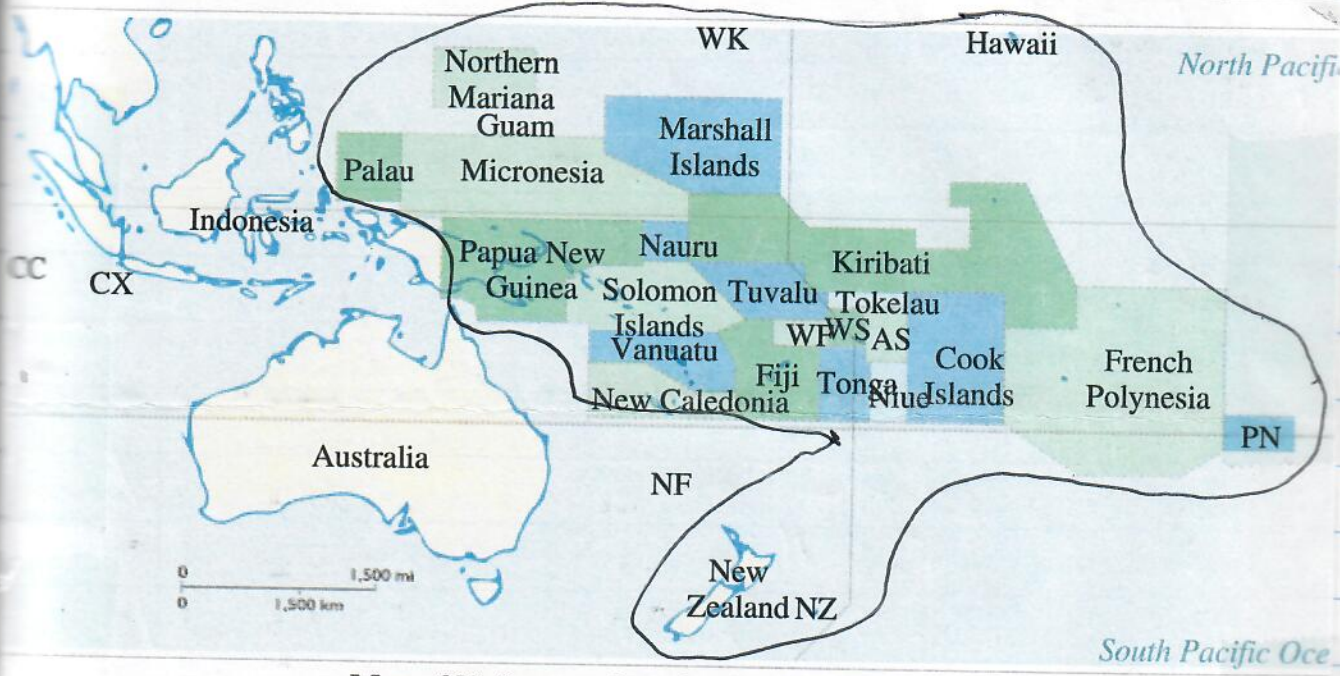

## Religion

The predominant religion in Oceania is Christianity.<sup>[28]</sup> Traditional religions are often animist and prevalent among traditional tribes is the belief in spirits (*masalai* in Tok Pisin) representing natural forces.<sup>[29]</sup> In recent Australian and New Zealand censuses, large proportions of the population say they belong to "No religion" (which includes atheism, agnosticism, Secular Humanism, and rationalism). In Tonga, everyday life is heavily influenced by Polynesian traditions and especially by the Christian faith. The Bahá'í House of Worship in Tiapapata, Samoa is one of seven designations administered in the Baha'í faith.

Successful sea turtle conservation programs that endure are best built with local communities as their foundation. National legislation and international conventions based on sound research findings clearly have importance. However, strategies for conservation are made robust and equitable when they integrate cultural and traditional components forged at the local level by the very people closest to the turtles and their environment. During 2011-2013, we (GB and KN) made five leisure visits to Xiao Liuqiu, a 6.8 km<sup>2</sup> island located at 22° 20'N, 120° 22'E, just 15 km off the southwest coast of Taiwan. The island is rich with numerous Tao and Buddhist temples serving as exquisite dwellings for an array of venerable Chinese Gods. Xiao Liuqiu's economy is substantially based on distant-water fishing and, increasingly, on ecotourism involving visitors from nearby Taiwan. The main purpose of our explorations has been to learn about and experience Taiwanese culture through the daily lives of Xiao Liuqiu's 12,000 residents. Paramount to these visits has been the nurturing of friendships with local families, based on a strong mutual interest in the conservation of green turtles (*Chelonia mydas*) occurring prominently year-round in the island's 12 kms of coastal waters. Seasonal nesting at low levels also takes place on several small sand beaches. Numerous turtles can often be seen foraging while snorkeling and from shoreline cliffs, perhaps rivaling such sightings in Hawaii. As guests at Xiao Liuqiu, our principal activity has been to listen and learn from our hosts, and to freely share biological knowledge about sea turtles linked to our own personal experiences with turtles and people in the greater China region, Japan and Hawaii. The key to lasting partnerships for balanced and sustainable conservation action is to build genuine trust and respect, with patience, at the person-to-person level. This presentation explores and photographically illustrates unique aspects of the Xiao Liuqiu culture relevant to current conservation challenges and opportunities. # No serious injuries or damage as monster waves hit shores

Gargantuan waves continued to pummel north and west shore beaches Thursday, the second day of a swell that happens only once every 10 to 20 years, but no serious injuries or major damage to property occurred.

About 20 to 40 of the most experienced surfers, including professionals, braved 50-foot waves on Oahu's North Shore on Wednesday, said Emergency Management spokeswoman Shayne Enright.

No one was seriously injured, "but it could have been serious if the lifeguards didn't get to them," she said.

She warned that although the coming swells may not be as big as the last couple of days, "it is still extremely dangerous," adding, "Basically, you can't let your guard down."

North Shore lifeguards issued 3,000 warnings Wednesday at Pipeline, Waimea Bay and Sunset Beach, where crowds gathered, and made two rescues at Waimea. Twelve were rescued on Oahu's west side.

"We were very lucky and dodged another big bullet," said John Cummings III, spokesman for the Department of Emergency Management.

No homes were damaged, and although the high surf caused an "overtopping of highways along the North Shore, it wasn't to the point where we had to close the road or divert traffic," Cummings said.

Waimea Bay Beach Park was shut down at 5:30 p.m. Thursday as the surf came back up, and will remain closed today if conditions continue to be hazardous.

Surf will remain at the high end of advisory-level heights today, at about

20 feet on the north shores of Oahu, Kauai and Molokai, National Weather Service meteorologist Bob Burke said. They will be generally highest in the morning and gradually decrease later in the day. The west side will also see smaller surf as well.

The weather service received reports Thursday of the biggest surf of 15 to 30 feet at Kee Beach and Haena, Kauai.

On Oahu, surf was 18 to 25 feet at Ehukai, 15 to 25 at Sunset Beach and 10 to 20 at Makaha.

The largest waves on Maui were at Hookipa at 15 to 25 feet.

The Big Island's west side saw 10- to 12-footers at Magic Sands and 8 to 10 at Kahaluu.

The weather service said Wednesday that Buoy 1 northwest of Kauai recorded a 30-foot swell for the first time since 1986.

40-foot waves on its north shores Wednesday, keeping its emergency workers busy.

An off-duty lifeguard rescued an 87-year-old Washington man who was sitting at Kee Beach at about 4:30 p.m. Wednesday when a powerful wave washed ashore and swept him roughly 20 yards down the beach.

The lifeguard noticed the man in distress and was able to bring him to shore before the strong currents pulled him out too far.

The man received multiple abrasions and was taken to Wilcox Hospital for medical evaluation.

Kauai north shore beaches remained closed Thursday, but Anahola Beach was reopened for swimming.

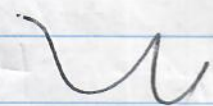

As we discussed at the February 2014 meeting of the U.S.-China Living Marine Resources (LMR) Panel meeting, NOAA invites up to six experts from China to participate in a Workshop on Sea Turtle Foraging Ecology and Health Assessment August 25-28, 2014 in Honolulu, Hawaii. The goal of the workshop is to promote meaningful information exchange, strengthen collaboration among Chinese and U.S. scientists, and share research techniques on sea turtle foraging ecology and health. This training event builds on the previous activities and discussions that have occurred between Drs. George Balazs and Jeff Seminoff (NOAA) and Dr. HUANG Honghui (SCSFRI) and others at the Guangdong Sea Turtle Reserve.

Understanding the causes of disease and mortality are critical for determining why sea turtle populations may fluctuate. Further, learning about foraging ecology can help identify important marine habitats and foods for sea turtles, and thus pinpoint essential coastal areas for conservation and management efforts. The workshop will rely on "hands-on" training techniques.

The tentative agenda of this 4-day meeting follows:

- Day 1 - Presentations and Discussions by China (CAFS and others) and the U.S. (NOAA and the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS)).
- Day 2 - Demonstrations of turtle necropsies, including lavage sampling for diet contents. Practice sessions for necropsies by those participants wishing to do so.
- Day 3 - Field work at a nearby study site to capture free-ranging live turtles to tag, health screen, and collect samples, including lavage diet samples.
- Day 4 - Discuss days 1-3 and arrive at conclusions and recommendations for future CAFS/NOAA and USGS turtle joint activities under the U.S.-China Living Marine Resources (LMR) Panel.
