# 王船祭典的舞臺

**Water: Stage for the Royal Lords' plague expulsion festival**

王爺信仰盛行於臺灣西南沿海與澎湖一帶，隨著早期移民攜帶的原鄉香火，或藉由漂流王船渡海來臺；在各地豐富多元的王醮、迎王祭典中，人們常自海邊、河邊恭迎王爺，為地方百姓消災解厄、驅瘟逐疫，再送到水邊隨著王船火化。水，為王爺信仰、王船祭典打造了重要的舞臺。

「王船」是王爺下凡代天巡狩、返天述職的交通工具及祭典主要法器。在這場以水為舞臺的祭典中，王船的建造與神聖化不僅是必要的準備工作，更是展現地方團結力量的要事。而各地不同的王船形貌、活化儀式，也反映了多元的地域文化特色。

Belief in the Royal Lords is widespread along the south-western coast of Taiwan and Penghu, as the early immigrants to these places brought their religious practices from their ancestral hometowns, which evolved into today's various ceremonial actions during the Festivals. These include summoning the Royal Lords from the seashores or river banks to start the festivals, following by expelling plagues and dispelling evil, giving blessings to the local people, and burning boats at the waterside to end the festivals. Water thus provides an important stage for the festivals.

The Royal Lords' Boat is its main form of transportation between the human world and Heaven, and is also the major focus of rituals during the festivals. The work of building and sanctifying these boats is an important task that starts well before the festivals, and this is also a way that local people can show their solidarity with each other. The various features of the boats and related rituals reflect the differences among local cultures.

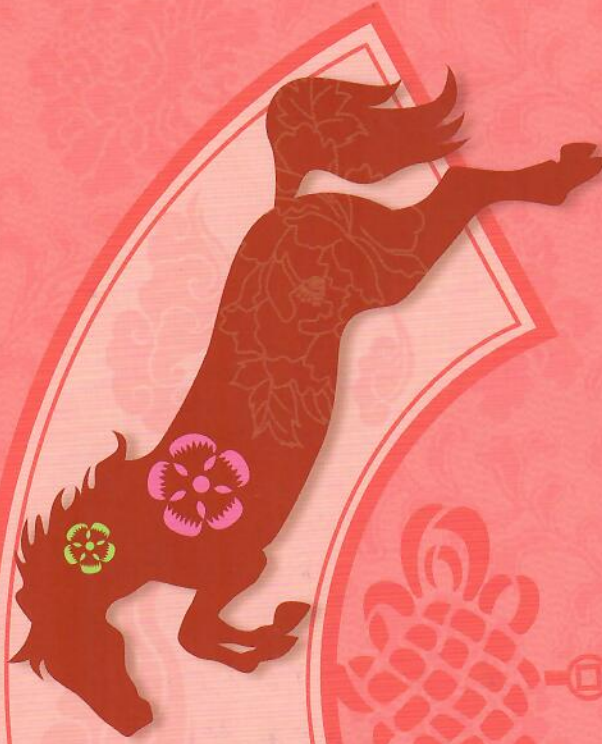

# People from near and far give support to protesters

A truck full of drinks yesterday appeared outside the Legislative Yuan where a sit-in by students and other activists protesting against the cross-strait service trade pact was being held.

"You have had a long day," the truck driver from New Taipei City, surnamed Shih (施), said to the protesters.

He said he had been "almost driven mad" watching news reports since the demonstration began on Tuesday and was deeply moved by the students' action. He said he could not do much to help the protest, except offer some drinks for the students.

"The nation's economy is not doing well and I am worried that young people will not be able to find a job or make money," Shih said.

"The future of the young is the future of Taiwan, and the government's messing around should not be tolerated," he said.

## LONG DRIVE

Supplies and moral support appeared yesterday from Chen Jui-chu (陳瑞珠), who had also been motivated by news reports.

The Changhua County resident drove to Taipei yesterday morning with her children and mother-in-law, bringing raincoats as well as instant noodles and other food for the students.

She said she had considered sending the supplies by speed post, but decided to save time by bringing them herself.

Her husband supported her decision, Chen said as she and her children passed the food to students equipped with pushcarts.

Chen had photographs of her

children taken on the scene, saying that the pictures would be a souvenir of their witnessing democracy.

Meanwhile, several tents were set up yesterday outside the Legislative Yuan complex for more than 20 families with small children who are taking part in the protests.

## MOTHERS

The mothers, who had been there for two days, said "it was our duty" to maintain a bright future for their children.

They were busy protesting and attending to their children as the temperature dropped yesterday.

One of the women, Hsu Shu-huei (徐書慧), said she came to voice her concerns because the service trade agreement will have a great impact on Taiwan, but was very few Taiwanese understand it.

"It is a very serious problem," Hsu said.

# DPP throws its support behind student protests

The Democratic Progressive Party (DPP) yesterday at a rally threw its support behind the students in the "Occupy the Legislature" movement and said it would refuse to negotiate with the Chinese Nationalist Party (KMT) until President Ma Ying-jeou (馬英九) apologizes for his handling of the controversial cross-strait service trade agreement.

Almost every senior DPP member attended the rally and called for national support for the student movement, with DPP Chairman Su Tseng-chang (蘇貞昌) saying that the occupation was "a right thing to do" and not "a violent act," as claimed by the KMT and several media outlets.

"We're not leaving as long as the students are still here," Su said.

The chairman said that the students were not "politically motivated" by the DPP, as the KMT had claimed.

However, the DPP shared the same values and ideals as the students and that was why it offered its unconditional support to the movement.

Former DPP chairperson Tsai Ing-wen (蔡英文) said she had been a professor for 15 years and the students' writing a new chapter in history was one of the most touching experiences in her life.

Tsai also urged Legislative Speaker Wang Jin-pyng (王金平) to skip a meeting with Ma and Premier Jiang Yi-huah (江宜樺) scheduled for 11am.

Both Tsai and former premier Yu Shyi-kun (游錫堃) said the controversy related to the cross-strait service trade agreement was not a dispute between different branches of the government, but one between Ma and mainstream public opinion.

Yu called for Ma to learn from

the example of former president Lee Teng-hui (李登輝), who met with the leaders of the Wild Lily student movement in 1990 and listened to what they had to say in a meeting that eventually contributed to legislative reform.

Wang did skip the meeting with the president, urging Ma to respect the voice of the people.

He pledged to convene inter-party negotiations as soon as possible to try to resolve the crisis.

Inter-party negotiation would not be necessary if Ma refuses to apologize and if the agreement is not withdrawn from a plenary session, said DPP caucus whip Ker Chien-ming (柯建銘), who did not

attend a meeting of caucus whips that Wang convened at his residence yesterday afternoon.

To avoid interfering with the students' activities, the DPP mobilized thousands of people across the country to express their support for the students in a rally organized next to the students' protest site outside of the Legislative Yuan compound in Taipei.

The crowd was visibly smaller than the students' rally and the party's introduction of its candidates in the seven-in-one elections drew the ire of nearby students.

Some students said the DPP tried to turn the rally into part of its election campaign.

# Crocodiles can climb trees: study

Most people entering crocodile territory keep a wary eye out on water and land, but research suggests they need to look up.

Though the reptiles lack obvious physical features to suggest this is possible, crocodiles in fact climb trees all the way to the crowns, according to University of Tennessee researcher Vladimir Dinets.

Researchers in the climbing study observed crocodiles in Australia, Africa and North America. The study documented crocodiles climbing as high as 1.8m off the ground.

However, Dinets said he received anecdotal reports from people who spend time around crocodiles of the reptiles climbing to almost 9m above ground.

Dinets said crocodiles lack the toe and foot structure that would be expected of a climber. However, smaller and juvenile crocodiles in particular were observed climbing vertically while larger ones tended to climb angled trunks and branches, all of which is a measure of the reptiles' spectacular agility, he said.

"They just go slowly. Eventually they get there," he said.

The finding was reported last month in *Herpetology Notes* in collaboration with Adam Britton from Charles Darwin University in Australia and Matthew Shirley from the University of Florida.

The researchers believe the crocodiles climb to keep a lookout on their territory and to warm themselves in the sun.

"The most frequent observations of tree-basking were in areas where there were few places to bask on the ground, implying that the individuals needed alternatives for regulating their body temperature," the authors wrote.

"Likewise, their wary nature suggests that climbing leads to improved site surveillance of potential threats and prey," they wrote.

People who spend time around crocodiles have known about the climbing ability for decades, Dinets said, but this study is the first to thoroughly examine the climbing and basking behavior.

Dinets also was coauthor of a widely reported study last year that demonstrated crocodiles used sticks and twigs to hunt, balancing nest-building material on their

snouts just above the water line to lure birds.

That was the first reported use of tools by any reptile and the first known case of predators timing the use of lures to a seasonal behavior in their prey, a University of Tennessee press release said.

The latest climbing study suggests paleontologists studying extinct species should be cautious about drawing conclusions from fossils, Dinets added.

"If crocodiles were extinct and you only knew them from fossils, you wouldn't be able to guess they climb trees because they don't have any physical adaptations," Dinets said.

Assumptions based on fossils, he said, can be "far less correct than people think."

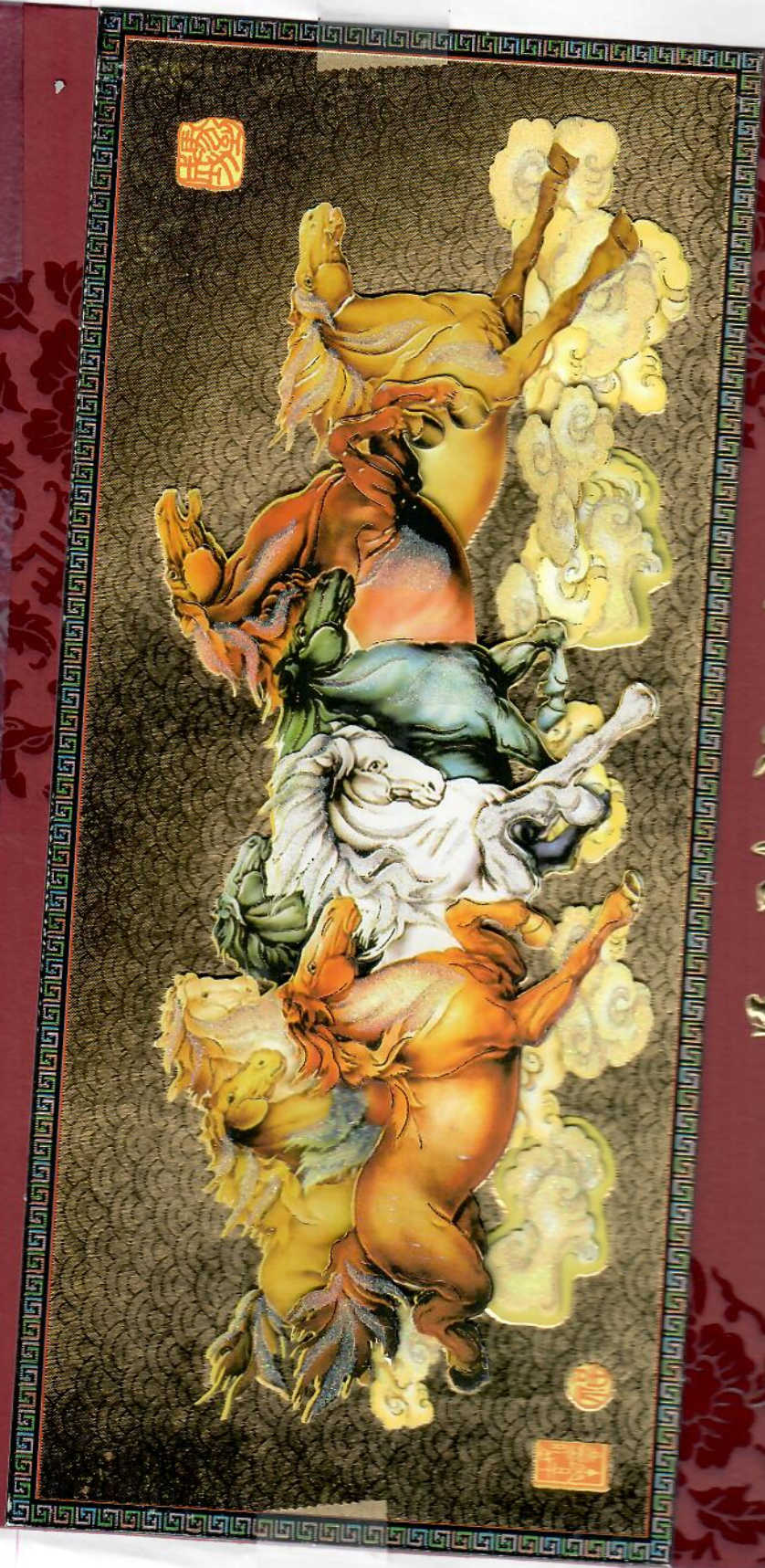

## Kaohsiung, Tainan will not send any more police officers to Taipei

The heads of Kaohsiung and Tainan special municipalities, both of which are governed by the main opposition Democratic Progressive Party (DPP), said yesterday that they are unwilling to offer further backup police manpower to control riots happening in northern Taiwan.

After a riot the previous night at the Executive Yuan, Tainan Mayor Lai Ching-te said that no violence should be used against the students expressing their opinions about important national issues.

The head of the Kaohsiung City Information Bureau, Ting Yun-kung, said that the city government respects the protesters'

appeals and is against Kaohsiung police donning riot gear.

One hundred and twenty officers sent from Kaohsiung and Tainan to Taipei were recalled the previous week.

The Kaohsiung city government said March 21 that they had negotiated with the National Police Agency to reduce the number of mobilized officers due to local security needs, and would bring back any further deployed officers immediately if riot-control instructions were issued.

Lai said Tainan would not send any backup police, saying that the National Police Agency already has enough officers to mobilize.

# US stays neutral on pact, lauds Taiwan democracy

US Department of State spokeswoman Marie Harf on Monday said Washington supports Taiwan's "vibrant democracy" and how it allows "robust political dialogue."

Harf made the remarks in response to a question about the student-led demonstrations in Taipei against the government's handling of the cross-strait service trade agreement with China.

"The agreement on cross-strait trade in services is an issue for Taiwan to decide," she said. "We hope that the discussion can be conducted peacefully and civilly."

"We have welcomed steps taken by both sides on the Taiwan Strait to reduce tensions and improve relations between Taipei and Beijing," she said. "We'd encourage them to continue this constructive dialogue and again, the specific agreement is really an issue for them to decide."

Asked if the US was offering any counsel or advice to President Ma Ying-jeou's (馬英九) government on how to deal with the demonstrators, Harf said that to her knowledge, that was not the case.

Harf also said she had not heard any concern expressed within US President Barack Obama's the administration that the protests may spread and destabilize Taiwan.

The department's statement came as the Formosan Association for Public Affairs (FAPA) called on

the US government and Congress to "express deep concern" about the police response to the protests.

FAPA, which represents many Taiwanese-American organizations, asked Washington to urge Taipei "to exercise the utmost restraint in using police force, in order to prevent further bloodshed and deeper polarization of Taiwan's society."

In a message to the White House and Congress, FAPA said: "The procedures followed by the Ma government to push the [cross-strait] service trade agreement through were undemocratic and not transparent. The autonomy of the legislature and the legislative process negotiated by the political parties should be respected as befits Taiwan's democracy."

US publications have also commented on the trade pact protests and the government's reaction.

"The more lasting damage may be across the [Taiwan] Strait, where Chinese authorities are surely looking at this mess and smirking smugly," *Fortune Magazine* said.

A Georgetown University blog urged US policymakers to take "seriously" claims that the pact will raise China's influence over Taipei.

"The US must adopt and strictly enforce a zero-tolerance policy toward Chinese intervention in Taiwan," the blog said. "We can't afford to let Taiwan become the next Crimea. China must be appraised that messing with Taiwan equates to messing with America."

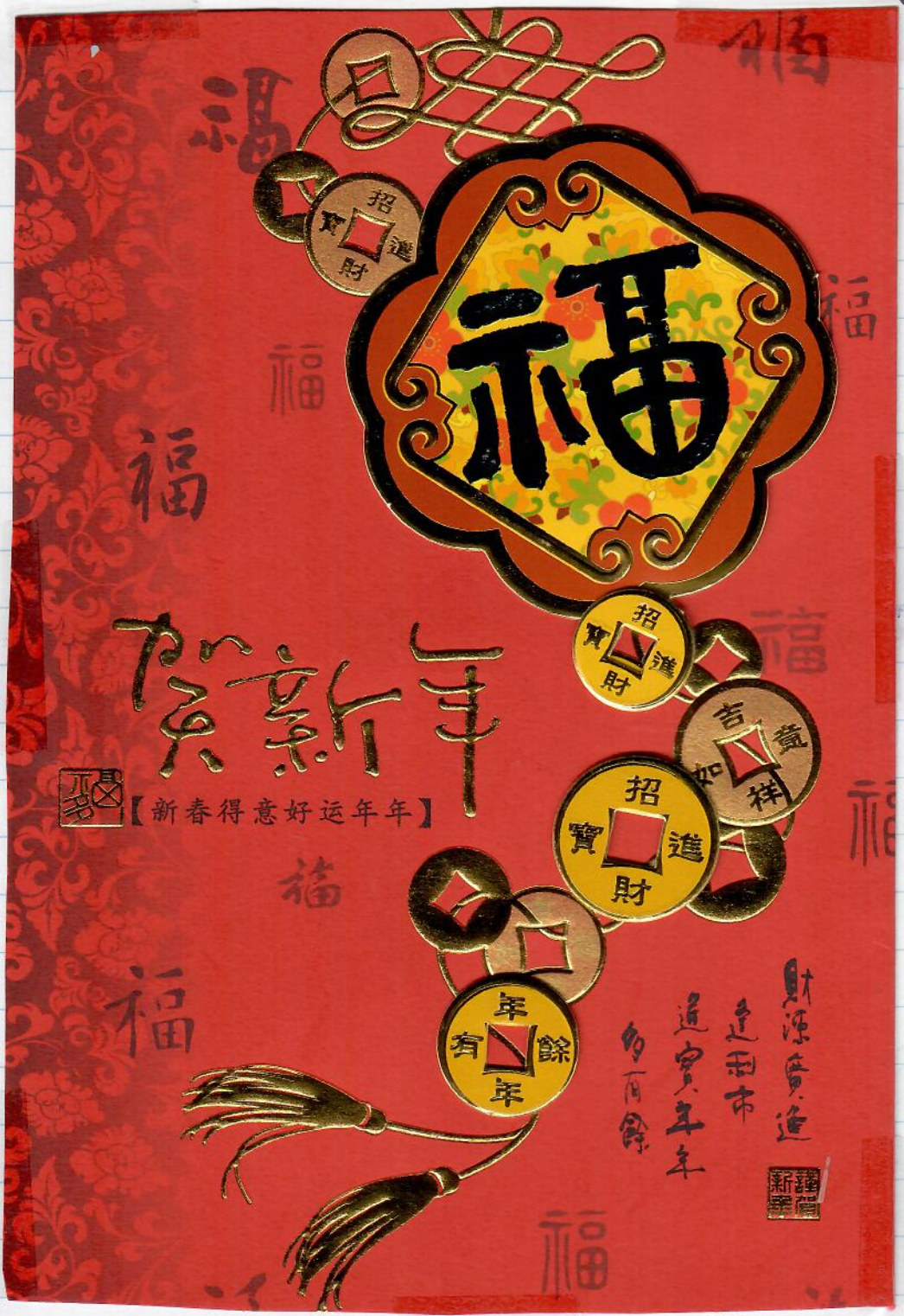

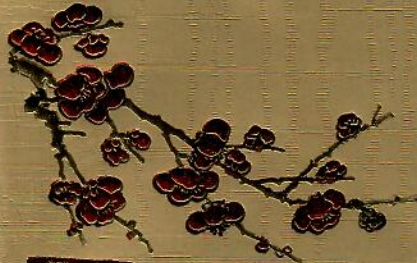

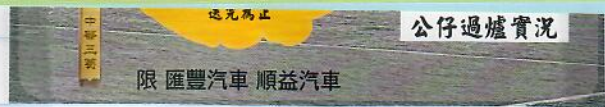
