US concerned over PRC's moves to alter 'status quo'

The US Department of State on Friday again expressed concern over the People's Republic of China's (PRC) lack of military transparency and reiterated its opposition to attempts to change the "status quo" in the Taiwan Strait, after Chinese military aircraft circled around Taiwan.

"The United States remains concerned by China's lack of transparency about its growing military capabilities and associated strategic intentions," a department spokesperson said in an e-mailed response to queries by Taiwanese media. "The United States opposes unilateral actions by any party aimed at altering the status quo, including any resort to force or other forms of coercion."

The US has a deep and abiding interest in cross-strait peace and stability and encourages Taipei and Beijing to engage in constructive dialogue that pursues a peaceful resolution of differences acceptable to the people on both sides of the Strait, they added.

China has increased its military activities near Taiwan over the past year, widely seen as part of its efforts to step up pressure on the administration of President

The "1992 consensus" — a term former Mainland Affairs Council chairman Su Chi (蘇起) admitted making up in 2000 — refers to a tacit understanding between the Chinese Nationalist Party (KMT) and the Chinese Communist Party that both sides acknowledge that there is "one China," with each side having its own interpretation of what "China" means.

In the latest incident on Friday,

the Chinese People's Liberation Army Air Force conducted a long-range drill with aircraft circling Taiwan in opposite directions, according to information released by the Taiwanese and Chinese militaries.

Involved in the exercise were the Xian H-6K bomber, Su-35 and J-11 fighters, the Shaanxi Y-8 transport plane, the KJ-2000 early warning aircraft and Tu-154 electronic surveillance aircraft, but neither Taipei nor Beijing disclosed the number of aircraft involved.

US lawmaker urges airlines to resist China

'ORWELLIAN NONSENSE':

Ted Yoho promised the support of Congress for US companies that refuse to be a pawn in China's political warfare against Taiwan

US Representative Ted Yoho, chairman of the House of Representatives' Subcommittee on Asia and the Pacific, on Thursday wrote a letter to US carriers urging them to resist pressure from Beijing and Chinese political correctness.

In his letter to Delta, American and United Airlines, Yoho addressed a letter China's Civil Aviation Administration had sent to foreign airlines asking them to list Taiwan as a province or region of China, under threat of penalties.

The lawmaker agreed with the White House, which on Saturday last week called those demands "Orwellian nonsense," and pledged congressional support for US companies against such threats.

"Congress will also stand behind US companies that prudently refuse to be drafted into the CCP's [Chinese Communist Party] political warfare against Taiwan," Yoho said in the letter.

The demands not only "falsely imply that Chinese law controls the carriers' global communications," but are inconsistent with US policy on Taiwan, he wrote.

Acknowledging that China has used what academics have termed economic blackmail to compel private companies to follow their agenda, Yoho urged the airlines and others in the private sector "to remember that with your global prominence comes corporate responsibility."

He added that these businesses should not lend "undue legitimacy to the CCP's attempts at thought control" or be hijacked to be a CCP mouthpiece.

While American and United Airlines have yet to respond to China's demands, Delta in January apologized for listing Taiwan and Tibet as countries on its Web site.

Punalu'u Beach Observations 7/9/2018

During an approximately hour long (10am-11am) snorkel along the shoreline at Punalu'u in water depths 1m to 3 m, we saw 15-20 green turtles. Groups of 4-5 individuals were actively feeding together in small nearshore "rock amphitheatres" north of the main sandy beach entry where the turtle tagging tent was set up. Turtles were also observed near the boat ramp at the north end of the bay. No tumored turtles were seen. Turtles were foraging on *Pterocladia* in crevices. Distinct water temperature variation was noted (cool at surface, warmer on bottom).

Pterocladia capillacea was very short on exposed surfaces of the substratum, but in some places in crevices, narrow passages between rocks, etc. the thalli were ~5cm long, clean, and healthy red.

Near the boat ramp, the seaweeds were covered with diatoms and brown sediment.

Seaweed cover was 80-90% on rocks, but most species were short or even veneer-like. Some bleached cauliflower coral (*Pocillopora meandrina*) colonies were observed.

Pterocladia capillacea

Codium sp. (green veneer on rocks)

Acanthophora pacifica (native, not to be confused with *Acanthophora spicifera*)- thalli intact, not grazed, but sparse in cover.

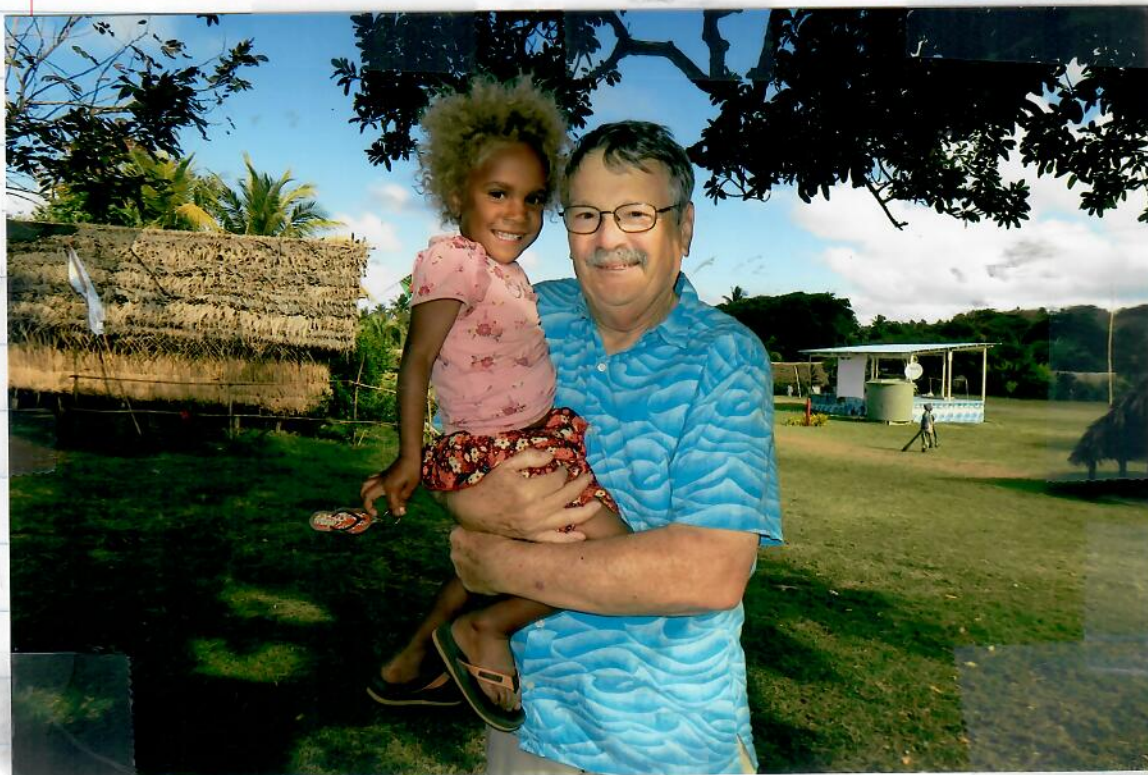

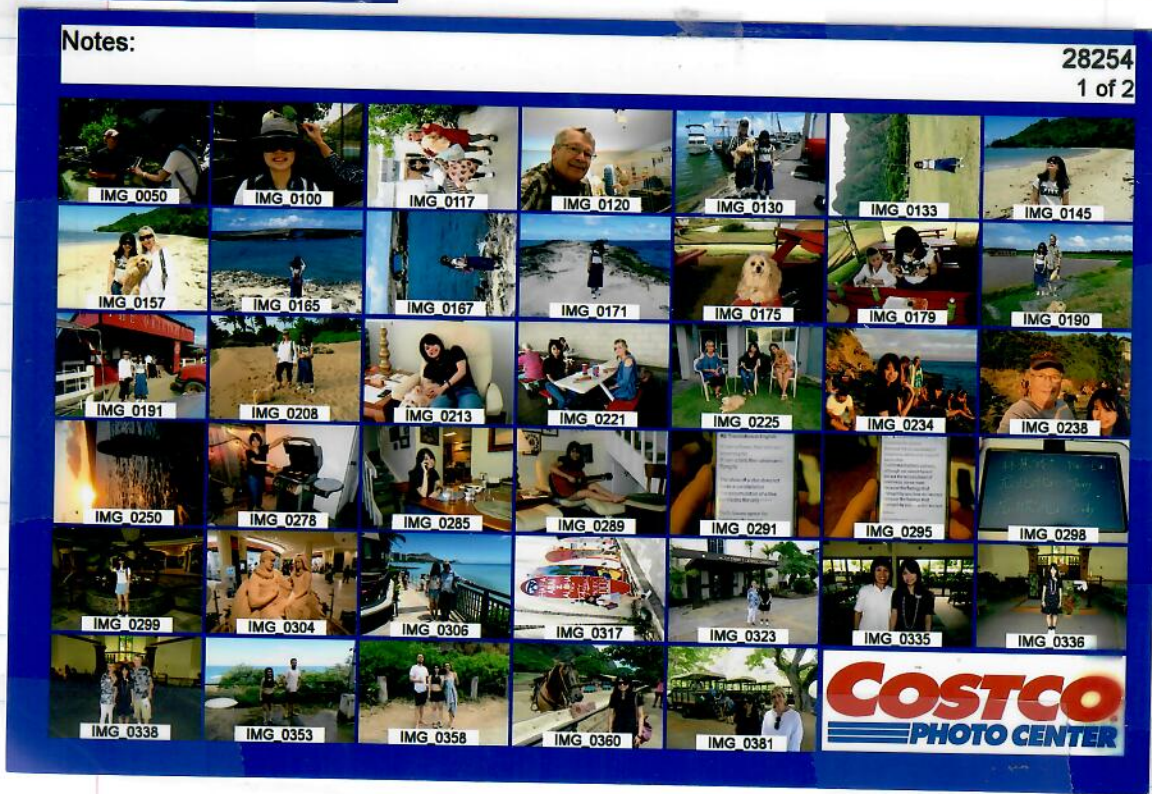

33. MEET HAWAII'S SEA TURTLES

The gentle, lumbering PACIFIC GREEN SEA TURTLE makes its home in Hawaiian waters. These huge,

threatened creatures, which can grow to 4 feet and weigh up to 400 pounds, feed on *limu* (seaweed) that grows on rocks in shallow areas. The turtles, known as *honu* in Hawaiian, are referred to as green not for the color of the algae growing on their backs, but for the color of their meat.

It's common to get a look at a green sea turtle, but it is rare to come across the nearly extinct **HAWKSBILL SEA TURTLE**. While Hawai'i's green sea turtle population has shown good recovery in recent years, the Hawaiian hawksbill population is estimated at fewer than 30 nesting turtles. The Hawaiian hawksbill turtle is named for its sharp, beak-like mouth but is known for its beautiful exterior shell, which was exploited for "tortoise shell" for many years by the fashion industry.

A good way to get a look at a turtle is to paddle a kayak in **KAILUA BAY**, or head to turtle canyon off Waikiki beach. **TURTLE CANYON** is accessible only by boat or kayak.

Be mindful that laws protect sea turtles. If you spot one, give it 10 to 15 feet of space, and allow room for it to surface and breathe.

It's against the law to approach, chase, surround, touch or swim with any protected marine mammal.

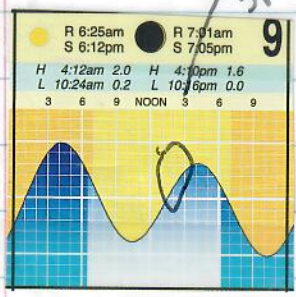

CLIMATE & CLOTHING
 The climate is fairly warm and tropical. Annual average temperature is about 23°C (73°F) and ranges from 20°C (68°F) to 26°C (79°F). Humidity levels are high and annual average value is around 79%. Average annual rainfall is 2,058mm, mostly during summer months. Autumn (October - December) is the most pleasant season. Days are sunny and warm and humidity levels are low. Winter (January - March) is cold but sunny. In April humidity increases and from May to September the climate becomes hot, humid and rainy with occasional tropical storms (typhoons).

About Hurricane Walaka washing away the green turtle (honu) nesting island of Hikina (East Island) in the Northwestern Hawaiian Islands ("Remote Hawaiian island largely wiped out by hurricane," Star-Advertiser, Oct. 26):

Surely this is one of the most exciting times of my 48-year career working with Hawaiian green turtles. The loss of East Island at French Frigate Shoals started decades ago, documented by photo evidence. My first stay on the island was as a University of Hawaii sea

turtle researcher in 1973.

The loss of the island is part of a natural long-term process where sand, unlike stone, comes and goes, accumulates and then washes away in cycles. Sea turtles for millennia have always been able to adapt to such changes. If they hadn't they would all have gone extinct long ago.

The Hawaiian green turtle population is robust, durable and incredibly adaptive. They will figure out where to nest new and it will be insightful and amazing to watch it happen over the next few years.

SEA LIFE PARK PLANNED IMPROVEMENTS

Sea Life Park is planning to renovate and expand its exhibits beginning in 2019.

Sea Life Park is embarking on a five- to six-year master plan that involves an estimated \$30-million redevelopment — the circa-1964 facility's most ambitious ever.

The 10-project upgrade will add a new green sea turtle conservation center, said Valerie King, Sea Life Park general manager. Other highlights include adding an "active" volcano exhibit to the center of the shark tank and restoring part of a historic fishing village called Kaupo that once ran from the park to the ocean, King said.

Fast-growing leisure park operator Palace Entertainment, a subsidiary of the Madrid-based Parques Reunidos Group, bought the 22-acre park in 2008 from Dolphin Discovery of Cancun, Mexico. According to its website, the parent company owns and operates more than 60 parks located in 14 countries across Europe, America, the Middle East and Asia, including amusement and theme parks, zoos, water parks and marine life parks.

Stephany Sofos, a commercial real estate analyst, estimated the redevelopment could approach \$30 million based on the extent of the renovations the company is proposing.

Stars' ascent signals arrival of makahiki

As Nahiku (the Big Dipper) sinks below the western horizon, Iwakeli'i (Cassiopeia) and Kalupeakawelo (the Great Square of Pegasus) climb high into the northeastern sky, signaling the arrival of Makali'i (Pleiades) in the star house 'Aina Ko'olau on the star compass. The arrival of the constellation Makali'i after sunset on the eastern horizon heralds the beginning of the makahiki season.

An open star cluster, the Pleiades, also known as the Seven Sisters and Messier 45, comprises hot blue, very luminous stars that are obvious to the naked eye. Makali'i, or Matariki as it is called in the South Pacific Polynesian islands, follows a similar celestial cycle.

Each island had different names for the lunar months of the year. The Hawaii island calendar designates the names 'Ikuwa for October, Welehu for November, Makali'i for December and Ka'elo for January. The makahiki season lasted for four lunar months. Counting months following a lunar calendar is problematic as a lunar month is about 29.5 days. Over time the calendar drifts, and the names no longer align with celestial season.

In David Malo's book, "Hawaiian Antiquities," editor W.D. Alexander commented that following the lunar calendar meant that the yearly Hawaiian calendar drifted about 10.75 days a year set against the backdrop of a yearly 365-day sidereal calendar.

To rectify this the Kahuna

Kilo Hoku, a person who observes the heavens, would need to intercalate the calendar, that is, insert a third month every three years. Although we do not know the name of that additional month, this protocol follows South Pacific Polynesian traditions.

During the makahiki season, Lono, the god of agriculture, succeeded the pantheon of Hawaiian gods. Warfare was suspended, taxes or tribute was collected, and athletic competitions became part of the makahiki season activities. Competitions such as boxing, wrestling, spear throwing and bowling were held.

Local communities often entered trained athletes as their representatives. In a clockwise circuitous procession, the king's retinue moved from community to community to collect taxes, which were in the form of food and utilitarian products such as cloth, rope and feathers.

At the end of the lunar month of Ka'elo, Lono was replaced by Ku as the paramount god, and the leisurely life of the makahiki season was concluded.

Evening observations

As we move further into our fall season, the sun will set earlier in the evening. Through November the sun sets at around 5:51 p.m., meaning that it will be dark enough for stargazing by 7 p.m. In these early evening hours, observers will be able to see Saturn and Mars.

In the early evening Saturn will be closer to the horizon and preparing to set in Manu Kona. While Saturn and its dynamic rings are beautiful through a telescope, the

Tiger Shark increases

Andromeda Galaxy, the closest full-size galaxy to the Milky Way, and the only object you can see with your naked eye that is outside of our own galaxy. The Andromeda Galaxy is approximately 2 million light-years away from us, meaning that when we look at it we are looking at light that is over 2 million years old.

Through mid- to late November, the spectacular Leonid meteor shower will scatter our sky with shooting stars. These meteors come from the tail of the comet Tempel-Tuttle, a periodic comet which last swept through Earth's orbit in 1998. The peak of the shower will occur on Nov. 17, when observers can expect to see at least 10 to 15 meteors each hour.

Morning observations

In November the sun will rise between 6:30 and 6:50 a.m. As the days get shorter, there will be more opportunities to do observing during the early morning hours. Around 5 a.m. the bright, recognizable shape of Kaheheionakeiki, famously known as Orion, will be visible toward the western sky. Beneath Orion will be the incredibly bright star of A'a, also known as Sirius. Rising in the east at this time will be the incredibly bright planet Venus appearing as our "morning star."

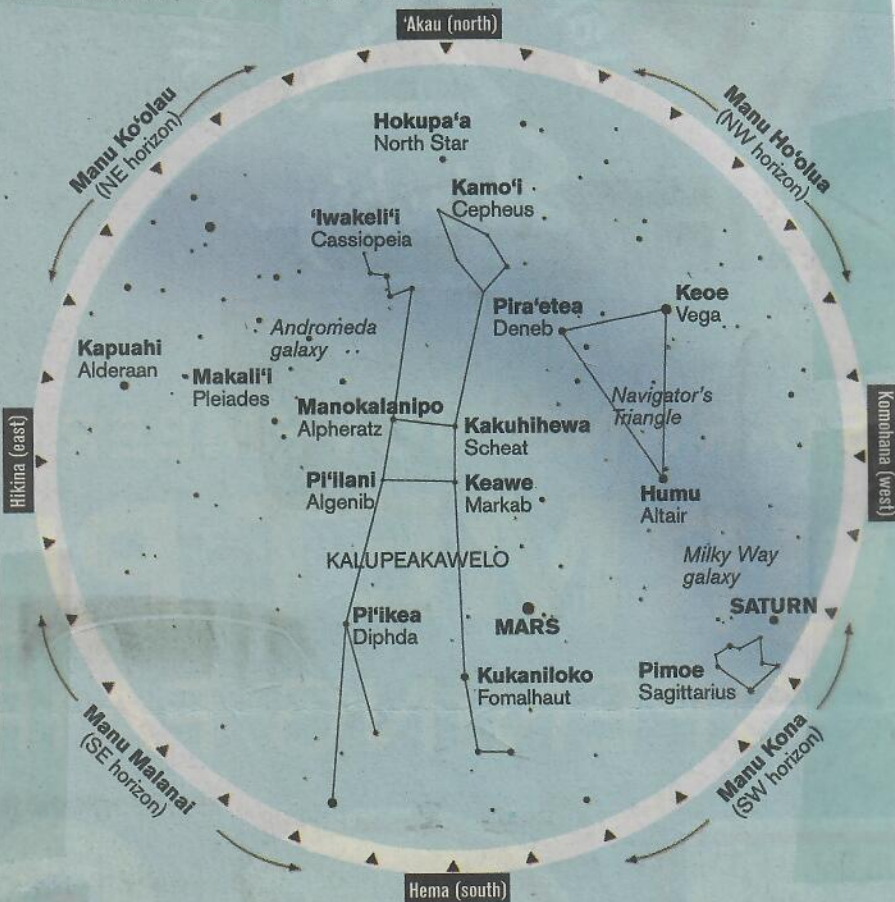

planet appears to be relatively faint in the sky. Higher up in the southern sky, observers will also be able to see Mars with its distinctive reddish color. As we march fully into our fall months, the central

region (the most visibly prominent selection) of the Milky Way galaxy will be leaving our sky. As the bulge of the Milky Way sets, higher up in the sky we will be able to view the only other galaxy that can be

seen with human eyes. While looking toward the body of Kalupeakawelo, about 10 degrees north and west of the star Manokalanipo, you can see a small, faint smudge in the sky. This faint object is the
