This has reference to your letter dated November 15, 1985 which just arrived here yesterday. In compliance with your said letter, I hereby narrate the story of the said turtle.

On October 6, 1985, I go fishing in the Southwestern of Itbayat using my improvised spear with sling, I saw the said turtle eating sea weeds. As I go nearer to it, it does not mind me, so I just held it. I am keeping its tag bearing number 3385.


Answers of your questions:

1. I caught the turtle by hand.
2. Yes, the turtle is in good health when captured. It seem normal, but, as if it is weak, hungry and exhausted.
3. The width of the shell is 28 inches and the weight of the entire turtle is approximately 75 kilos.
4. It is feeding itself with sea weeds when captured. Turtles of this same kind regularly live in that area where I caught the said turtle. However, they could not go ashore in our place as it has no sand in the surroundings, unlike in the northern small islands whereon almost all are surrounded by sand. Anyway, the captured turtle is a male. During the month of June, July and August, female turtles usually go ashore and lay eggs in the northern islands, so, we go and hunt there.
5. Since turtles' meat is a special for us to eat, we butchered the said turtle and ate some of its meat in the stomach uncooked. We cooked some of it with simple ingredients.

Itbayat is the Northernmost inhabited island of the Philippines and it is often affected by strong typhoon. So, mailing is sometimes delayed. During fine weather, our only means of transportation is a motorized small wooden made vessel going to Basco, the capital of Batanes whereon regular flights of airplane is four times per week vice versa to Manila.

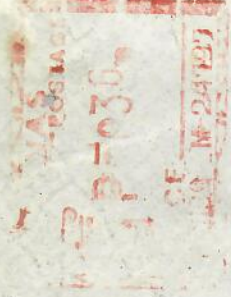

Hi George,

Thanks for all the stuff -- I didn't mean for so much time to go by before getting back to you.

I've enclosed the "East Island Number of Nesters" table. On five nights I saw nesting turtles which you tagged this year -- I've given you the numbers so that if any of those are "new nesters" (I don't know which ones were tagged basking or nesting) they can be added into the totals I've given you (it's all on the back of the yellow sheet).

Interesting about that painted turtle sighting on the Big Island. My 164 was seen and painted on 6/25, tagged 8190L, 94.0 cm st. length. She was the turtle I saw laying extremely deformed eggs -- that night was the only sighting of her (by me). She laid a very small clutch of those deformed eggs and was quite skittish afterwards. Since she was up laying the paint would have really had a good time to dry -- I painted her when she was doing her "preliminaries". Wonder if JH saw her. *locate photo*

left shortly thereafter?

My notes show that I also saw your 64 on 6/24, and that she layed eggs at that time. I didn't read her tags so the 64 must've been clearly readable at that time (I was repainting if there was even a slight problem reading your numbers).

Here are my other 3-digit numbers ending in "4":

- 124 = was repainted "AA"
- 134 = 8160L, 8161R; last seen 6/20 (laid)
- 144 = 8158L, 8170R; last seen 6/25 (laid)
- 154 = 5440L, tag R; last seen 6-26

I got up to number 168; those are my last sighting dates; maybe John saw some of these turtles later.

I made no special notes about the Kahala turtle (5463, 5464) -- alas, not even a measurement. The nesting sighting was 6-9, and I also saw her basking on WS 6-15.

The enigma of tag recovery 3597 undoubtedly is a SL misread -- checked my notebook and I did indeed record on 6-14 a basking female 3597L, 96R (no spray paint!). Of course there's no telling, but it could be that I misread the "5" -- that same evening I saw a female night basking with the tag 3397L, and a tag right (which I didn't read). I'd be curious to know if her right tag is 3396. (Thanks for the pat on the back along with that note, too.)

Please keep those pictures of "84" with the wound. I agree that variations

in lighting and wetness can make those carapace smudges look very different, especially in a photo -- or when you're looking through binoculars at a turtle swimming in the water!

I really appreciate your sending the master recovery list to me -- gives me quite a thrill finding the SLs, and looking through to see who you saw this summer. Intriguing about those Whale-Skate turtles moving to East at the end of the season..... Hopefully it won't take too long to write up a report to FWS. School starts this Saturday and from then on I expect I'll be around the lab quite a bit so we can talk in person. Give me a call if I can do anything more, or if I've forgotten something.

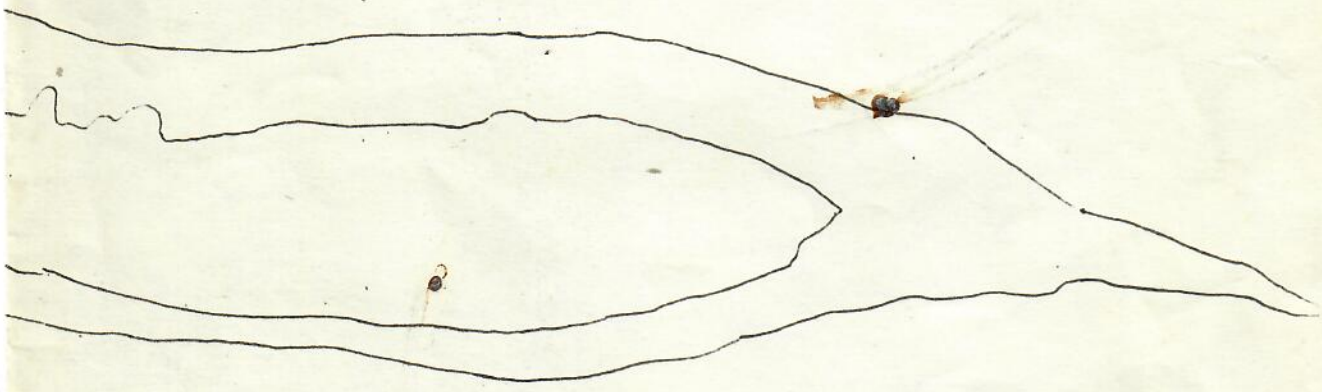

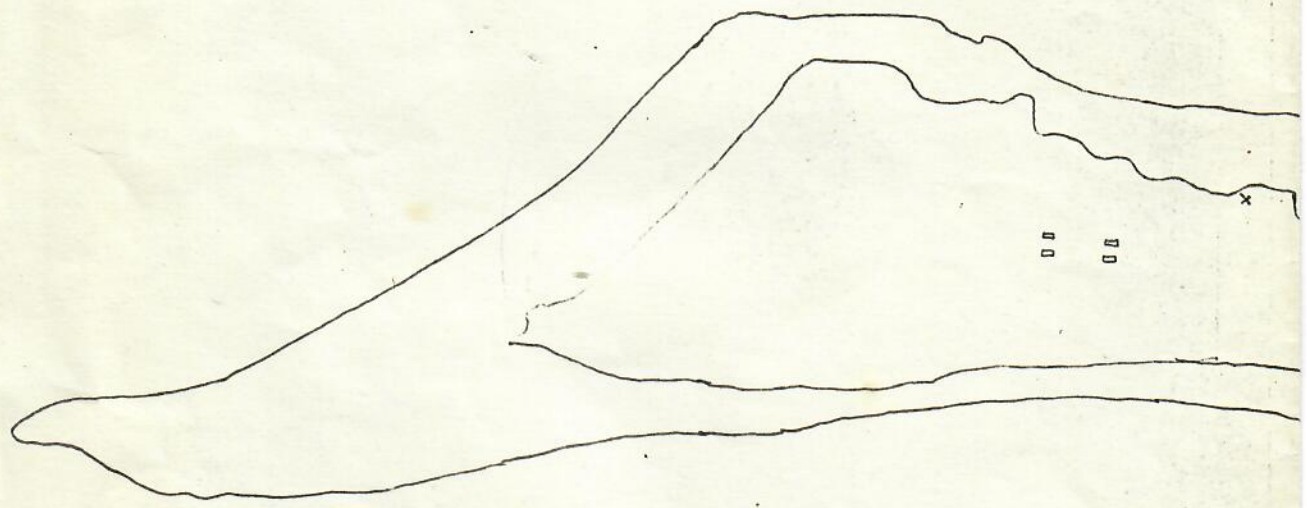
