Basic attachment procedure used with following modifications:

- (2) Poked hole in 15" length-wise piece, and notched-out each side to accommodate screw heads on anterior surface.

(3) Used pieces of brown plastic bag to mask-out white of transmitter.

4. Alcohol, instead of acetone used to clean carapace.

**FIBERGLASS HAWAII SURFBOARD RESIN** is specially formulated to prevent the yellowing of polyurethane foam surfboards.

**SURFBOARD LAMINATING RESIN** should be used in the application of the one or two layers of fiberglass cloth. The surface will remain tacky, and be difficult to sand.

**SURFBOARD SANDING RESIN** is used after the laminating resin to build up the resin thickness in preparation for sanding. It will dry with a hard surface, which can be sanded.

**SURFBOARD FINISHING RESIN** is used for the final gloss coat. It is sometimes thinned with styrene or acetone in order to flow out better. Any dull appearance (wax) may be removed by buffing with rubbing compound.

**REPAIRING SURFBOARDS.** Sanding or finishing resin may be used for repairs. If more than one coat is needed, the wax must be sanded off before the next coat is applied.

**MIXING THE RESIN.** To avoid waste, never mix more resin than can be used in a few minutes. Once mixed, it must be applied immediately. Use approximately 10 drops of catalyst per ounce, ¼ ounce per pint or 2 ounces per gallon. Set-up time will vary depending on weather conditions, thickness of the layer of resin and materials added to the resin for coloring and thickening. Tests should be made before each use to determine amount of catalyst to use for desired set-up time. The final or gloss coat generally requires more catalyst. One gallon of resin will cover approximately 45 square feet of Fiberglass with three coats.

**CAUTION.** Contains organic solvent. Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid prolonged breathing of vapor. Avoid prolonged or repeated contact with skin. Keep cool to prolong shelf life.

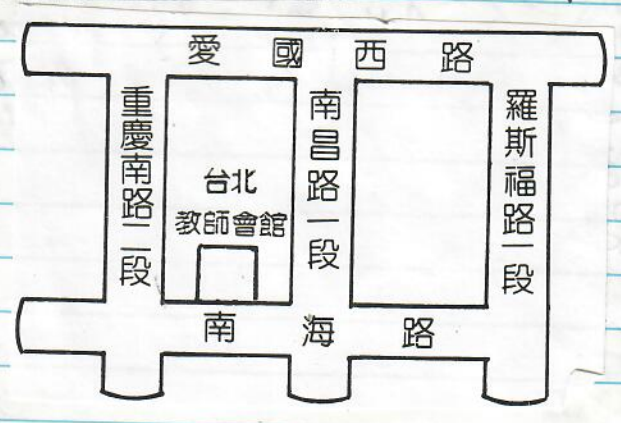

Small turtle already present covering near 3 deep excavations where grabs were going to be relocated to, prior to cement roadway being removed. Relocation graves were next to cement road and this was considered a desecration. Noted again that coverup was very shallow, unlike a green - Body pit (almost non-existent). See photos. (I proceeded later to try to dig out eggs [to show his shell?]) Farmer egg poacher. (The other one on the island was caught on tickets?) Eggs not found. "Restraining pen" put on turtle at ~3am and held-watched until 5am when we returned. Unlike other turtle, the 30" width of pen allowed the turtle to turn around.

If worked released turtle recaptured,  
it had to be sold at a lower

# Typhoon Gladys kills 6, spurs landslides in Taiwan

TAIPEI — Typhoon Gladys battered Taiwan today with 78 mph winds, killing six people and setting off landslides and widespread power disruptions.

The typhoon forced the cancellation of more than 300 domestic flights and triggered landslides that closed highways. More than 300,000 homes were without electricity.

A 22,000-ton Indian freighter ran aground off Yehliu in northern Taiwan, but rescuers fastened ropes to the vessel so the 40 crew members could climb safely to shore, police said. Tons of oil

leaked from the ship, the Kalidas, and police said they feared substantial damage to the coast, known for its beautiful rock formations.

Five people died in Ilan in eastern Taiwan. A woman was killed when an electricity pole fell on her car, a man drowned in a flooded river, and three other people were killed by falling objects, police said. Another woman was killed when strong winds brought down her house in Taoyuan in northern Taiwan, police said.

Seventeen people were injured by shattered glass or falling billboards in Taipei, they said.
