About Hurricane Walaka washing away the green turtle (honu) nesting island of Hikina (East Island) in the Northwestern Hawaiian Islands ("Remote Hawaiian island largely wiped out by hurricane," Star-Advertiser, Oct. 26):

Surely this is one of the most exciting times of my 48-year career working with Hawaiian green turtles. The loss of East Island at French Frigate Shoals started decades ago, documented by photo evidence. My first stay on the island was as a University of Hawaii sea

turtle researcher in 1973.

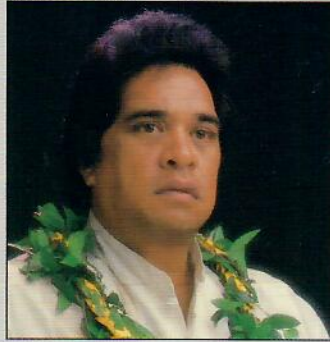
The loss of the island is part of a natural long-term process where sand, unlike stone, comes and goes, accumulates and then washes away in cycles. Sea turtles for millennia have always been able to adapt to such changes. If they hadn't they would all have gone extinct long ago.

The Hawaiian green turtle population is robust, durable and incredibly adaptive. They will figure out where to nest new and it will be insightful and amazing to watch it happen over the next few years.

Remote Hawaiian island

First, the island was there. Then, it was mostly gone.

Before Hurricane Walaka swept through the central Pacific this month, East Island was captured in images as an 11-acre sliver of sand that stood out starkly from the turquoise ocean.

After the storm, government officials confirmed the island, in the northwestern part of the Hawaiian archipelago, had been largely submerged by water, said Athline Clark of the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration. East Island is the second island to disappear in recent months from French Frigate Shoals, a crescent-shaped reef including many islets, Clark said.

Chip Fletcher, a climate scientist with the University of Hawaii who has been studying East Island's natural history, said it comprises loose sand and gravel rather than solid rock. His team had just taken geological samples from the island in July. But a little more than a week ago, he said, he was

alerted by government officials that it had mostly disappeared.

"From my experience in cases similar to this, I had just assumed that the island had another decade to three decades of life left," Fletcher said. "It is quite stunning that it is now, for the most part, gone."

Clark, the NOAA superintendent for the Papahānaumokuākea Marine National Monument, which includes the French Frigate Shoals, said no one immedi-

ately realized the island, located 750 miles northwest of Oahu, had largely disappeared because it is so remote.

East Island, with its sandy composition, wasn't much of a match for the storm in early October, which started off as a Category 5 hurricane and created large storm swells, Clark said.

Although experts cannot directly trace the shrinking of East Island to the effects of climate change, Clark said, it contributes to the

strength and frequency of hurricanes like the one that overtook the island. Scientists say hurricanes will be stronger because warmer water provides more energy to feed them.

"The intensity and frequency of storms is likely to increase," Clark said. "This is probably a forebear of things to come."

In 2016, President Barack Obama more than quadrupled the size of the Papahānaumokuākea national monument, turning it into

the world's largest protected marine area. Created by President George W. Bush a decade earlier, the monument is home to an estimated 7,000 marine and terrestrial species, a quarter of which are found nowhere else on Earth.

Charles Littnan, a conservation biologist with NOAA Pacific Islands Fisheries Science Center, said about 96 percent of Hawaiian green sea turtles, a threatened species, travel to the French Frigate Shoals to

nest. About half used East Island, Littnan said.

The shoals are also home to more than 200 endangered Hawaiian monk seals, he said. Only 1,400 of the species remain in the state.

The animals dodged the worst effects of the hurricane, Littnan said, because it struck late in their breeding seasons. Most of the turtles had already left the island by the time the storm hit.

When the turtles return next year, they may try to find another island on which to nest, Littnan said.

But it is possible that East Island will resurface and the turtles and seals will return to their seasonal homes. In images of the island after the storm, Littnan said he could already see that some monk seals had returned and hauled themselves onto the 150-foot-long patch of sand that remained.

He added the island's future was uncertain.

"We've seen islands disappear in the past and re-emerge," he said. "And we've had islands that disappear and they're gone 30 years later."

PICES PROJECT ON “SEA TURTLE ECOLOGY IN RELATION TO ENVIRONMENTAL STRESSORS IN THE NORTH PACIFIC REGIONS”

The Korean sector of PICES decided to fund a new PICES project entitled “*Sea Turtle Ecology in Relation to Environmental Stressors in the North Pacific Regions*”. The profile of the project is as follows.

Background

Most sea turtles are endangered species designated by IUCN. They are now receiving threats from multiple stressors induced by anthropogenic activities such as climate change, pollution and plastic garbage. Based on the PI group’s research (Jang et al. 2018) on the movement of green sea turtles bycaught in the Sea of Jeju Island of Korea, they have different movement patterns (1. Staying around Jeju Island 2, Moving toward Japan, and 3. Moving toward China) depending on individuals. It is necessary to reveal the connectivity of populations in the North Pacific regions and to identify the major environmental stressors to them to conserve the sea turtles in the North Pacific areas.

Project Goal and Key Questions

The overall project goal is to research the sea turtle population found in the North Pacific regions centering on Jeju Island of Korea to enhance the understanding of their habitat use and ecology related to anthropogenic activities. The project key questions are: (a) How the sea turtles found in Jeju Island, Korea, Kyusu Island, Japan, and Hongkong, China are connected to the other identified populations in the North Pacific areas and (b) What are the major environmental stressors to the sea turtles in the North Pacific regions.

Duration and Funding

The maximum project lifetime is 4 years: from the starting date of the project in 2018 to November 30, 2022. Funding for Year 1 (FY 2018), with ending November 30, 2019, is set at CAD 75,000. This amount includes a 15~20% overhead to be retained by PICES and Inha University to coordinate the project. Total funding for four years of this project is CAD 300,000.

Connection to PICES

The project is expected to interact with and support relevant activities of PICES Scientific Committees on Human Dimension (HD), PICES Technical Committee on Monitoring (MONITOR), and PICES FUTURE (*Forecasting and Understanding Trends, Uncertainty and Responses of North Pacific Ecosystems*) Program (specifically, Research Theme 1 on “*What determines an ecosystem’s intrinsic resilience and vulnerability to natural and anthropogenic forcing?*”).

Major Initiatives

The project is proposed to focus on the following two major initiatives:

1. Identifying the ecological information of the sea turtle population through the use of advanced tagging technologies, DNA analysis, and stable isotope analysis (e.g., identify habitat use and

'Iolani literature students clear limu

An eco-literacy class focuses on elements of island culture and community service

In a roped-off area about 10 yards square, the blue shallows of Maunalua Bay turned murky gray as 24 'Iolani School juniors and seniors waded in, slipping on rocks and slime, and plunged their arms underwater to grope for invasive limu and pull it out of the brine.



Others snared the alien algae with their toes, clad in reef shoes provided by Malama Maunalua, a nonprofit that leads regular shoreline cleanups with students and other volunteers from around Oahu.

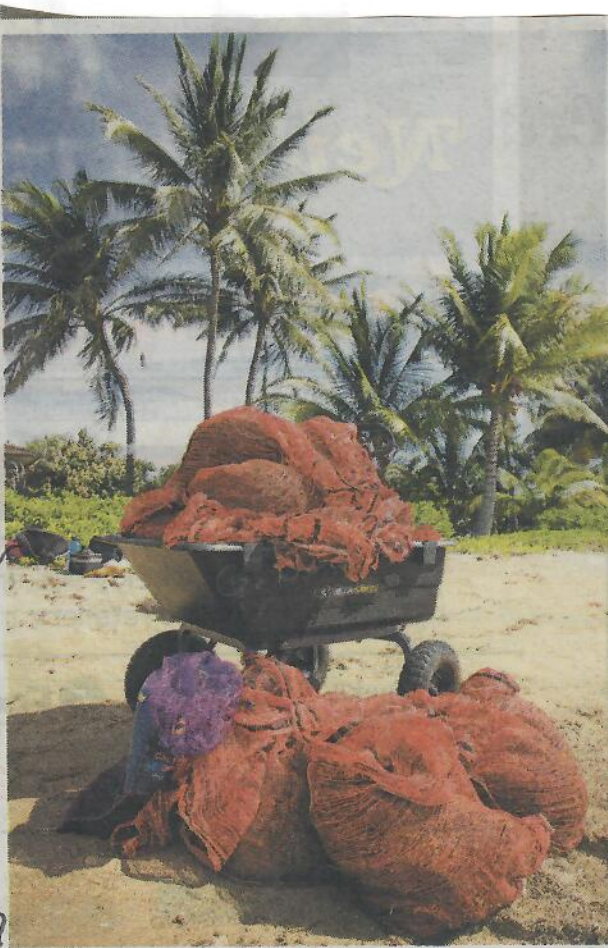
"You can feel it with your feet, and it's satisfying after you pick up everything you can and there's nothing left," said Sierra Moniz, who was participating in a field trip last month with her classmates in "Literature of the Ocean," an English class with an ecological theme.

The course examines "the connection between conservation and Hawaiian culture," said teacher Michelle Hill, who in 2016 crewed on the Hokule'a sailing canoe's Malama Honua (Care for the Earth) voyage.

It also encourages students to think about their own relationship to the ocean "as they contemplate how characters in literature find themselves through the sea."

Before starting their huki, or pull, near Paiko Lagoon, the students were briefed by Malama Maunalua members.

Uncle Ralph Dykes, a retired Punahou School biology teacher, showed them samples of invasive limu:

prickly seaweed and gorilla ogo, which covered 42% and 60%, respectively, of the area where they would be working, and which crowded out

native algae that other creatures in the ecosystem need to survive.

He also showed them native seaweed.

Bags of limu were to be taken to local farmers for compost, at left.

"Try not to remove these spiridia fluffballs and this bright-green caulerpa," Dykes said. "Put the bad stuff in the bag, the good stuff back in the ocean outside the ropes."

For more than two hours, the students filled big net bags with the bad limu, which would be donated to local farmers for use as fertilizer, while separating out and throwing back native limu, rocks and tiny mud-green crabs.

As they worked, Hill asked her students how this hands-on learning related to their class reading.

Wesley Yamada cited "The

- Without alien algae habitats of Hawaii would support far fewer turtles.
