Thanks for sharing that video. This reminded me of an encounter I had on Kauai with a Monk Seal and a turtle. I was not able to get a great video of the behavior but this clip shows a little of what was going on. <u>https://www.youtube.com/</u>watch?v=6gvwYpSpVhc

The Monk seal would flip the turtle onto its back and then push it to the surface and then push it around. At one point the monk seal actually put its whole mouth over the turtle's head as if it was going to bite it off, but then it would release it and flip it upside down again. This went on for about 10 minutes straight, then they both disappeared under the water and we never saw them again. When we first saw them in the water we thought they were tangled up together by fishing line or net or something, then we thought maybe they were just playing together, but eventually the way the turtle was struggling on its back trying to flip over made us think this was a cat and mouse scenario.

We were also wondering why the turtle just didn't swim away as we all know they can be pretty fast when they want to swim away? Our guess was that the monk seal somehow had overwhelmed the turtle and the turtle was just too exhausted to swim away, or maybe they were really just playing?? Not sure.
