On January 20th, Del Moss Sr. passed away. He would have been 90 years old on March 4th. His life has been full and rewarding and he has been a 44 year plus resident of Yucca Valley, moving here in 1957. Del and his wife Jeanette started the original "Del's Shoes" in 1958. Del saw the 'growing years' of Yucca Valley and was

a member of the Chamber of Commerce committee to bring street lights to our town. When he moved here there were no banks, supermarkets, car dealers or large discount stores. Del made a lot of friends that still survive today. He sold many people in the Morongo Basin their first pair of shoes. He and his wife, Jeanette, retired in 1970 enjoying extended vacations in Hawaii, Mexico, Montana and finally at "Sands RV & Country Club" in Desert Hot Springs where they fell in love with the game of golf. He leaves his wife Jeanette of 59 years, his two sons, Del Jr. and Bob Moss all of Yucca Valley, as well as grandchildren, Dan Moss of 29 Palms, Julie Luckart of Yucca Valley and Michael Moss of Las Vegas. Plus three great-grandchildren, Christine Moss, Ammon Luckart and Rachel Luckart. He was the last in a family of twelve children. During his life he was a member of Elks, Lions, Rotary, Toastmasters, and the Masonic Order and Student Body President at Excelsior Union School in Norwalk, Ca. in 1930. But most of all, he was a member to those 'special' people that bring joy to others through their smiles and laughter and giving spirit. His favorite quote was "A Little Nonsense now and then is cherished by the wisest men". He gave his heart to Jesus just prior to his passing. "Del", you will be missed
