


The Four Freshmen's graduation to the big time was sudden, dramatic—and logical. The rooting section of the New Jazz had been fidgeting for a vocal group that sang their brand of music. Along came the Freshmen, and they were it. The cheering has been getting louder ever since.

Because their voices, individually and collectively, are so agreeably listenable, it takes a while to realize that the Freshmen use them as though they were instruments. As a happy consequence, they are able to carry off complicated, unorthodox arrangements that are unhampered by the threadbare idioms of commonplace vocalizing. This unique facility stems from the quartet's musical grounding, formidable technique, and boldly imaginative concepts. One result of their vocal innovations is a growing list of highly successful albums. The earlier "Four Freshmen and Five Trombones," incidentally, pairs off nicely with this, their newest album.

The Freshmen's flair for ballads and suavely dissonant mood pieces is aptly demonstrated here in Good Night Sweetheart. After You've Gone rocks to the rhythmic pulse that is basic to all good jazz singing, whatever kind of jazz it may be.

Throughout the album, the group displays the sensitivity, good taste, and restraint that go hand in hand with top musicianship—the musicianship of four young perfectionists whose vocal trail-blazing has been stimulated rather than sidetracked by their extraordinary success.

Dick Reynolds wrote the arrangements and conducts. The five trumpets are Buddy Childers, Mannie Klein, Uan Rasey, Joe and Ray Triscari. Rhythm is handled by Milt Raskin, piano, Jack Marshall, guitar; Frank Carlson, drums; and Don Simpson, bass.




