 They are also fully protected by State law.
- Never feed fish or drop food or rubbish into the water.
 Human food and bought fish food can sicken fish and other marine life and disrupt the natural interactions between organisms that keep the ecosystem healthy.
- Never chase, move, or try to manipulate marine life.
 This can stress and harm the animals.
