## Dr. Miklos Dezso Ferenc Udvardy

Born March 23, 1919, in Debrecen, Hungary Died January 27, 1998, in Sacramento, California

Dr. Miklos D. F. Udvardy passed away in Sacramento on January 27, 1998, from complications following throat surgery.

Miklos D.F. Udvardy was a professor in the Department of Zoology at University of British Columbia in Vancouver, Canada, from 1952-1967. In 1967, he joined the faculty in the Department of Biology at California State University at Sacramento where he remained until retirement in 1991. He was a fellow of the American Association for the Advancement of Science, the American Ornithologists' Union, a consultant to the International Union for Conservation of Nature and Natural Resources, a member of the Hungarian Academy of Sciences, and was honored with the title, Honorary Doctor, at Debrecen University.

Miklos D.F. Udvardy is survived by his wife, Maud, his three children, Beatrix Andrew and Monica, and his two grandchildren, Jacob and Sarah. In addition to his family, he will be sadly missed by his sister, Agnes, other relatives in Hungary, and friends and colleagues throughout the world.
