Turtle disposal

A dead, tumor-riddled turtle weighing more than 150 pounds was found floating in the shore break off Waihee and was dragged ashore by fishermen Tuesday morning. After inspection by state Aquatic Biologist Skippy Hau, the turtle was taken to the Central Maui Sanitary Landfill, where its shell was crushed by a bulldozer to deter human scavengers.
