Story of Grubstake Days





EDUCATION



The Yucca Valley School provides nice modern classrooms for the education of children in grades Kindergarten through Eighth, Each room is completely equipped with the best in school furniture, equipment, and heating facilities. The school is strategically located in the center of the village so that it is within easy reach of the majority of the children.

Current enrollment provides approximately twenty-five children for each classroom. The teaching staff has extensive training and experience. The services of a school psychologist, school nurse, and instrumental and vocal music director are also provided.

The present construction program adds a multi-purpose cafeteria building and administrative office. These will be completed by the fall of 1957.

Daily bus transportation is provided for children living in Joshua Tree, Pioneertown and Morongo Valley. High school students are transported each school day to the Twentynine Palms High school.

Desert Christ Park

For the past 5 years the vista of the hillside on the North slope of Yucca Valley has been constantly changing as the Biblical statues take shape under the competent hand of Antone Martin. This modest but versatile gentleman not only conceives and designs the lifelike figures in the Desert Christ Park, but brings them to completion as the fruits of his own hard labor. Composed of concrete with reinforcement of steel, each subject requires much manual labor as well as technique.


The original statue of Christ was transported to its present site in the Spring of 1951, from the home of Mr. Martin in Inglewood. This was the result of the concerted efforts of Rev. Eddie Garver, the "Desert Parson," who foresaw the potentialities surrounding such a work of art. in the founding of a desert park. Then came a seated figure of Jesus, depicting the "Sermonon the Mount," with the likenesses of two little children near by. Later the statues of Judas and Peter were brought to occupy spots farther down the hillside. Mr. Martin soon realized the magnitude of his burning ambition to create a lasting memorial to Christianity, and decided to take up his abode in Yucca Valley in order to facilitate his work. Today, the twelve Apostles have become reality in sculpture, and are grouped intimately around their Saviour, to complete one phase of Mr. Martin's five-year program.

A new acquisition to the nationally famous park is a Wedding Chapel, created under the guidance, and largely by the hand of Frank Garske. The chapel, which is built of native rock, lifts its striking lines into the desert sky, with wing walls and spire of reddish stone piercing the blue in marked contrast. The root is of corrugated translucent plastic, filtering the sunlight to a pale azure within. An electric Hammond organ of the latest design is being installed to provide fitting volume of music for the magnanimity inspired by the harmonious surroundings of the Desert Christ Park.

Ample parking space is available, adjacent to the grounds, which also provides three barbecurpits, water fountains and adequate modern rest rooms for the thousands of visitors who enjoy the Park annually.

PLACES OF INTEREST

If you have only a few hours to spend on the Desert and wish to cover as much of it as possible, Desert Christ Park in Yucca Valley is a good place to start. Most noticeable along these hills are the numerous modern homes of folks like you—who came for a little visit and then arranged to own a plot of ground nearby. Just west and north of the park is three miles of winding asphalt road to Pioneertown where, if you are lucky, movie 'Westerns' are being 'shot' on MANE Street. Continuing west and north the road ambles into old ranches, homesteads, and new subdivisions—Pipes Canyon and saddle trails to the ridge of the San Bernardino Mountains.

Rimrock, once planned as Pioneertown's exclusive residential section, now boasts of one motel and beyond is 'broken' country and the back road to Big Bear Lake, You can drive through once-rich placer mining country—Rattlesnake Canyon and the old Rose Mine where still exist remains of old Spanish arrestas and smelters. There are picnic sites galore among the rocks and pinyon pines.

At what is now marked as Pioneer Springs crossroads, one can turn Eastward through foothills leading to Victorville and Old Woman Springs junctions—to 'George's Skyroom Cafe and private landing field— to Giant Rock Air Port, of flying saucer fame,

The modern desert traveler enjoys the past efforts of pioneers who left behind them a trail of developed springs and deep wells, cabins and cafes. The recent crop of '5-acre tracters' have blazed dim trails with thousands of signs, small and large, over-shadowed by imposing realtors billboards, and one can afford to be choosy.

Still further East stretches the United States Marine Base at Twentynine Palms. Complete in itself, it sends long lines of convoys like trails of determined ants across the floor of the desert. Americans bless the power that keeps their boys fit and ready for defense.

The nationally-known Joshua Tree National Monument headquarters are at Twentynine Palms and information on numerous dry camps and traces of prehistoric man may be obtained at the 'Oasis of Mara' there.

Rock hounds and sightseers have no more concern for survival on the treacherous Colorado Desert because of passable, maintained roads. The Baseline highway to the Colorado river was a mere dream twenty years ago—today it is the "open sesame" to progress and future transcontinental thoroughfare.

Geographic barriers have never stopped the strong—and so— in a natural setting—with plenty of pure air and water—plus health-giving violet rays, Yucca Valley is already the hub of Hi-Desert activity.



JOSHUA TREE

Eight miles East of Yucca Valley is a community of friendly folks who, in the early thirties, named their place under the sun Joshua Tree.

With an elevation of about 3000 feet above sea level and plenty of water that tests ninty-eight per cent pure, and generally temperate weather, they attract 'city cousins' throughout the year.

From the center of the town hills slope up to the Western entrance of scenic Joshua Tree National Monument, fabulous land of mountainous rocks and caves where evidence of prehistoric man may be found.

Joshua Tree is nationally known as the 'HOME OF THE TURTLE RACES'. Land turtles of the west are brought here to compete with the Desert Denizens which are rounded up in the spring by interested folks of Greater Morongo Basin. Traditionally, races are held on the week end of the first Sunday in May.

Rapidly gaining attention for its beauty and simplicity, is the annual Christmas pageant, which is presented as a non-profit community Christian project, each night during the week before Christmas.

TWENTYNINE PALMS

Twentynine Palms is the oldest and largest of the High Desert cities. Located between the Little San Bernardino Mountains and the Calico Mountains, it commands an inspiring view. Utah Trail is the beginning of the Eastern gateway to the world-famed Joshua National Monument. This thriving community of approximately 6,000 residents, comprises a large area. The High School is extremely modern and well equipped. An addition of equal size is planned this fall, as well as an annexation to the elementary school.

The Oasis of Mara, a distinguished landmark, was once farmed by Indians Of the Chemehuevi tribe, the last of whom left the area about 1913. The farmland around the oasis was fed by gravity flow water from an Indian made lake. Mah-rah, as the Indians called the oasis, meant "much water and grass". The spelling was changed by the white man to Mara.

The name of Twentynine Palms came at a time when only that many palms graced the oasis. It now has many more and is embraced in a Park System of the Department of the Interior.

Five miles from the center of town is the largest Marine Training Center. It covers an area of approximately 936 square miles and has proved to be a decided asset to the community.

Twentynine Palms is no longer the end of the line in the high desert. By the way of Amboy on route 66, some twenty miles can be saved going east from Los Angeles. The Baseline Highway, directly east from four corners, reduces mileage about ninety miles.
