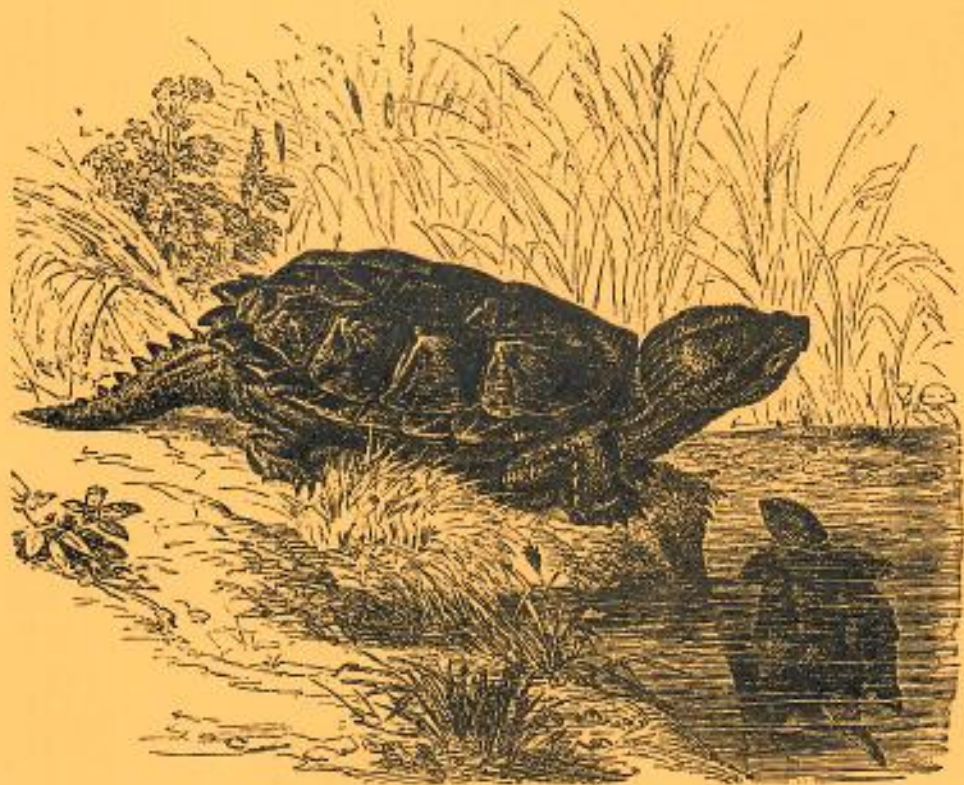

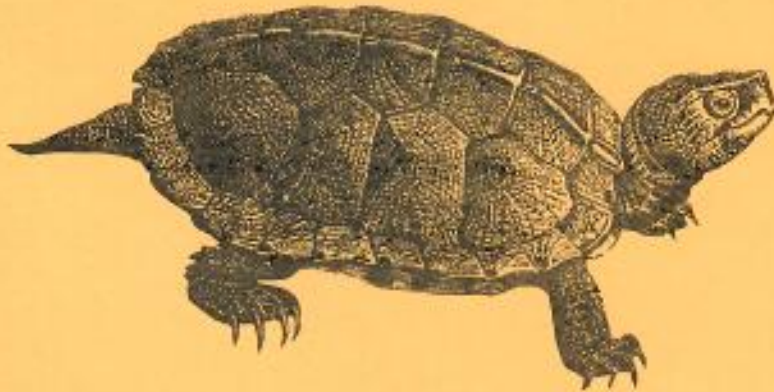

PREFACE

This is a listing of all of the known stamps from throughout the world that depict turtles, tortoises, or terrapins or which are in some way related to turtles, tortoises, or terrapins, even though they do not depict a chelonian. Thus, a stamp is included in the list which pictures the Turtle Beach Hotel and a number of stamps are included which show a lighthouse called the Turtle Lighthouse, even though there are no turtles pictured on those stamps. Some stamps of questionable postal validity are also included, such as the stamp from Upper Yafa and the stamps from Dhufar.

It is our goal to make this list as inclusive and complete as possible, so that anyone can look it over and decide what they may want to include in their collection and what they do not wish to include. Many collectors enjoy collecting Cinderella material and if they wish to do so, this list will be helpful to them. On the other hand, purists can use the list as well, ignoring or rejecting materials whose credentials they do not wish to accept. The mere inclusion of an item in this list does not imply that every turtle stamp collector should try to obtain that particular item.

Major variations in stamps are included in the list, but not every minor variation. An attempt has been made to include all variations which are listed separately, under a unique number, in at least one catalog. Many stamps exist in perforate and imperforate forms and these are not included in this list as different stamps. Similarly, stamps which differ only in the printing process by which they were produced, are not listed separately.

With one exception, the scientific names of the turtles on this list conform to the nomenclature of Ernst and Barbour (Ernst, Carl H. and Roger W. Barbour. 1989. Smithsonian Institution Press, Washington and London. ISBN 0-87474-414-8). The one exception is the taxonomy and nomenclature of the Galapagos Tortoise Complex. Ernst and Barbour have divided the giant tortoises inhabiting the Galapagos Archipelago into 12 separate species. In this list, they are treated as a single species (Geochelone elephantopus), with a number of subspecies.

A "0" in the column headed "Cat. #" means that no catalog number is known for that particular stamp at the present time. Stamps in this category will normally be at the beginning of a country list.

CHANGES IN TAXONOMIC NOMENCLATURE

As explained in the Preface, the taxonomy used in this list follows that of Ernst and Barbour (1989), with the exception of the Galapagos Tortoise Complex. As a result of changing the taxonomic authority from that used in previous lists, a number of names used in previous editions of the list have been changed. To minimize any confusion, the following synonymy lists the name used in previous editions of the list and the name used in the current edition.

#1. DAHLAK ISLANDS - The 7 cancellations available on the Dahlak Islands sheet are as follows:

1. No cancellation

4. Canceled at Forward Base No. 2 29 Dec 69

7. Canceled at Rear Base Massawa 24 Dec 69

These stamps were issued to commemorate the Scientific Exploration Society of England's expedition to the islands in 1969-70.

#2. BERNERA ISLANDS - The stamps listed are local post stamps issued for Great Bernera and Little Bernera Islands, which lie northwest of the Isle of Lewis in the Outer Hebrides. Four mailboxes are maintained on the islands and they are serviced at regular intervals. The mail is collected and re-mailed at a nearby British Post Office with regular British postage added.

#3. ST. PIERRE AND MIQUELON - The "F.N.F.L." o/p on some of these stamps stands for "Forces Navales Francaises Libres" or "Free French Naval Forces". The "Noel 1941" o/p on some of these stamps refers to a Christmas Day plebiscite ordered by Vice Admiral Emile Henri Muselier, commander of the Free French Naval Forces.

#4. SEYCHELLES - All stamps depicting the Seychelles Coat-of-Arms are turtle stamps because a turtle appears on the Arms. Starting in 1978, all Seychelles stamps have a very small Coat-of-Arms on them, and thus are technically turtle stamps. However, since the turtle is indistinguishable to the naked eye, and since it barely looks like a turtle, even under magnification, due to insufficient resolution, these stamps are not included in the list.

#5. STAFFA - This island is in the Inner Hebrides, 7 miles west of Mull and 6 miles northeast of Iona. The Laird of Staffa has established a Postal Service which operates daily from April to September. Mail is picked up and carried by a boatman to British Post Offices on Mull and Iona, where it is re-mailed with regular British postage added.

#6. TONGA - Tonga has issued approximately 200 stamps on paper which is watermarked with a turtle design. Most of these do not have a turtle on the face of the stamp and are not included in this list.

END NOTES (continued)

#7. ZIL ELWANNYEN SESEL SEYCHELLES (Also spelled "ZIL ELOIGNE SESEL SEYCHELLES" and "ZIL ELWAGNE SESEL SEYCHELLES") - This group of Islands is the former British Indian Ocean Territory. Since being returned to the Seychelles Islands, they have issued their own stamps, each bearing a small imprint of the Seychelles Coat-of-Arms. Since the Seychelles Coat-of-Arms has a turtle on it, every one of their stamps is technically a turtle stamp. However the turtle is too small to be seen by the naked eye and so the stamps are not included in this list. See discussion of this problem under End Note #4. ZIL ELWANNYEN SESEL SEYCHELLES is listed at the end of SEYCHELLES in the Scott Catalog.

APPENDIX I

NATIONAL WILDLIFE FEDERATION STAMPS

Each year since 1938 the National Wildlife Federation has issued stamps as a means of raising revenue. Three "series" of stamps are currently being issued each year; the "Annual Series", the "Spring Series", and the "Christmas Series". All of the turtle stamps have appeared in the Annual Series. LABELS, SEALS, ADVERTISING STAMPS, ETC.

BRISBANE (AUSTRALIA) LION'S CLUB

Christmas seal depicting three stylized sea turtles. Two have Christmas packages on their backs and one is carrying a scroll in its mouth that says "Peace". 1986.

BRITISH DIABETIC ASSOCIATION

Christmas seal depicting a stylized tortoise w/ a Christmas package on its back and the words "Merry Christmas" across the top of the stamp. Date unknown.

CAILLER'S CHOCOLATE COMPANY

A series of stamps, apparently given away with the company's products, and intended to be mounted in an album, probably supplied by the company. Most of the stamps have the name of the turtle in Latin, French, and German, but not English. The dates of issue are unknown, but they are obviously quite old.

SERIES VII, NO. 1 - *Terrapene carolina* (but identified on the stamp as "*Testudo graeca*").

SERIES VII, NO. 2 - *Emys orbicularis* (?) (identified on the stamp as "*Emys lutaria*").

SERIES VII, NO. 3 - *Geochelone radiata*.

SERIES VII, NO. 4 - *Hydromedusa maximiliani*.

SERIES VII, NO. 6 - *Geochelone gigantea* (identified on the stamp as "*Testudo elephantina*").

SERIES LXI, NO. 5 - *Chelus fimbriata*.

CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME

California Fish and Game issues a native species stamp each year. In 1991 it was a \$9.20 value depicting *Xerobates (=Gopherus) agassizii*.

CLEVELAND ZOO

(Cleveland, Ohio, USA) *Geochelone gigantea* 2 Mar 75
(Local Post)

DANISH RED CROSS

Sheet Number 66. (Maerkat stamp numbers 15078 through 15093) contains one *Chelydra serpentina*, one *Chelonia mydas*, one *Testudo* sp., and one *Emys orbicularis*. All 16 stamps on this sheet are reptiles. 1974

EAGLE STAMP CO.

(Spokane, Wash., USA) Mailman riding on stylized turtle w/ "ZIP" written on its shell. Stamp says "U.S. Mail 1776-1976". Issued 1976

GREENPEACE

This organization issued two stamps depicting a hatchling sea turtle. One stamp has a yellow border and one has a light blue border. Neither one has a date nor a denom.

KOREAN TUBERCULOSIS SEALS

Five designs, one of which is a stylized turtle. 1980

LORD HOWE ISLAND

(Near Australia) Postal label w/ the skeleton of *Meiolania*, an extinct chelonian from the Pleistocene of Australia.

PENNSYLVANIA NATURE CONSERVANCY

Clemmys muhlenbergii and ducklings on a \$5.00 stamp issued in 1990.

PINEAPPLE POST

Local Post Issue from Hawaii depicting Chelonia mydas. 15 cent denom. Issued 26 Mar 1986 in sheets of ten, with a printing of 1,000 sheets. It was the local's 34th issue, the first being 11 Jun 77, and the last being 29 Nov 87. The post was run by Craig Miyamoto to the Makiki P.O., ZIP 96882.

RHODESIAN TUBERCULOSIS SEALS

Sheet of 25 stamps issued in 1973. One stamp depicts a freshwater chelonian generally resembling Kinosternon, but possibly Pelusios or Pelomedusa.

SPAINISH CIVIL WAR

Two revenue stamps from the Spanish Civil War, (1936-39). Both show a tortoise and have the wording: "JUNTA LOCAL DE DEFENSA PASIVA - CASTELLON". One stamp is green (5 cts denom.) and the other is red (10 cts denom.)

THAILAND TUBERCULOSIS CHRISTMAS SEALS

Stylized turtles underwater near base of an aquatic plant, which is the major design feature. 1968

APPENDIX III

TURTLE "LOOK-ALIKE" STAMPS

The following stamps depict extinct animals which are NOT turtles or tortoises, but which look superficially very much like chelonians. For this reason they have been included in various lists of turtle stamps, and are even described as turtle stamps in some major catalogs. This has caused confusion and misunderstanding. They are included here in an effort to explain the situation and to help resolve the confusion.

Note that none of the animals on the stamps listed below belong to even the same Sub-Class to which turtles belong (Sub-Class Anapsida). The only relationship that these animals have with turtles is that they are all reptiles. Thus, these animals are no more closely related to turtles than are snakes or crocodiles.

HUNGARY

1996 *Placochelys placodonta*. 21 Sept 69. This extinct reptile is a Triassic placodont belonging to the Sub-Class Euriapsida, Order Placodontia, Family Placochelyidae. It is in no way related to turtles but appears turtle-like due to convergent evolution. The Scott Catalog incorrectly calls it a turtle.

SAN MARINO

618 *Thaumatosauros victor*. 30 June 65. This extinct reptile is a Jurassic plesiosaur belonging to the Sub-Class Euriapsida, Order Sauropteria, Sub-Order Plesiosauria, Family Thaumatosauridae. It is in no way related to turtles but appears turtle-like due to convergent evolution.

SIERRA LEONE

Henodus sp. 8 June 92. This extinct reptile is from the Upper Triassic of Europe. It belongs to the Sub-Class Euriapsida, Order Placodontia, Family Henodontidae. It is in no way related to turtles, but appears turtle-like due to convergent evolution.

Dear Fellow Turtle Stamp Collector,

Enclosed please find Supplement Number 1 to the turtle stamp list of 02/03/94. This supplement has followed very quickly on the heels of the original list because of all the feed-back that the list generated.

Surprisingly, much of the feed-back I received was contradictory, especially in regard to catalog numbers and issue dates. I tried to sift through it all and include the most accurate data possible in the supplement.

I was wondering why so much contradictory information should be floating around out there, when I received my May, 1994 issue of Scott's Stamp Monthly. The article entitled "They Take a Licking" on page 4 explains part of the reason for the confusion. I am enclosing a photocopy for those of you who do not get the magazine.

Please note that not all of the entries in Supplement Number 1 are entirely new stamps to the list. Many entries merely include new dates, new catalog numbers, or other new information about stamps already on the list. Other types of changes, including deletions, are listed on page 8.

I realized years ago that this list can never be 100% complete or 100% accurate and I have accepted that fact. For example, even before this supplement came back from the printer, I became aware of a change. The first item on page 6 (under Malagasy Republic) should not be a block of four reptile stamps. It should be a sheetlet of sixteen stamps, including four dogs, four domestic cats, four beetles, and four reptiles (including the radiated tortoise). It will be corrected in Supplement Number 2, whenever that comes out.

Thank you all for your input.

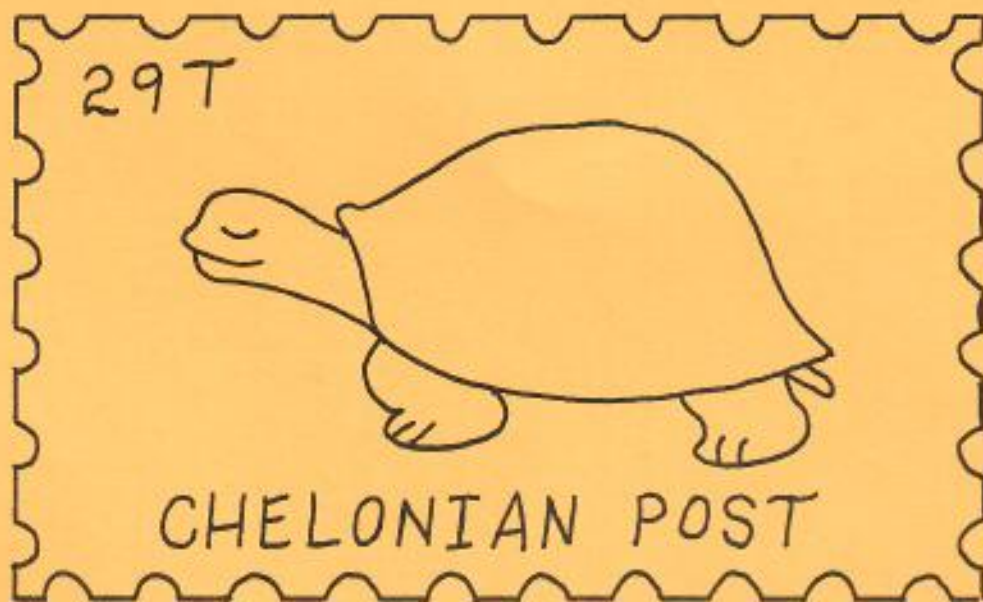

SUPPLEMENT NUMBER 1 OF

A WORLDWIDE LIST OF TURTLES AND TORTOISES ON STAMPS

1. DELETE the stamps from UNITED NATIONS OFFICES IN GENEVA and UNITED NATIONS OFFICES IN VIENNA. These stamps do not depict turtles. Erroneous information was given to the authors.

2. DELETE BRAZIL SC# 2316-17. What had been reported to be small tortoises, turned out to be piles of stones.

3. ADD the following information to End Note #3 on page 35 of the list:

Although the lighthouse stamps from ST. PIERRE AND MIQUELON are inscribed "Phare de la Tortue", this is apparently an error. According to Don L. Gary, writing in THE PHAROS (Vol. 8, No. 6, March 1981), the lighthouse is known as the "Pointe aux Canons" lighthouse. Mr. J. Lehuenen, of the St. Pierre and Miquelon Merchant Marines, agrees the name is "Pointe aux Canons Lighthouse". He suspects that the stamp designers were working on these stamps and some other lighthouse stamps simultaneously and the wrong name was inscribed on the St. Pierre and Miquelon stamps. Despite the apparent error, the stamps are inscribed "Phare de la Tortue" and as a result, they will remain on the list.

4. ADD the name of Ernst and Barbour's book to the fourth paragraph of the Preface (page ii). The name of the book is: Turtles of the World.

5. ADD a postal label to Appendix II (page 39). The label has a 2d denomination, a picture of a Galapagos Island Tortoise, the words "Galapagos Tortoise" and "POSEN" all printed in red on a white background. The FDC is postmarked 1 Feb 1975 at Posen, IL 60409. The purpose of the label is unknown.

6. DELETE the Tanzanian s/s of 1991 (first item listed under TANZANIA). This is the s/s of 1992 which is included in this supplement.
