# Bugs Bunny's MERRY-GO-ROUND



What is a visit to a County Fair without a ride on the merry-go-round? Bugs had so much fun, he made a model as a reminder. If you follow his easy directions, you can make one, too. Out of colored construction paper, cut a wedge like Fig. 1, following the dimensions shown there. Then lap one edge over the other until you have a perfect cone, like Fig. 2, and glue together. Fold the tabs back and glue them onto the top of a round box such as an oatmeal box. For the canopy, use sturdy white typewriter paper so that you can color and decorate it. Cut a circle six inches in diameter, then cut out a circle one half inch in diameter

in the center. Next, make a slit from the center hole to the outside edge, as shown in Fig. 3. Now, overlap the two cut sides and glue together to form a shallow cone, like Fig. 4. Drop the canopy onto the cone. Finally, cut out the figures of Bugs, Porky, Sylvester, and Elmer, fold the tabs on the dotted lines, and paste them on the box top. Now your model merry-go-round is ready to set on your chest or dresser. If you want to put it into action, poke the sharpened end of a pencil up through the bottom of the box top so that the point of the pencil extends into the cone, and spin your County Fair Merry-Go-Round around and around.

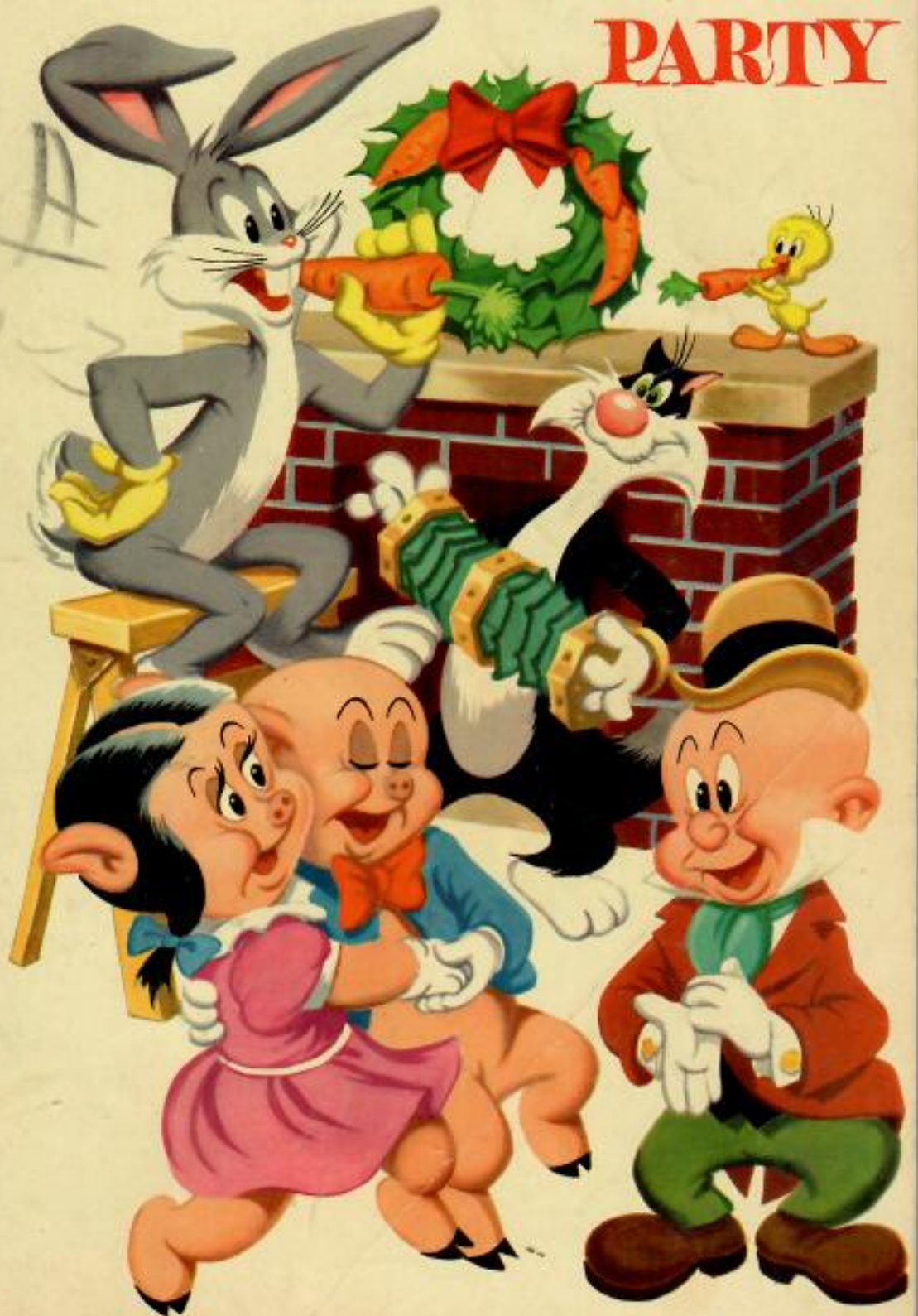

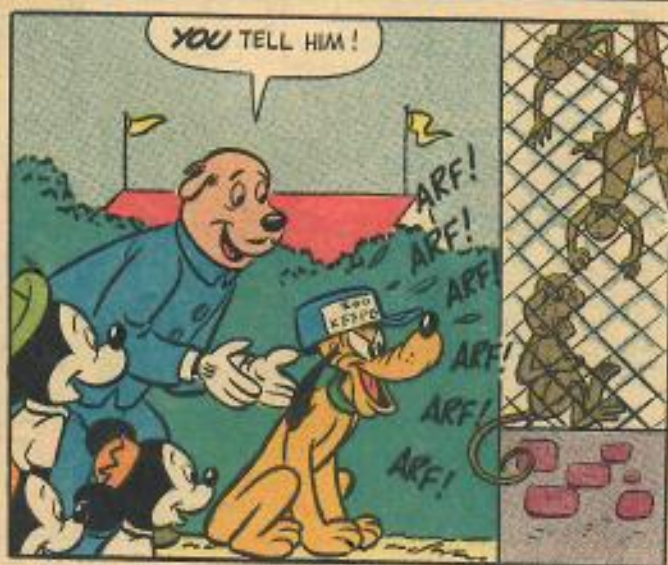
