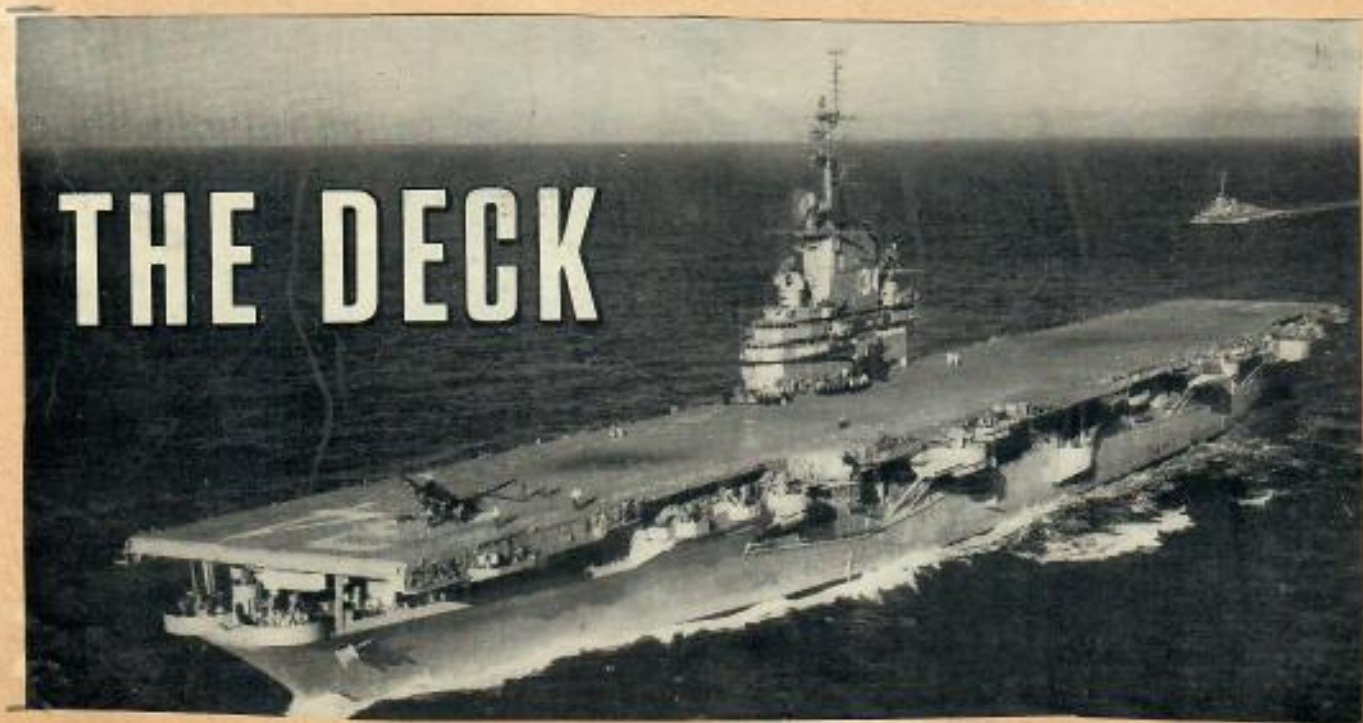

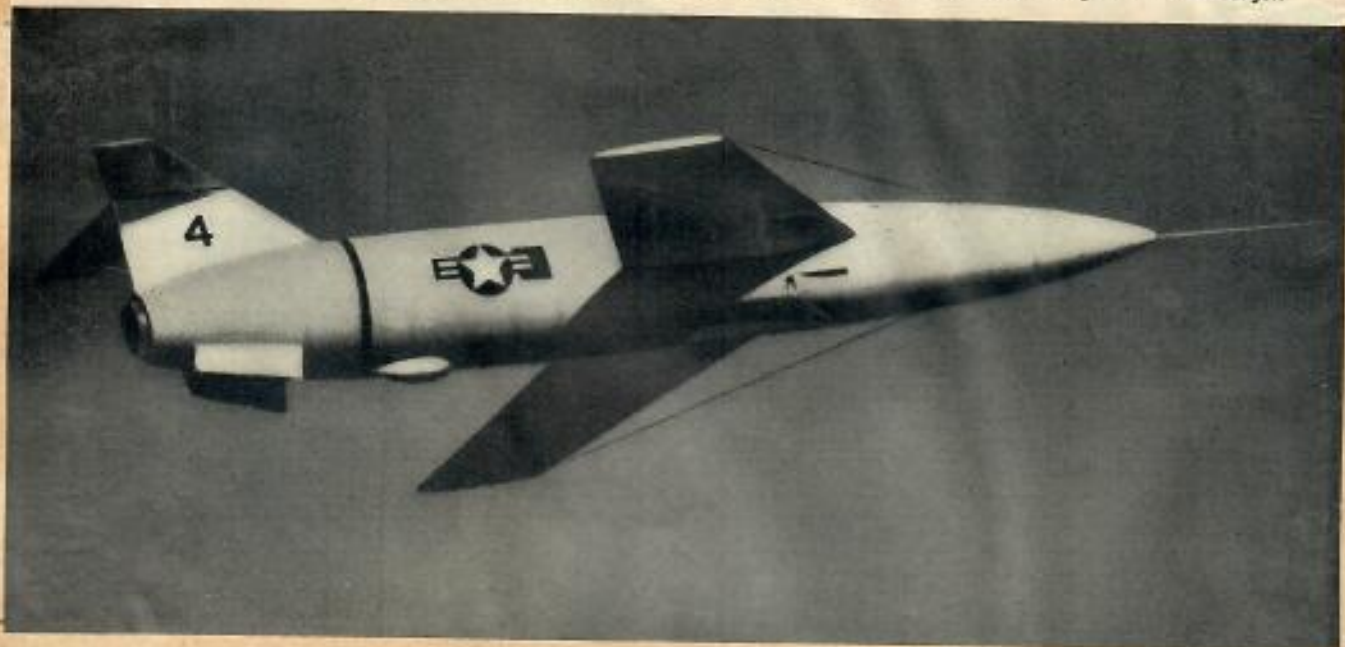

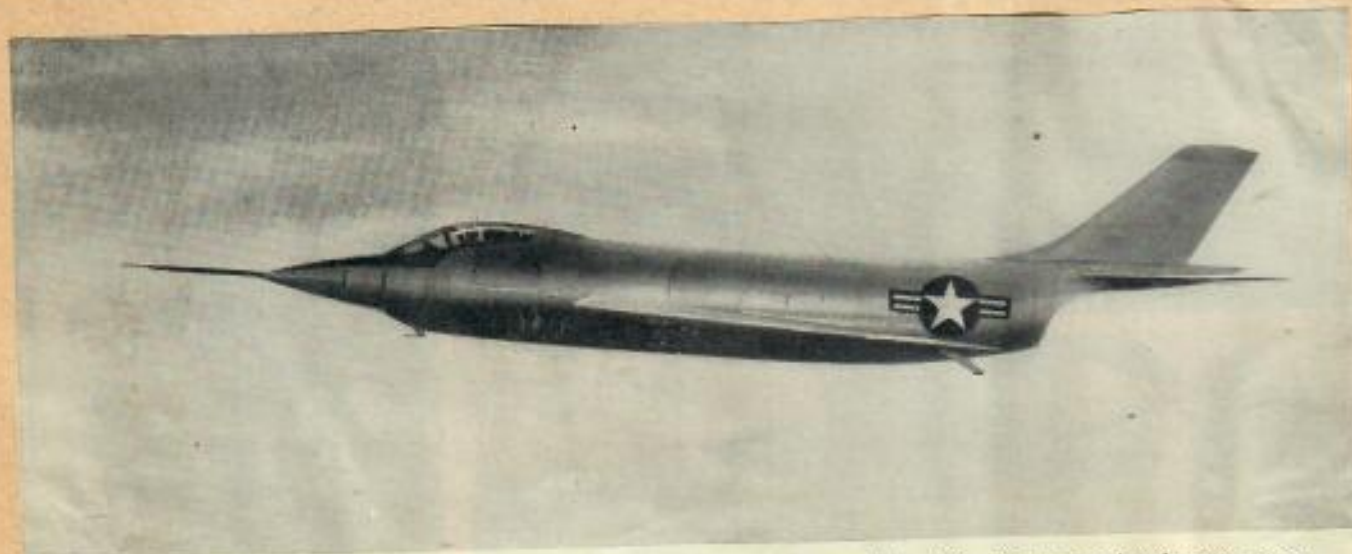
Photographer-frogman swims with submarine camera which propels itself and takes motion pictures of submerged hazards.

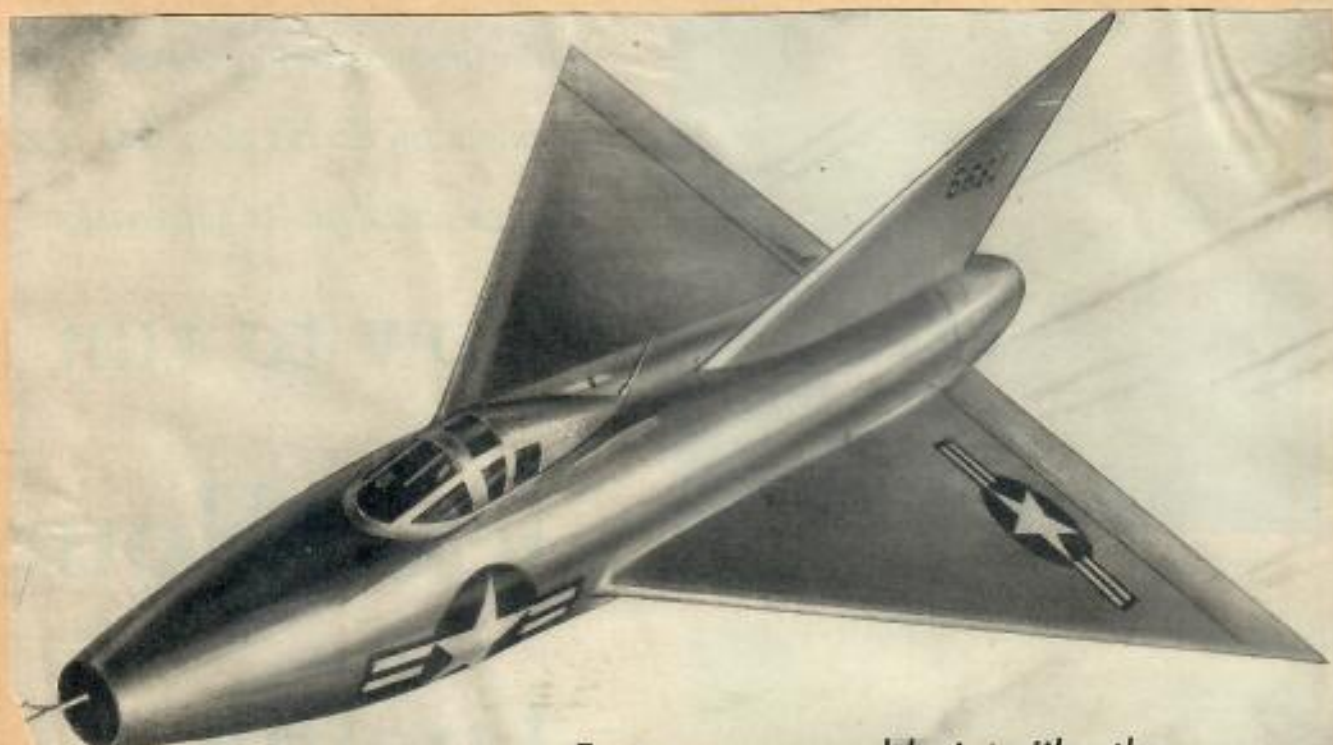


Atom Bomber

Ten engines on mammoth B-36D Intercontinental A-bomber give top speed of 435 m.p.h. Plane grosses over 179 tons.

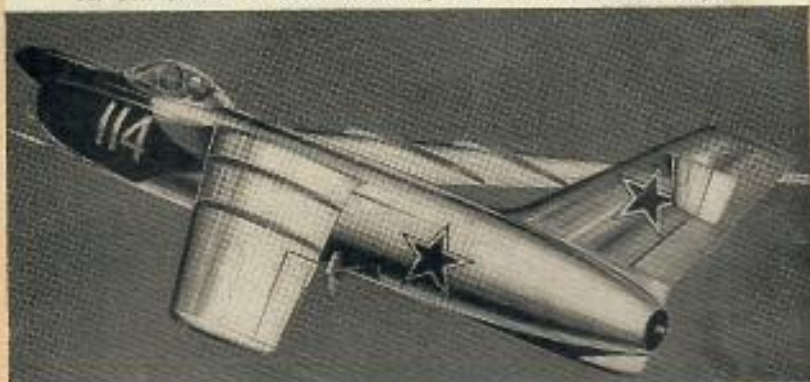


Fast, maneuverable jets like these would battle for air superiority in any war in the next few years.

This sleek fighter, modified La-17, is another Red jet which may challenge our best aircraft. It has M-45 turbojet and an M-718 rocket engine.

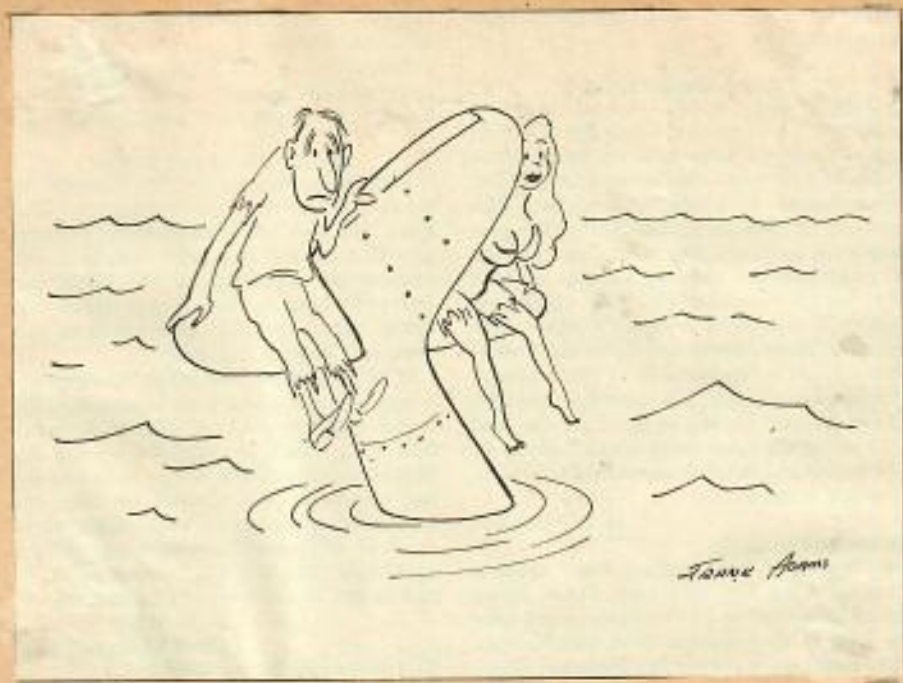


Another new RAF jet is the Supermarine Swift which has an Avon engine. Six factories are to produce this sleek fighter.

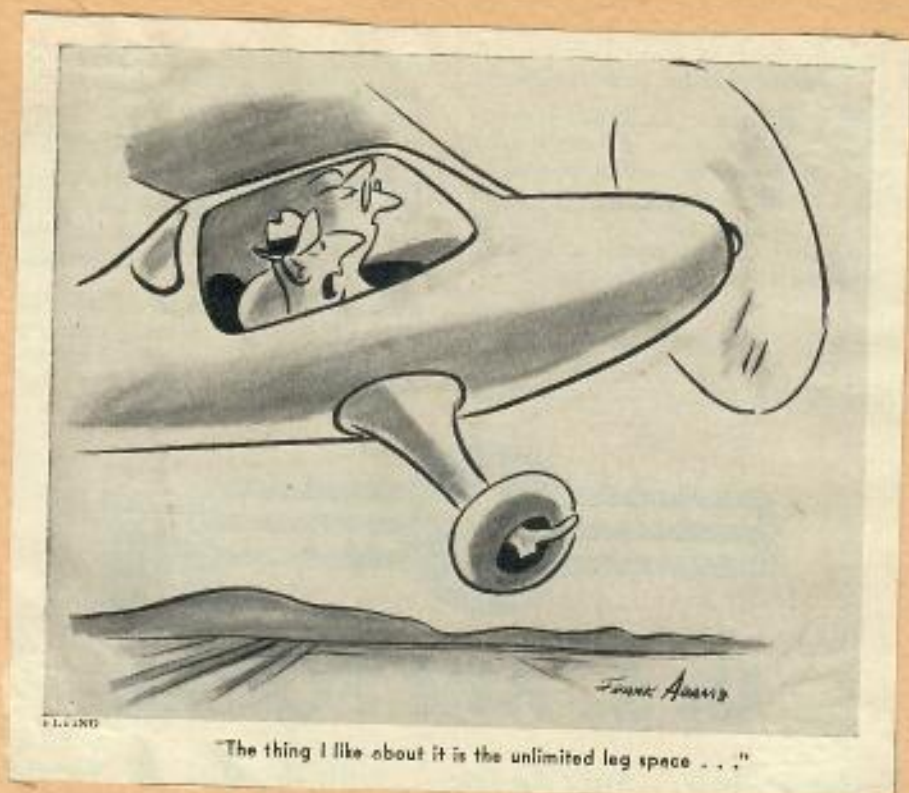

 my own grandfather. And there you are.

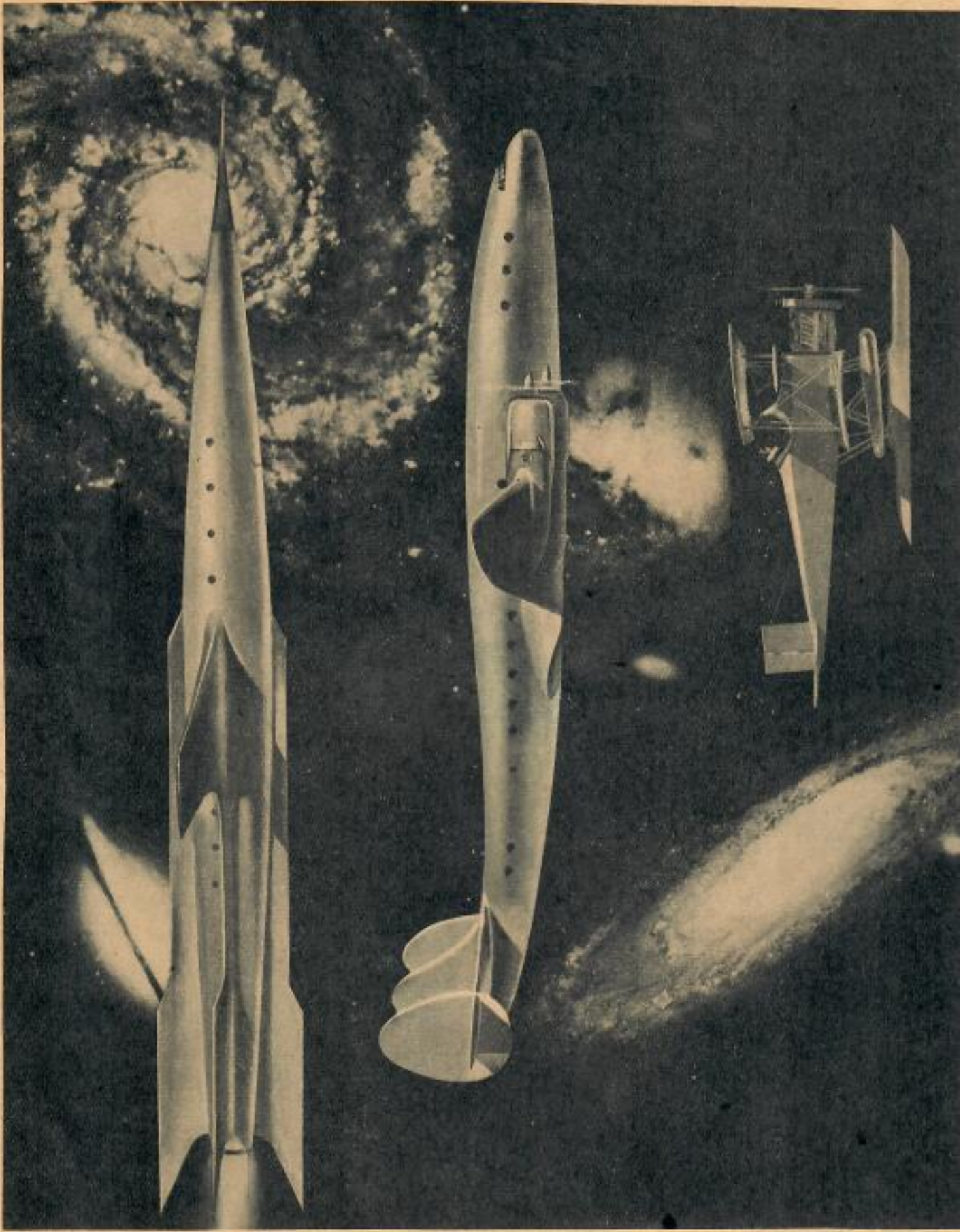

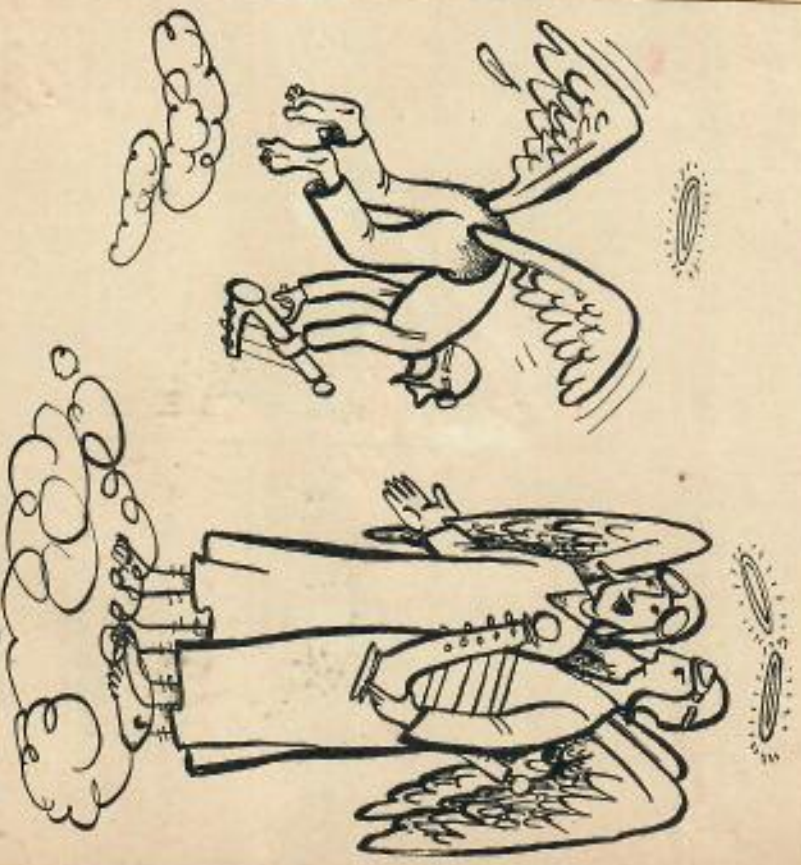

ENTHUSIASTIC AUDIENCE ATTENDS VARIETY SHOW

YUCCA VALLEY—The Yucca Valley Community Players gave demonstration of their histrionic ability and civic mindedness by staging variety shows, one on Thursday and the other on Friday evening, for the benefit of the Chamber of Commerce.

The turnout of residents and visitors of this High Desert town who packed Community Hall for the entertainment testified to the popularity and ability of the players.

The public spirit and good-fellowship of Yucca Valley's people was succinctly summed up by Hank Creaser, president of the Chamber of Commerce, who declared: "In any community where people take time to enjoy a song and a laugh there is no time for failure." The friendly folk of this community take time to enjoy song and laughter as was amply demonstrated by the two nights of fun in behalf of the Chamber of Commerce.

In addition to a well enacted farce in which a jury selected from the audience took part, a vaudeville program with eight splendid offerings delighted those who packed the hall and registered the fact that they possess funny-bones.

The one act farce entitled "Plummer versus Plummer — a Case for Divorce" brought down the house with its hilarious lines

and comedy situations. The players who gave proof of professional ability were Muriel Perrin, Paul Perrin, Ruble Caerbert, Floyd J. Peters, Kenn Witting, Vesta Peters, Tyne English and Clyde Barth. The cast was augmented by members of the audience who were invited to the stage to act as jurors in the side-splitting court scene.

The variety show was proof of the thespian, comedy and musical talent prevalent in Yucca Valley. The variety entertainers and their specialties were George Balazs with accordion specialties, Fred Landgraf in a pantomime act, John Arch and Charisie Peters in a skit called "Why Do I Love You," Jo Engle in her Sophie Tucker impersonation, Bob Murray in a number of impersonations, Joan Papendick in piano-forte renditions and Antoine Martin with his singing of "Silver Threads among the Gold" and "Shine on Harvest Moon."

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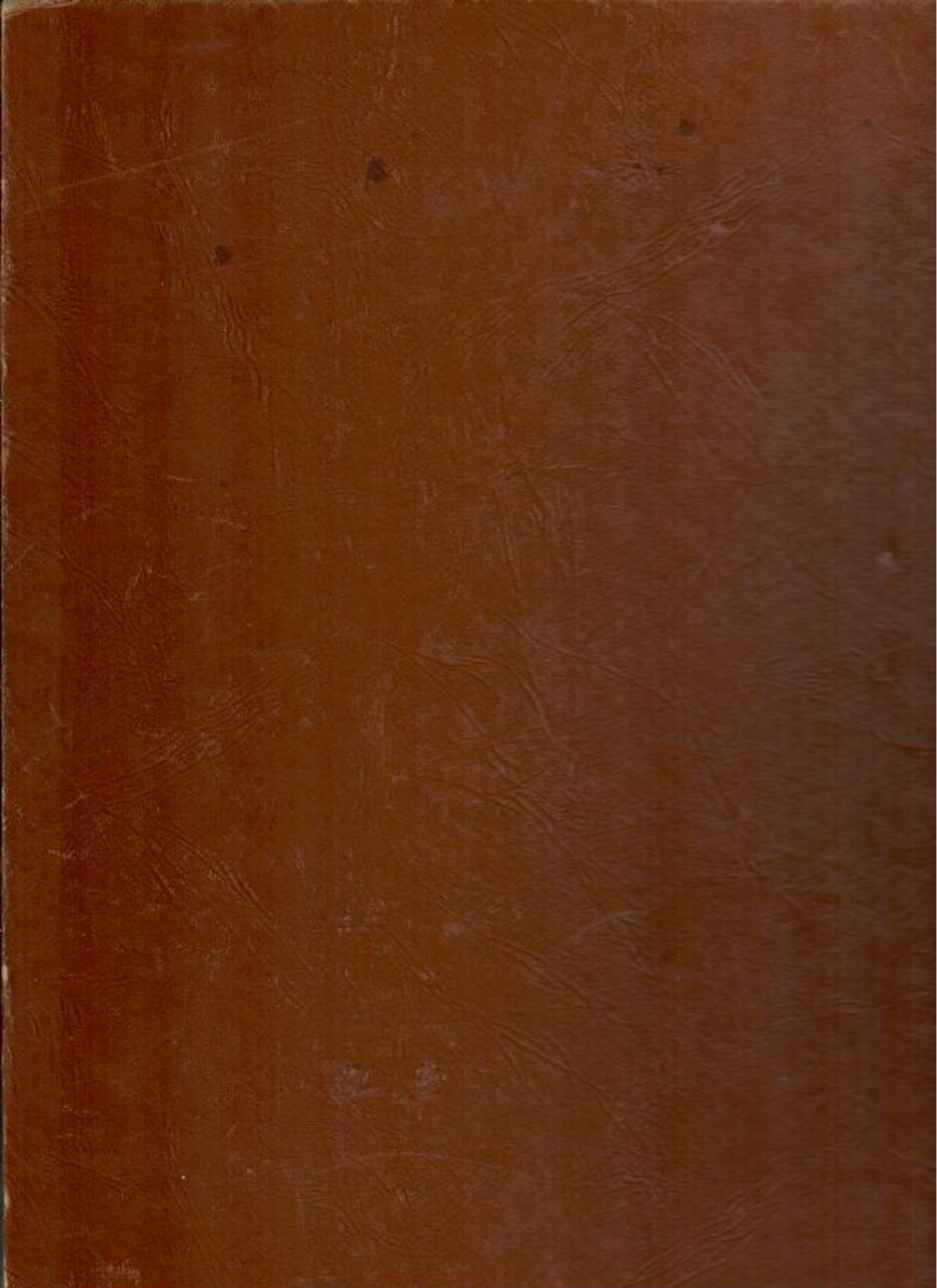
