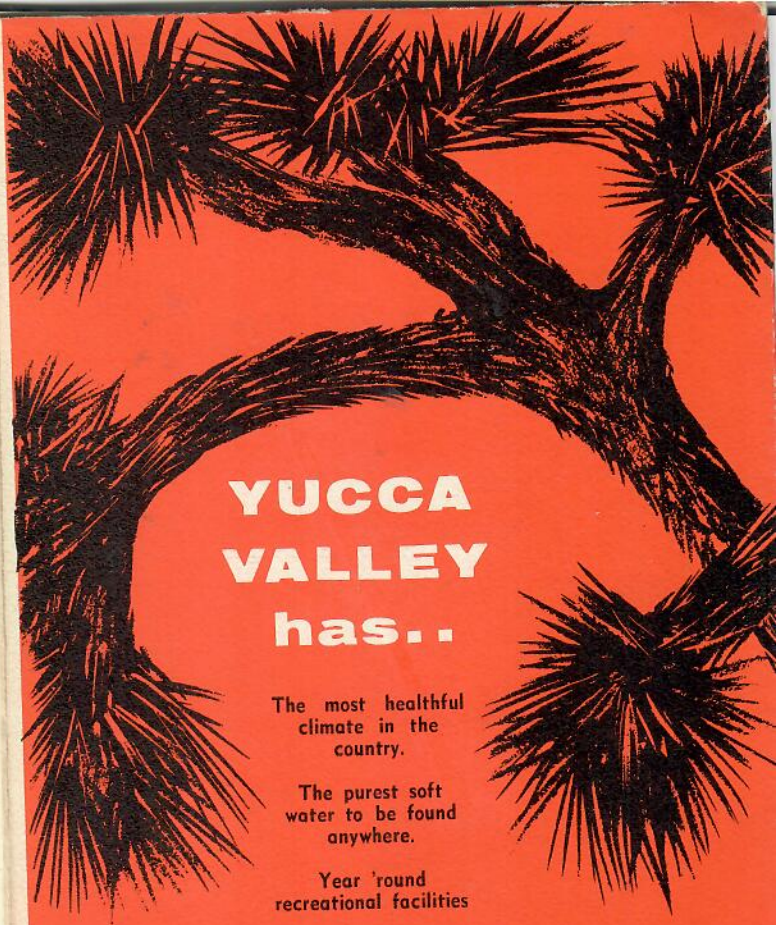


# Interesting Facts about Yucca Valley

Although Yucca Valley's many advantages for year 'round living and vacation fun can't be captured by statistics, they do serve to emphasize how this progressive community is growing so fast. In fact, only the elevation really remains constant, at an average of 3,300 feet; 1959's rainfall was 7.04 inches. This explains why days are sunny, cool, and clear. In the approximate 26 square miles included in the fire and park district, the following figures indicate the totals at press time, although Yucca Valley will hardly stand still long enough to be counted.

The population is 5,200, and the assessed valuation more than \$3,600,000. The 1959 post office receipts were \$28,947.43. More than 700 telephones, 1,220 electrical, and 2,300 liquified gas connections are in service. Approximately 1,200 water connections have been made, and all utilities are constantly being expanded to provide the necessary services.

There are 1,238 registered voters, 3 weekly area newspapers, a brand new drive-in theater, modern supermarkets, motels, and much much more that space limitations prevent listing here. The new Road Runner Route signs are emphasizing the fact that all of the major access routes to this area are now paved, with interesting alternate return routes for your enjoyment. See the new "Desert Paradise" for more information on this area. Pick out any loop trip you'd like to explore, then come on up soon and enjoy the beautiful hi-desert.

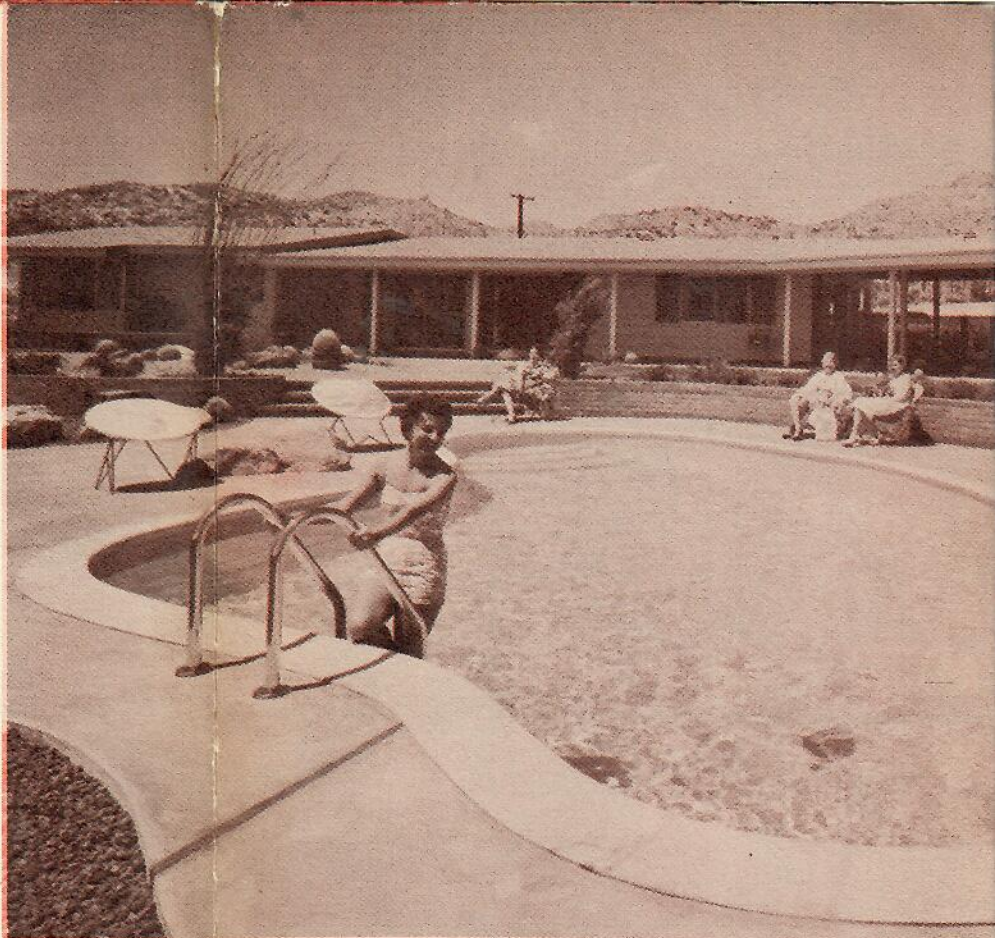

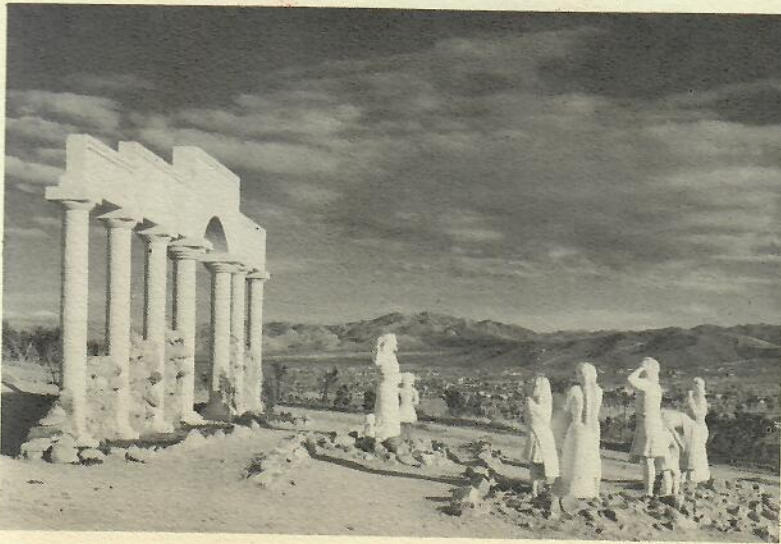
Here you'll discover an exciting new way of life among the spectacular Joshua Forests of the Hi-Desert. Many of the thousands of families who now live in Yucca Valley first came here for fun-filled week-ends and vacations, but now they can enjoy its unsurpassed climate and wide variety of recreational attractions all year long. Horseback riding, golf, tennis, swimming, exploring the ever-changing desert — these and many other leisure-time activities are virtually at your doorstep in beautiful Yucca Valley. Glance at any road map and you'll see that this growing community is actually situated at the crossroads to all of the major natural attractions of Southern California.

To the West is Big Bear Lake and the entire San Bernardino Mountain area. There you'll find excellent trout fishing, hunting, and winter sports. The vast and colorful landscapes of Joshua Tree National Monument are right outside your door. Water skiing and corvina fishing are tops at the adjacent Salton Sea area, and the nearby Colorado River completes a quartet of recreational attractions that will appeal to virtually every taste.

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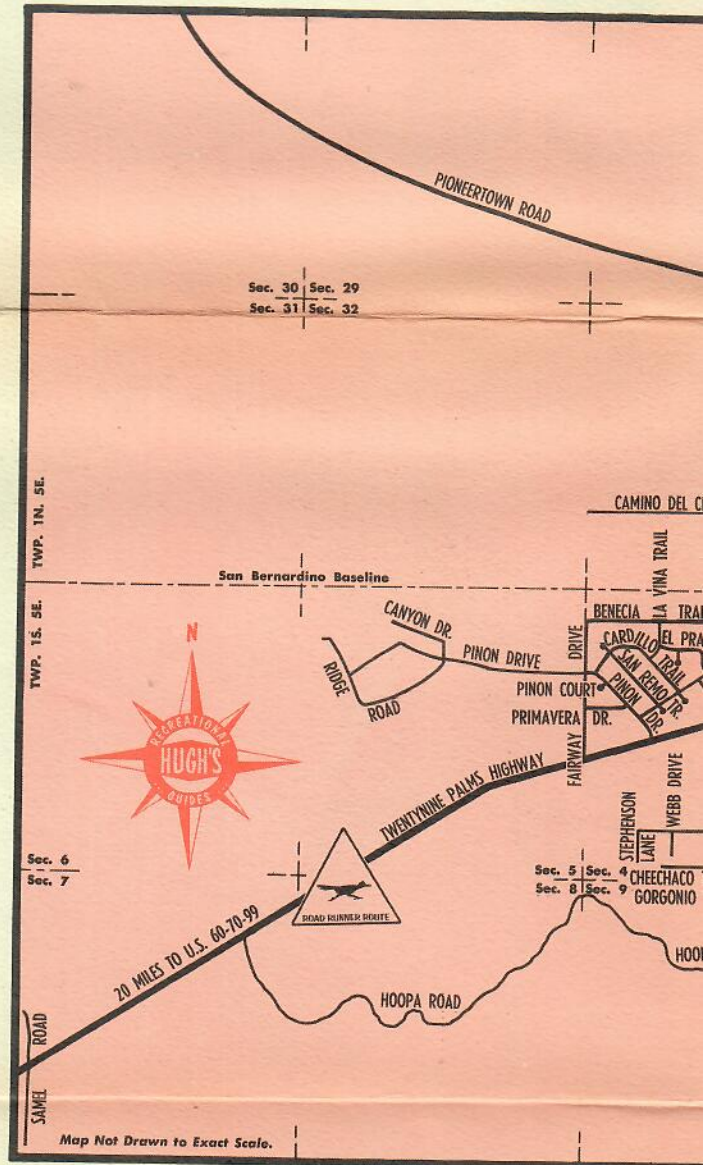


This photograph shows only a small portion of the unique features of Hi-Desert Shrine Park, which has been created at Yucca Valley through the dedicated sculpture of Antone Martin. Many other biblical scenes are scattered throughout the large park area, and there's also a tiny chapel and a picnic area. Admission is free.



Yucca Valley's inviting golf course is open to the public every day of the year. Because of the area's higher elevation and remarkable climate, playing conditions are excellent throughout the year. The course is especially popular during the summer season, when golfers from many other localities come here to enjoy their favorite sport.

Because of its excellent facilities, flying clubs often meet for pleasant week-ends at Yucca Valley's modern airport. It is lighted for 24-hour use, and there's a restaurant right at the airport. Local motels will gladly provide transportation for visitors who wish to stay overnight. Airport elevation is 3,220 feet, and there's 80 and 100 octane gasoline available. The landing strip is 2,900 feet long.



Excellent educational facilities are provided in a new and modern school, completed in 1958. Students from kindergarten through the eighth grade are accommodated at Yucca Valley with high schools.



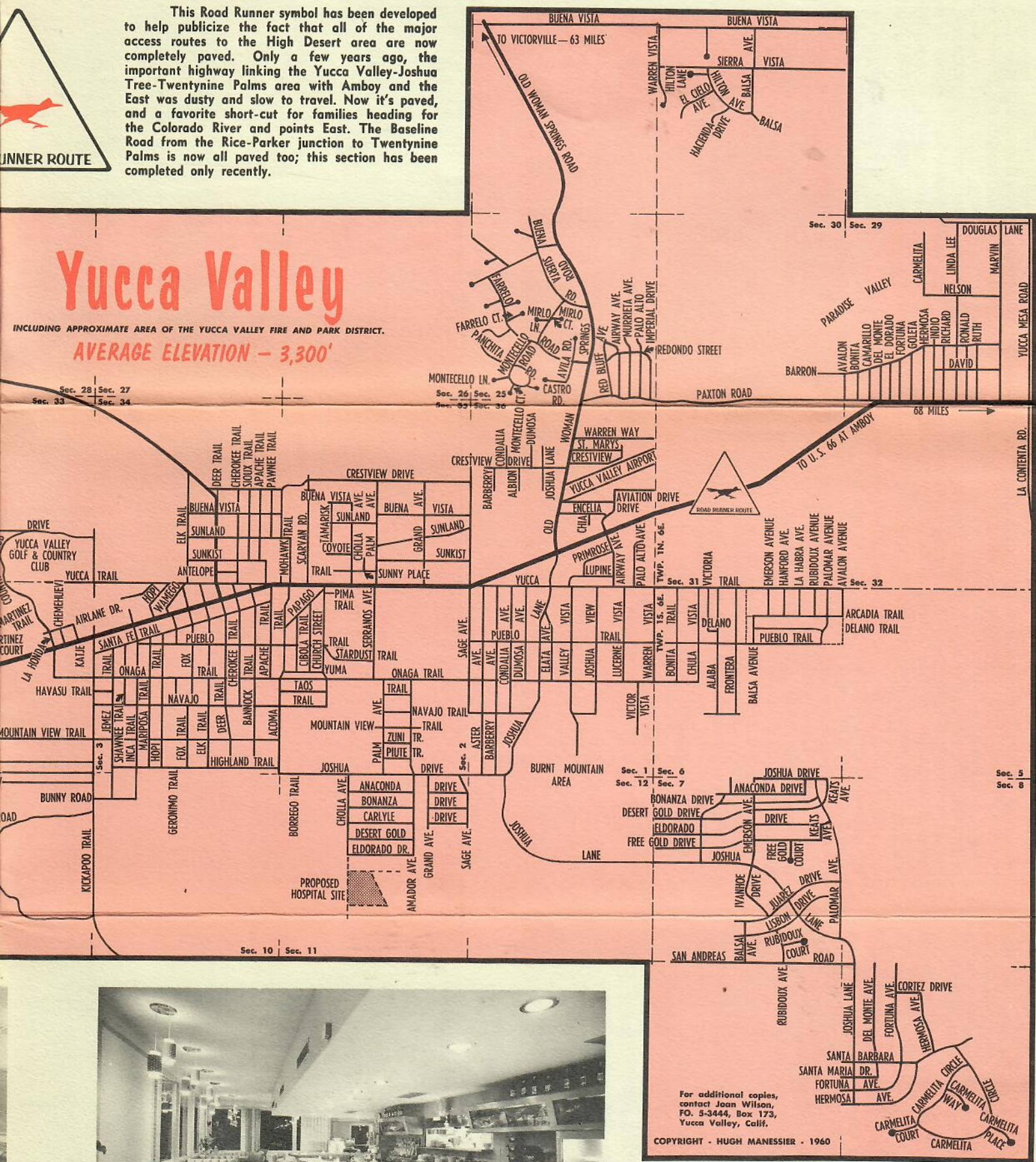


This Road Runner symbol has been developed to help publicize the fact that all of the major access routes to the High Desert area are now completely paved. Only a few years ago, the important highway linking the Yucca Valley-Joshua Tree-Twenty-nine Palms area with Amboy and the East was dusty and slow to travel. Now it's paved, and a favorite short-cut for families heading for the Colorado River and points East. The Baseline Road from the Rice-Parker junction to Twentynine Palms is now all paved too; this section has been completed only recently.
