## Life Connected by Water

Surrounded by mountains on three sides, the Kyoto basin is blessed by abundant water resources brought by the rivers that flow from the mountains.

More than 10 Class A rivers run through the city of Kyoto, notably the Kamo, Katsura and Uji rivers.

Long known as a city of Sanshūmei, or scenic beauty,

Kyoto has fostered a unique culture around its rivers.

The KYOTO AQUARIUM recreates the ecosystems where numerous life forms co-exist through connection with water.

### Camera / Video Shooting

① You are allowed to take photos and videos only for personal enjoyment.

② Shooting for commercial purposes is prohibited.

### Smoking

Smoking is prohibited at the aquarium.

### Bringing into the Kyoto Aquarium

Please refrain from viewing while carrying large (or long) baggage, such as a keyboard and a carry bag, since it may cause inconvenience to other visitors.

① If a staff member determines that your belongings are not suitable to be brought into the aquarium, he/she may speak to you.

② You can bring your own lunch with you. You may enjoy it on benches in the area of the fur seal and earless seal exhibits, the Dolphin Stadium, and the Sanshisuimei (the Beauty of Nature) area.

### Accompanied by Your Pets and Other Animals

You are not allowed to be accompanied by your pets and other animals.

① However, guide dogs and assistance dogs are allowed to enter the aquarium with their owners.

### Acts Resulting in Admission Refusal

If we determine that your acts may cause inconvenience to those who live in the neighborhood and other visitors, you may be refused admission.

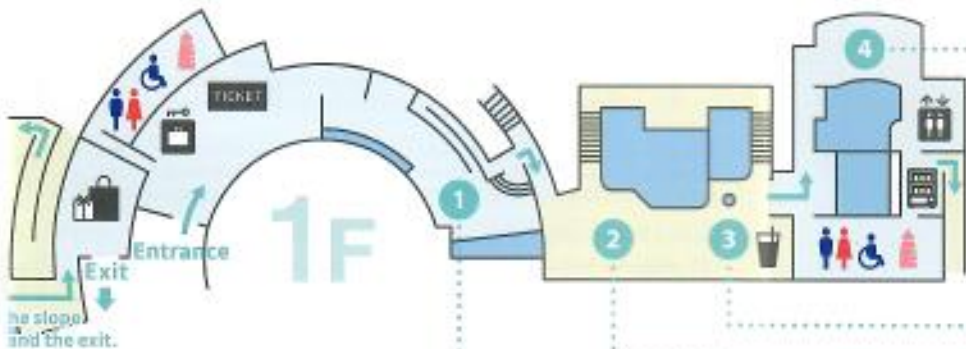
