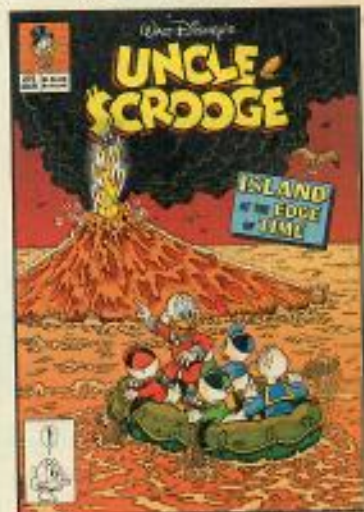
Lastly, a request. Could you please reprint "The Case of the Sticky Money," from US #42?
