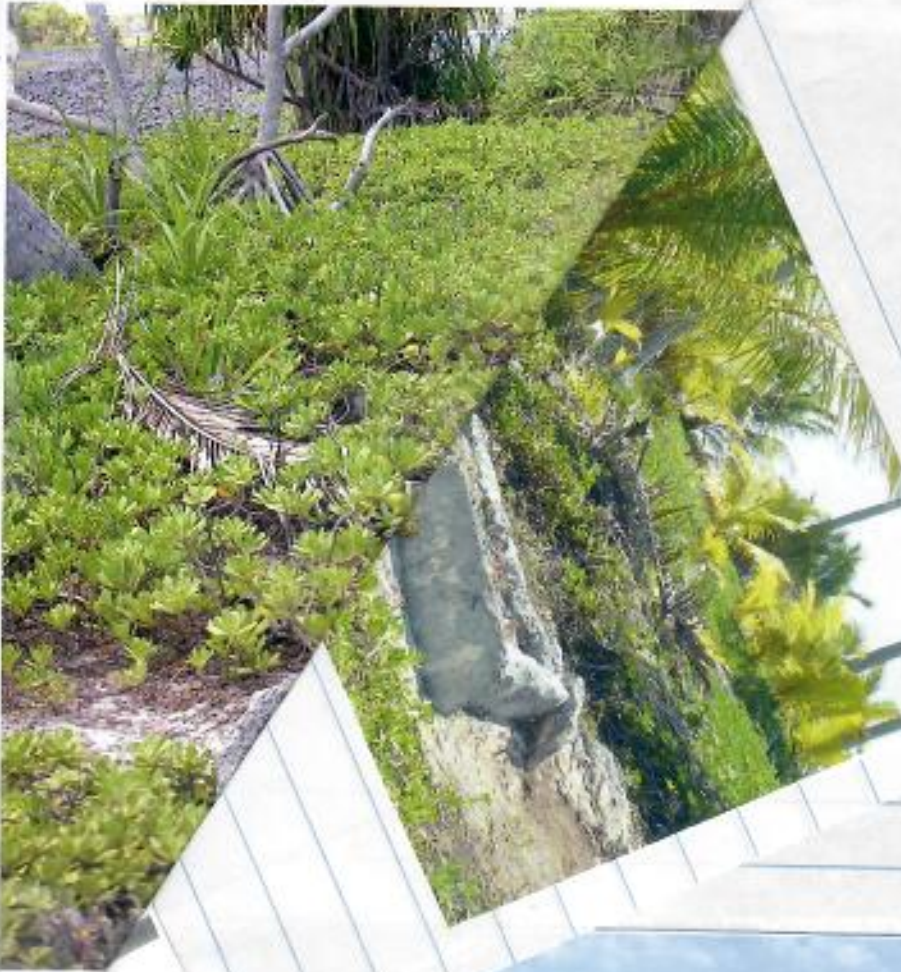


Fig.1.10 : Pêche à la foëne sur le récif, Napuka (photo E.Conte)

Green turtles are unique among sea turtles in being mainly herbivorous. They make regular long-distance migrations of as much as a thousand miles or more between their nesting beaches and pastures of sea grasses or algae. For centuries, the species has been heavily exploited for its excellent meat, and many colonies have been destroyed.


Hello and Aloha President Brotherson,

The story of green turtles being restored in the Hawaiian Islands during recent times has been heralded in several scientific and popular publications, but perhaps most eloquently in "The Book of Honu" and on the Turtle Trax web page <www.turtles.org> authored by Peter Bennett and Ursula Keuper-Bennett. Less known to most is the past and present complexities of the green turtles of French Polynesia, where they are also called honu. The bond between the native peoples and honu of the far-flung islands of French Polynesia continues to be deep-rooted, diverse, and intense, likely as previously existed in Hawaii, and may happen again, as the honu population of Hawaii proceeds ever upward and the tumor disease continues in decline. My relationship with green turtles began in French Polynesia in 1963 and evolved, through a series of lucky events, into a 43-year endeavor focused in the Hawaiian Archipelago. In 1963, my wife Linda and I sold our few possessions, emptied our small bank account, and left California to experience life in the South Seas among the people of Tahiti. Our journey there included a week in Hawaii before flying to the newly-opened jet airport near Papeete. Through the kindness of strangers, for seven months we subsisted in the then-outlier District of Paea in Tahiti. Visa limitations eventually returned us to California on a cargo ship via Nuku Hiva in the Marquesas and Panama. A few months later, we were back in Hawaii building a life, family, and careers that endure to the present.

I saw my first sea turtle in Tahiti, a juvenile honu that would have been dinner if not for my poor aim as a spear fisher. Later, walking the shoreline of Bora Bora with Linda, I saw my second sea turtle kept as a pet in a pen on the reef flat. I regularly still dream about French Polynesian people, islands, and turtles, as the natives still dream at night when an ancestor tells them where a turtle can be caught the next day on the reef. Since leaving in 1964 I've returned to French Polynesia on six short trips, five by invitation to assist with sea turtle studies, and once with Linda for a brief stop on a cruise vacation to Sydney. The most memorable visit was in 1991 to remote Scilly Atoll to work with Rene Tuputu and family, Rene being one of the most knowledgeable turtle hunters of the region. My most recent visit was in October 2010 as part of the "First International Symposium on Sea Turtles in French Polynesia" where Rene Tuputu and I met again after 20 years.

There is great potential for traditional ties with the honu to persist, on a sustainable basis, among the people of French Polynesia. The status of the stocks and the sustainability of the harvest need to be examined within the cultural context of island communities. I am committed to playing a role in aiding both the honu and the people in their interwoven relationships.

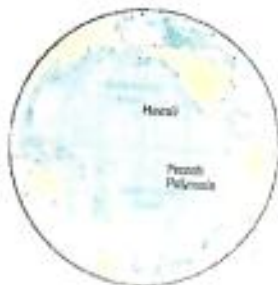


La restauration des populations de tortues vertes dans les îles Hawaïennes durant les dernières années <http://www.iucnredlist.org/details/16285718/0> a fait l'objet de plusieurs publications scientifiques et grand public, mais aussi une note toute particulière est illustrée dans le "Le Livre de Honu" et par «Turtle Trax» sur le site www.turtles.org, créé par Peter Bennett et Ursula Kuiper-Bennett. L'histoire passée et présente des tortues vertes de Polynésie française (appelées aussi «honu») est moins connue. Le lien fort et traditionnel entre les polynésiens dispersés sur les îles éloignées et les «honu» est très profond, diversifié et intense. Ce lien est sans doute le même que celui qui existait et qui continuera d'exister encore à Hawaii, où les populations de tortues continuent de progresser et où les décès par présence de tumeurs tendent à décroître. Mon lien avec les tortues vertes est né en Polynésie française en 1963 et s'est renforcé tout au long des 43 dernières années par des événements successifs et principalement au sein de l'archipel hawaïen. En 1963, ma femme Linda et moi avons vendu le peu que nous possédions, vidé nos comptes en banque pour quitter la Californie et tenter l'aventure parmi les polynésiens de Tahiti. Notre voyage a commencé par une semaine à Hawaii avant de se poursuivre par l'arrivée à Tahiti, dans le tout nouvel aéroport de Papeete. Avec l'aide des résidents, nous avons vécu dans la zone de Paea, alors peu développée. Puis notre visa expirant, nous avons dû rentrer en cargo en Californie, en passant par Nuku Hiva aux Marquises et par Panama. Quelques mois plus tard, nous étions de retour à Hawaii, pour construire notre vie, une famille et une carrière, toujours d'actualité.

J'ai vu ma première tortue marine à Tahiti, elle aurait fini dans mon assiette si je n'avais pas été aussi médiocre en tant que pêcheur au fusil harpon. Puis, plus tard, j'ai vu ma deuxième tortue marine, lorsque Linda et moi marchions sur la plage à Bora Bora, la tortue était alors un animal de compagnie, onfornée dans un parc flottant sur le récif. Je rêve encore très souvent de la Polynésie française, ses habitants, ses îles et ses tortues, tout comme les Polynésiens rêvent encore la nuit de leur ancêtre qui leur dit où la tortue pourra être attrapée le lendemain sur le récif. Depuis 1964, je suis revenu 6 fois en Polynésie mais pour de courts séjours, 5 fois sur invitations pour collaborer à des programmes de recherche, et une fois avec Linda pour un court stop lors d'une croisière vers Sydney. La visite qui m'a touchée le plus est celle de l'atoll de Scilly en 1991 avec René Taputu et sa famille, René était considéré comme le meilleur chasseur de tortue de la région. Ma dernière visite a été en Octobre 2010, à l'occasion du «Premier symposium sur les tortues marines en Polynésie française» où j'ai revu René Taputu 20 ans après. Je sens que le lien fort qui lie les Polynésiens et la tortue persiste, sur une base durable. Le statut des populations de tortues et la durabilité de leur utilisation doivent être examinés en fonction du contexte culturel des îles. Je me sens engagé à jouer un rôle pour contribuer à renforcer le lien intime entre les populations et les tortues marines.

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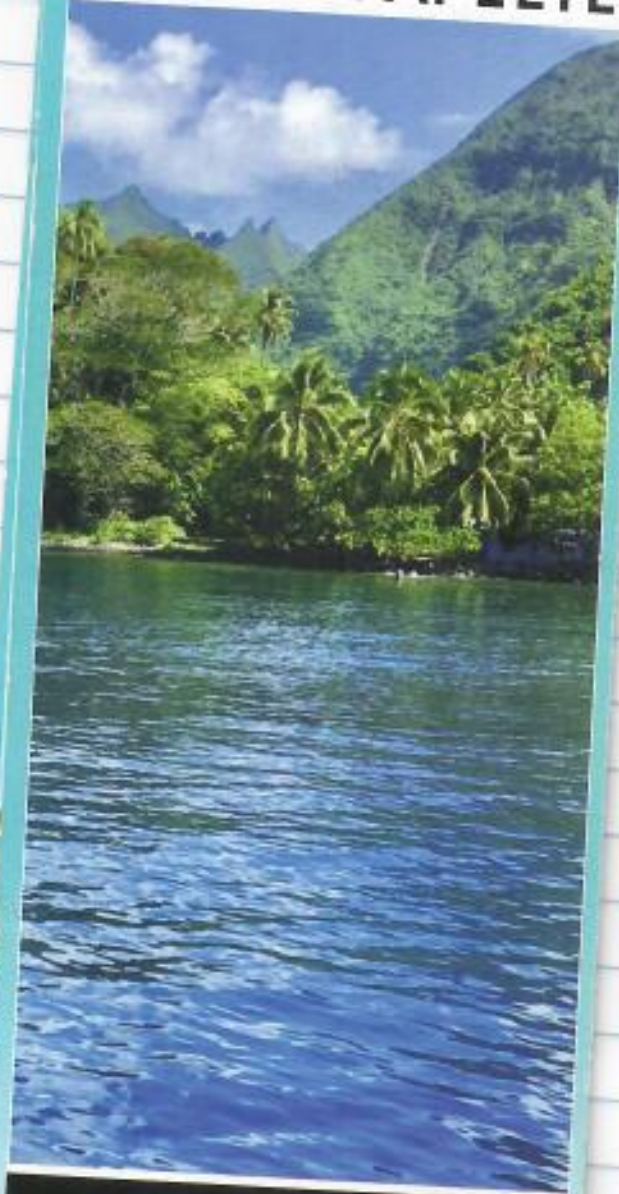

The trial of a "massacre" of turtles in Manuae

Tahiti, September 2, 2022 - The correctional court judged Friday four poachers for a real turtle fishing campaign -particularly bloody- conducted in November 2019 in Manuae. The prosecution considered that it was now necessary to move to firm prison sentences on this subject. Deliberated on September 15.

"A real massacre." Friday morning, the president of the correctional court, Thierry Fragnoli, did not mince his words at the evocation of a file that one did not expect to discover during a simple single judge hearing. At the bar, four defendants aged between 22 and 44 years old were prosecuted for an unusual poaching of turtles of a scale rarely equaled in Fenua. And as a proof of the importance of the case, the prosecutor did not hesitate to ask for prison sentences against the traffickers. The representative of the public prosecutor, H  l  ne Geiger, conceded that these were "severe sentences", but they were intended to "show that for this type of environmental offence, we have raised the bar to the level of the issue".

Trails of blood

The case had been discovered on November 21, 2019, during a surveillance flight of a plane of the Armed Forces of French Polynesia over the atoll of Mopelia in the far west of the Society Archipelago. While approaching the atoll, the military crew spotted and photographed a bloody scene in which about 15 people were busy cutting up at least as many turtles on a beach. Several ships were anchored nearby, shells and coolers were spread out on the

beach, but above all, long, clearly visible blood trails stretched across the sand and into the sea... "It must have been a nameless carnage", the president of the court let slip during his summary of the proceedings, at the beginning of the hearing.

The plane of the Armed Forces had then redone a passage, but to note that there was "nobody more on the beach". The turtle shells and coolers had been hidden under large coconut palms, but the traces of blood were still widely visible from the air. The army plane was also able to identify the registrations of three of the vessels present, a bonitier and two poti marara. An investigation was then carried out to find the owners of the vessels, who were originally from the island of Tahiti, and then to interview them and implicate five suspect fishermen.

Cigarettes against turtles On

Friday morning, four of these fishermen were sent back to the court. The fifth one, having left the territory in a hurry for the mainland, will be summoned and judged later. "I don't hide from you that the versions given in police custody, it was a lot of nonsense", started the president of the hearing, usually assigned to the instruction of the penal files. "I expect from you today a certain frankness. That each one takes its responsibilities." And nearly three years after the facts, the four men have generally complied. One of them quickly introduced himself as the instigator of the project. "I wanted to eat turtle meat, because I like it," he explained. But with about twenty poached green turtles representing nearly 350 kg of animal flesh, the man did not hide for a long time that he intended his fishing mainly for the resale on Raiatea or Tahiti. "I knew people in Mopelia. We decided to set a date. We filled the boats. We got some food and headed out."

But above all, it is the organization and conduct of this real poaching campaign that makes the case special. From Tahiti, the fishermen went to Raiatea to fill up, before heading to Mopelia where they literally recruited atoll residents in exchange for food. Pasta, rice and sugar were exchanged for labor that was obviously quite used to turtle fishing. After spending a night in Mopelia, the fishermen went to the neighboring atoll of Manuae to catch about 20 turtles. "There, there were people on the reef who wanted to

trade turtles for cigarettes," even the main defendant recounts. The animals were then brought back to Mopelia to be cut up, butchered and packed in bags... And that's when the fishermen and the inhabitants got scared when they saw the army plane, got rid of all the turtles and returned to Tahiti.

On the stand Friday, the three other defendants tried by the court generally confirmed this version of the expedition. Even if they affirmed that they did not know that they were going to fish turtles before setting sail from Tahiti. "I just came to do a fishing trip," explained the owner of one of the poti marara. "I thought we were going to Fakarava," the youngest, a simple sailor on the bonito, defended himself. Once on the spot, however, the three defendants admitted to having participated in the fishing, transporting and butchering of the turtles. "You knew that it was forbidden. You had the choice to refuse once you were on site", the prosecutor pointed out during her closing arguments.

"Also present at the hearing, the representative of French Polynesia intervened to announce the constitution of civil party of the Country in this file. The territory has a very repressive legal arsenal against turtle poaching and aims to make Polynesia a "sanctuary" for the protection of protected marine animals. The country's lawyer explained that the turtles were in the middle of their reproduction period at the time of the poaching and that the choice of Manuae was not made by chance: "It is a nature reserve classified by decree so that the turtles can quietly nest". The representative of the country asked for 15 million Fcfp in damages on behalf of French Polynesia.

As underlined, the prosecutor wished to insist on the seriousness of this case, but also on a change of penal policy on turtle fishing. The prosecutor announced the end of the pedagogical approach with the suspended sentences that have been given until now, and the beginning of a stronger repression by requesting 18 months of firm prison for the main fisherman and 12 months for the three others. "We must begin to understand the importance of what we want to protect," insisted the prosecutor. The defense lawyers, for their part, regretted that this case was chosen "to make an example". They also underlined a certain "hypocrisy" on the subject, by

evoking in particular the example of elected representatives of the assembly having announced openly to have already consumed meat of tortoise... The court put the case under deliberation. It will pronounce itself on September 15.
