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The green turtle nesting season starts again in Tetiaroa





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Tahiti, October 6, 2025 - The 2025-2026 egg-laying season begins, marking a new stage in the scientific monitoring carried out by Te mana o te moana to protect these emblematic Pacific travelers.

The new green turtle nesting season has just begun on the atoll of Tetiaroa. As every year, the Te mana o te moana association supervises the scientific monitoring of these protected species, alongside volunteers recently trained to observe, identify and protect the females who come to lay their eggs on the beaches.

The previous season (2024-2025) was particularly rich: 430 turtle tracks were recorded, 161 nests confirmed, and nearly 15,614 emerging turtles were estimated. 113 females were observed, including ten new and nine old ones who returned after several years of absence – among them, the faithful Moana2 and Coco Iti, each author of nine clutches.

The association also highlights the rescue of 227 emerging women in difficulty, including 17 transferred to the rehabilitation center of Tahiti for treatment. This fieldwork, which is essential to the preservation of the species, is made possible thanks to the support of the Department of the Environment, The Brando and many private partners.
